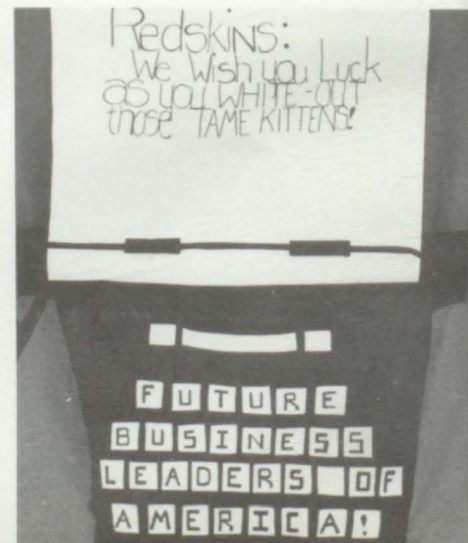
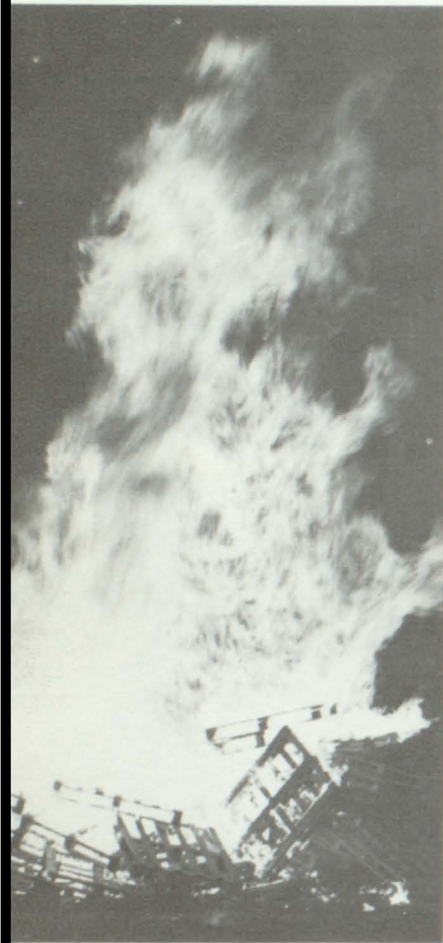


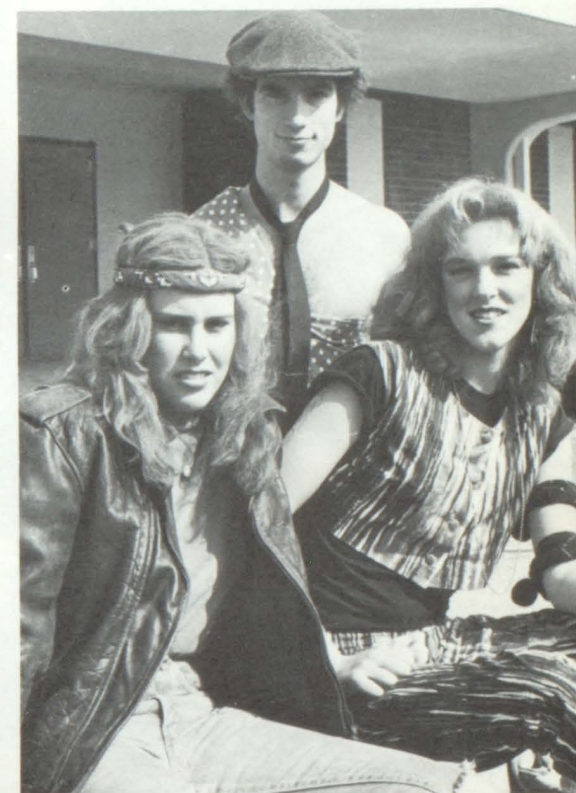




Homecoming (`hōm-kəm-in)
