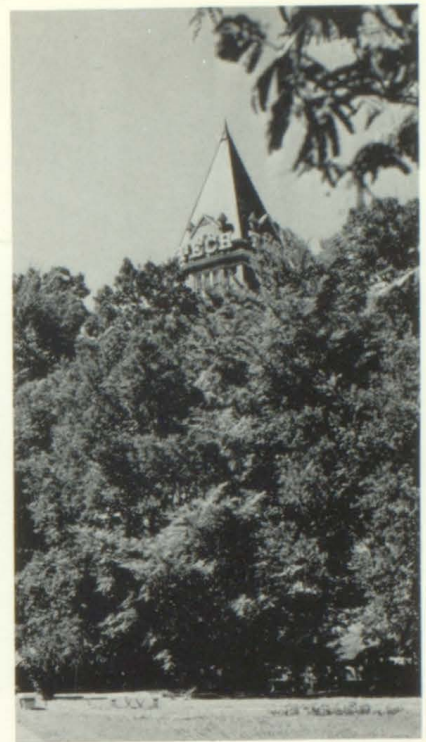
### ATLANTA
