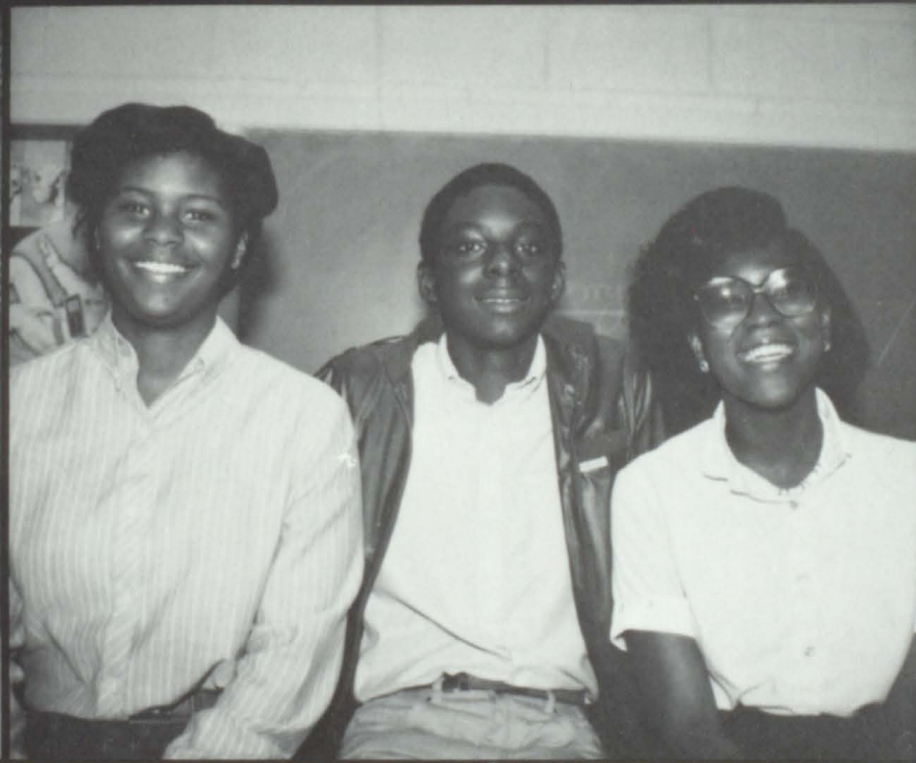




**T**he National Honor Society induction

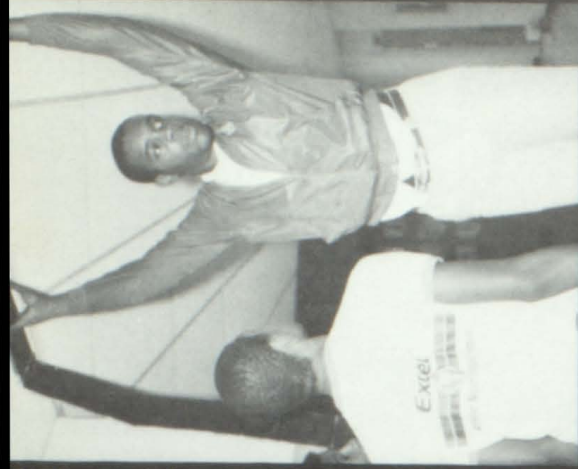


**R**oyalty in the Rain was the theme for our third annual Coronation Ball. We were influenced by the current hit album by Prince entitled "Purple Rain."
