LAW ONE GOD LOVES YOU, AND HAS A WONDERFUL PLAN FOR YOUR LIFE. GOD'S LOVE

"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life" (John 3:16) GOD'S PLAN (Christ speaking) "I came that they might have life, and might have it abundantly" (that it might be full and meaningful) (John 10:10).

Men are continually trying to reach God and the abundant life through their own efforts: good life, ethics, philosophy, etc.

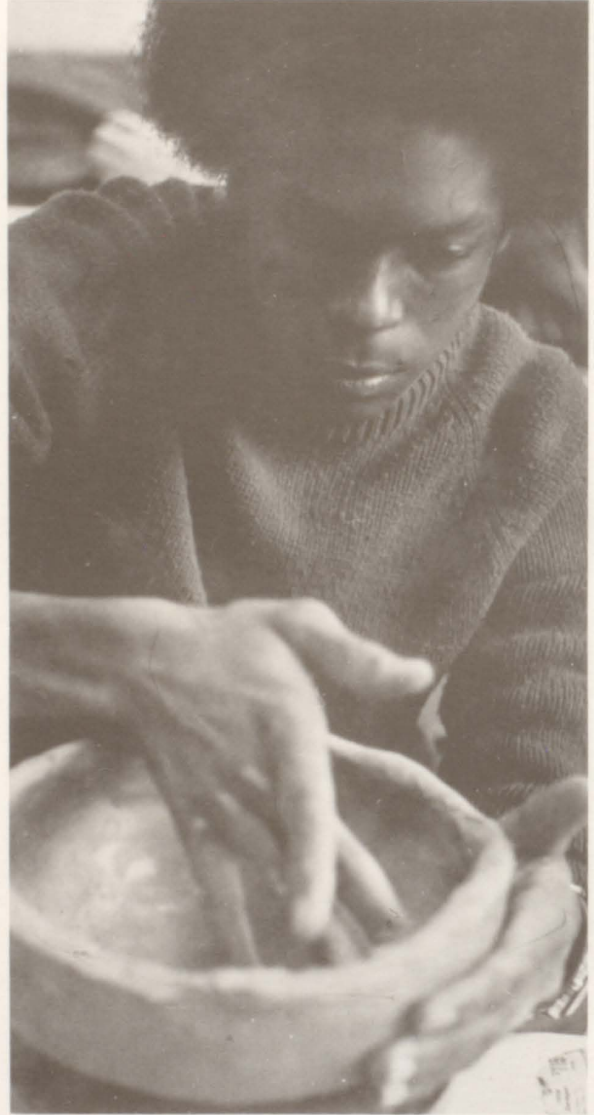

HE DIED IN OUR PLACE "But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 5:8). HE ROSE FROM THE DEAD "Christ died for our sins . . . He was buried . . . He was raised on the third day according to the scriptures . . . He appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. After that He appeared to more than five hundred . . ." (I Corinthians 15:3-6).



HE IS THE ONLY WAY "Jesus said to him, I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but through Me" (John 14:6) God has bridged the chasm which separates us from Him by sending His Son, Jesus Christ, to die on the cross in our place. WE RECEIVE CHRIST THROUGH FAITH "For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, that no one should boast" (Ephesians 2:89). WE RECEIVE CHRIST BY PERSONAL INVITATION "Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if any one hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him" (Revelation 3:20). Receiving Christ involves turning to from self, trusting Christ to come into our lives, to forgive our sins and make us what He wants us to be. It is not enough to give intellectual assent to His claims or to have an emotional experience. YOU CAN RECEIVE CHRIST RIGHT NOW THROUGH PRAYER (Prayer is talking with God) God knows your heart and is not so concerned with your works as He is with the attitude of your heart. The following is a suggested prayer: "Lord Jesus, I need You. I open the door of my life and receive You as my Savior and Lord. Thank You for forgiving my sins. Take control of the throne of my life. Make me the kind of person You want me to be."
