The SENIOR CLASS of 1966 dedicates our *Aries* to this man—the man in whom we most want to see ourselves.

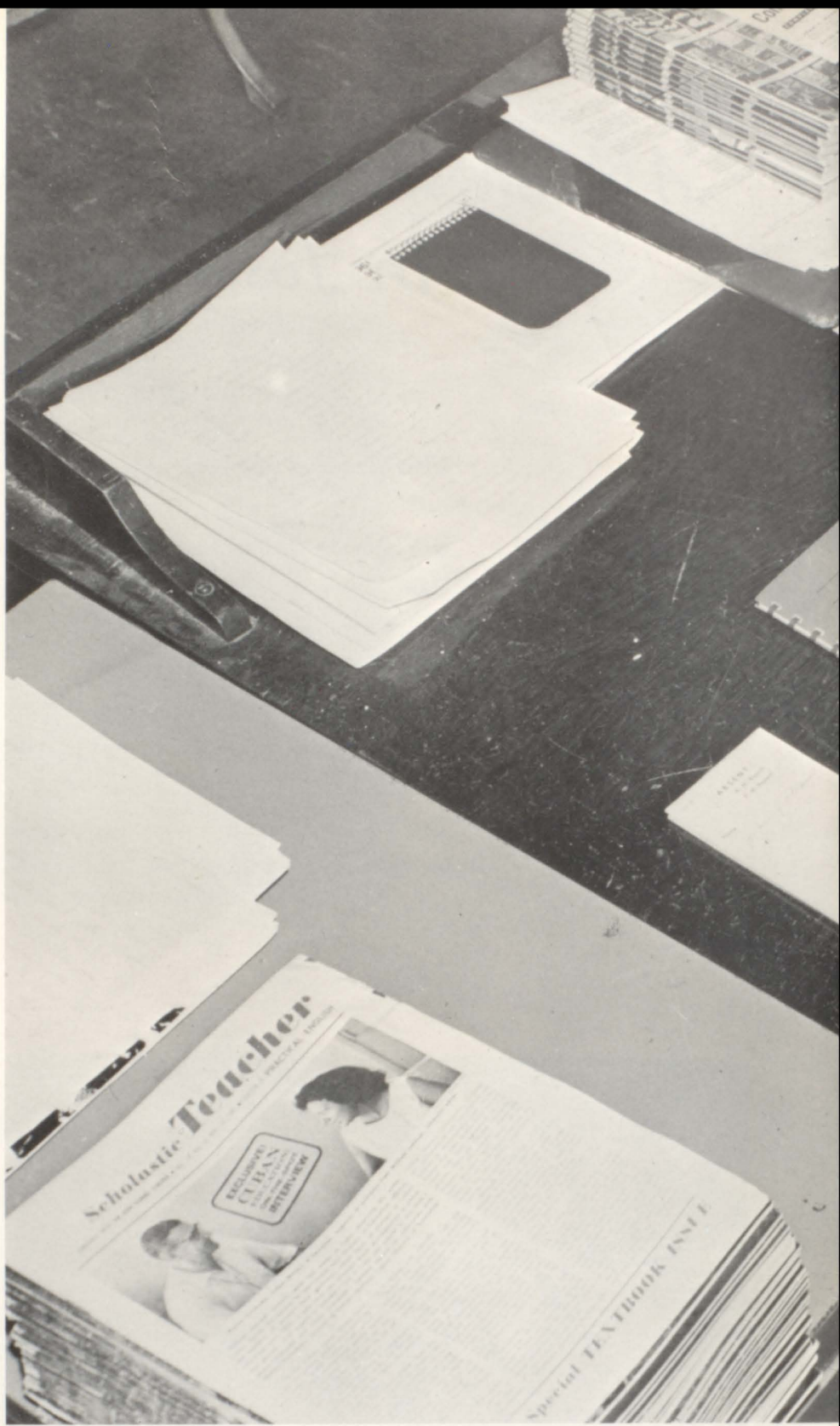


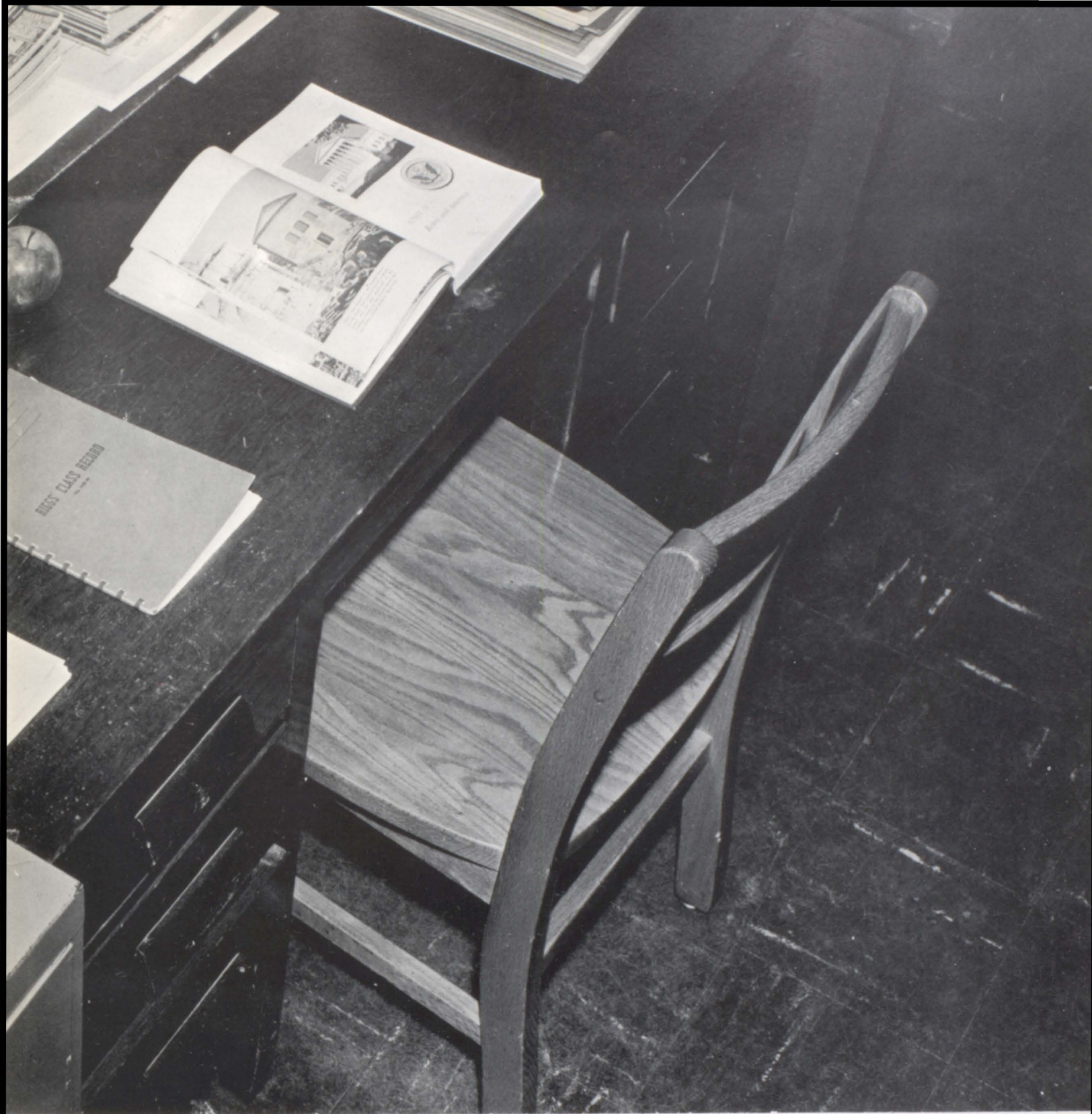

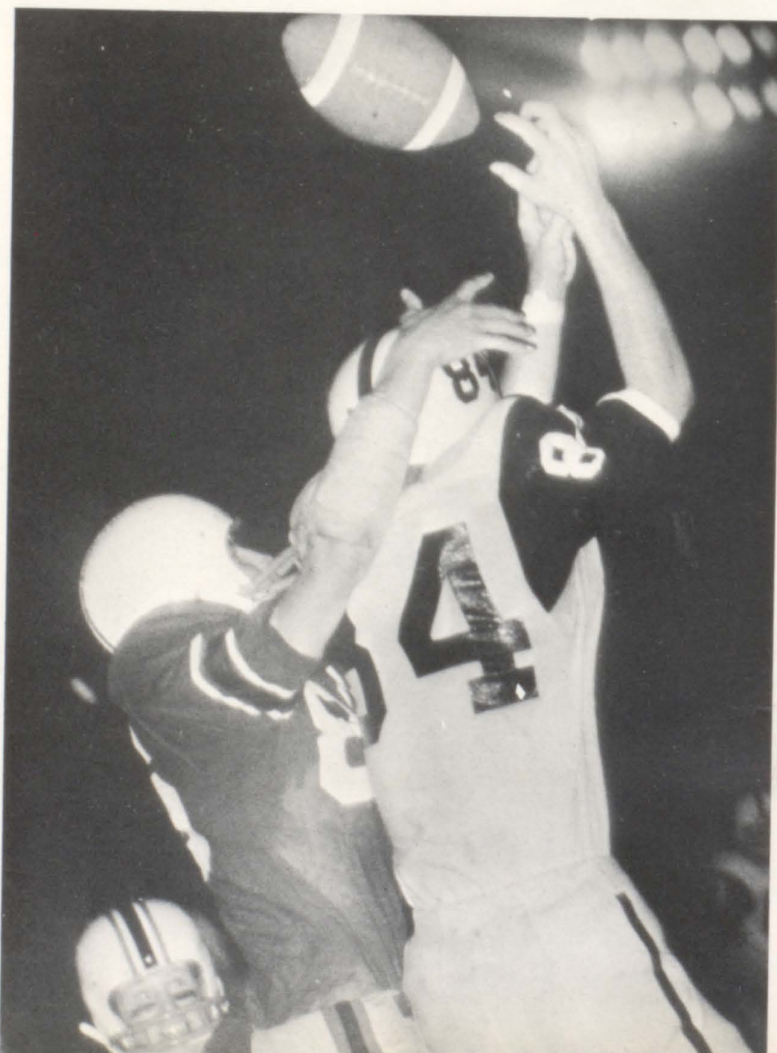
