Offense Scores 192, While Defense Holds To 145

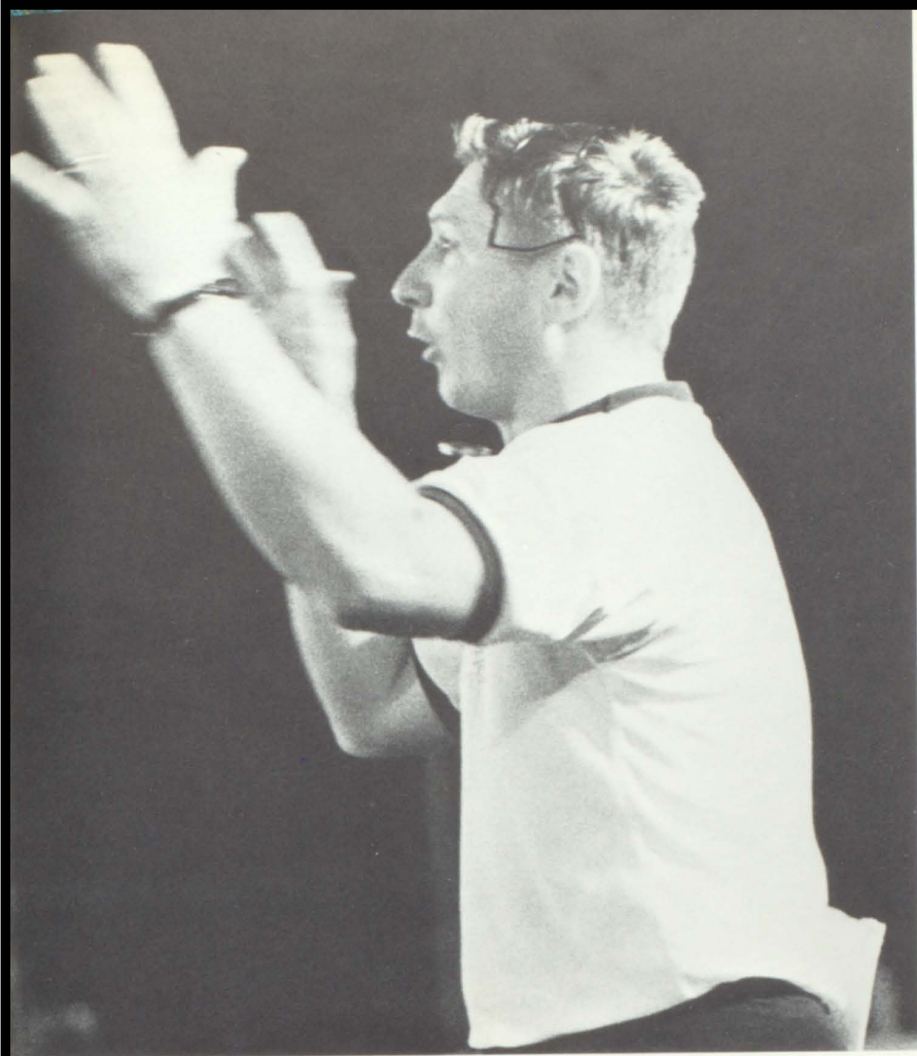

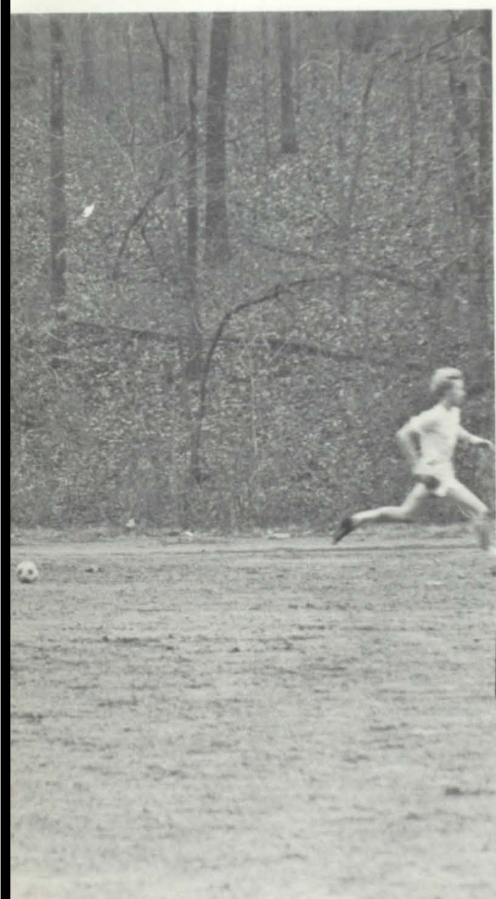
Ridgeview's first soccer team started with a petition drafted last year and signed by over 525 students and teachers asking for a team. The petition led to the organization of our first soccer team.

The squad has taken its lumps while compiling a less than impressive won-lost record. The record, though, does not reflect the tremendous spirit and determination shown in participation.

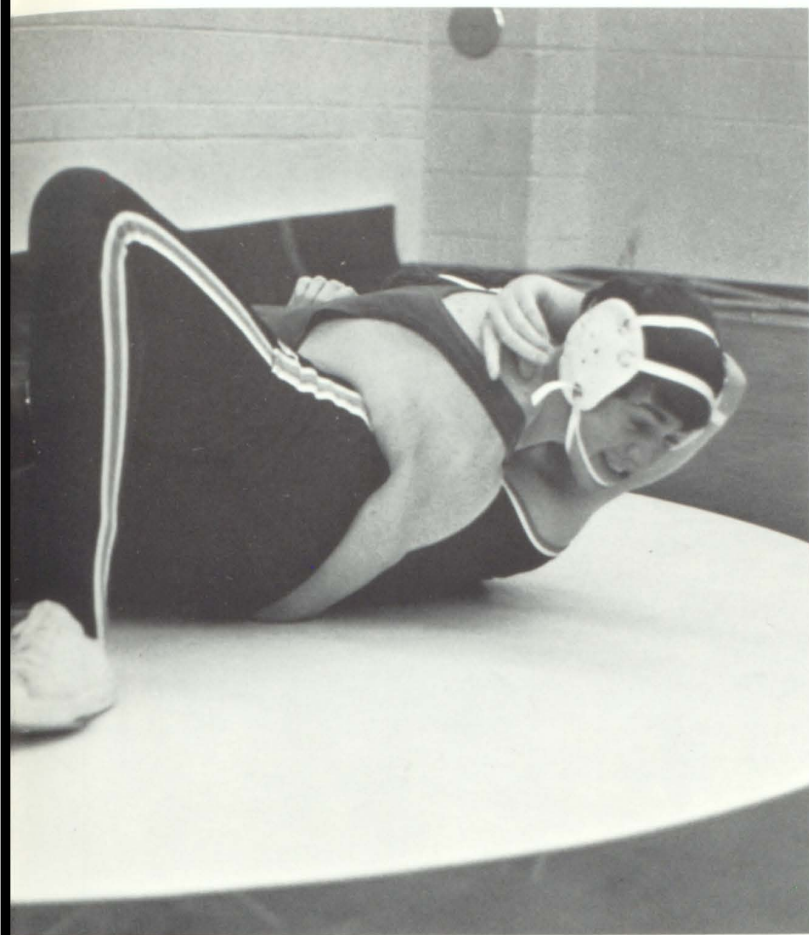

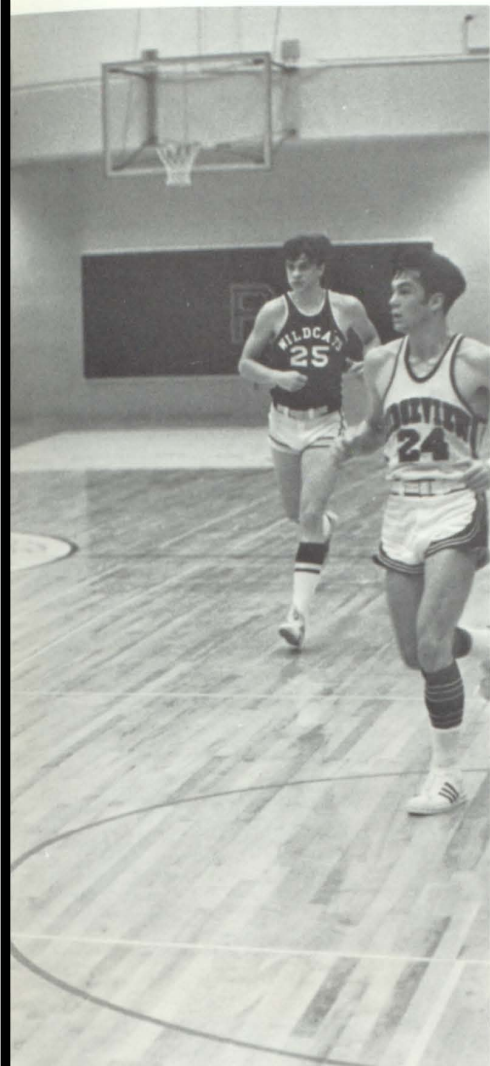
That's the way it was for the first part of our initial season in region competition. Unfortunately, our record did not show the great effort put out by the coach and all the players, both as individuals and as a whole team.

Beta Club

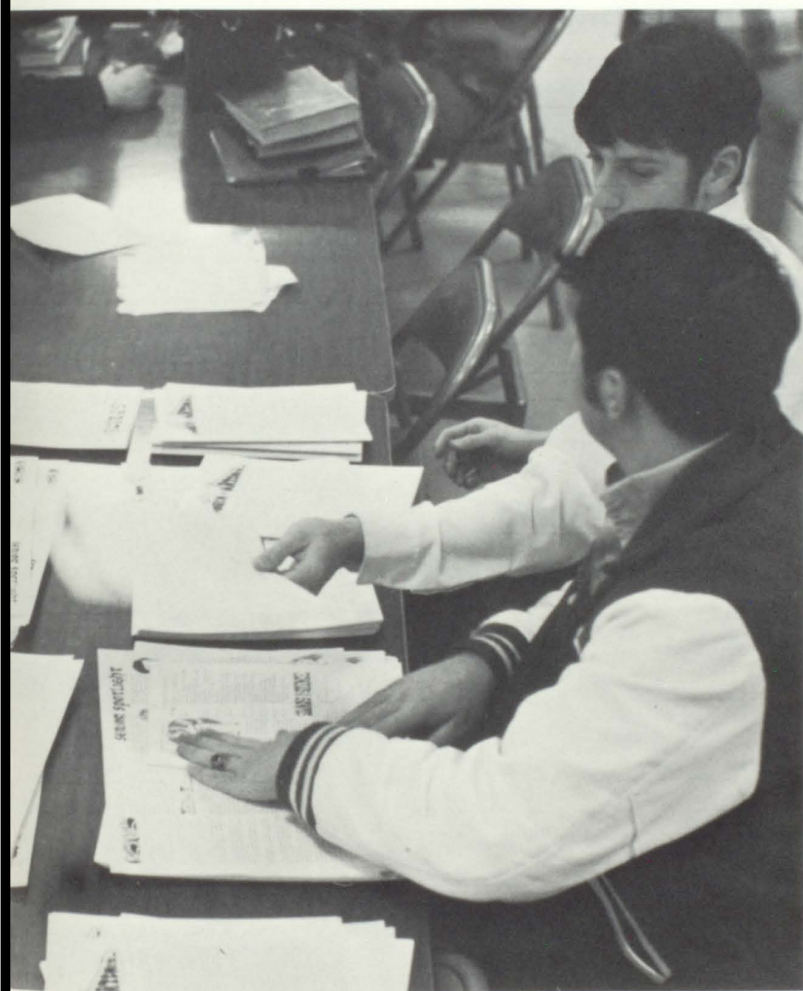

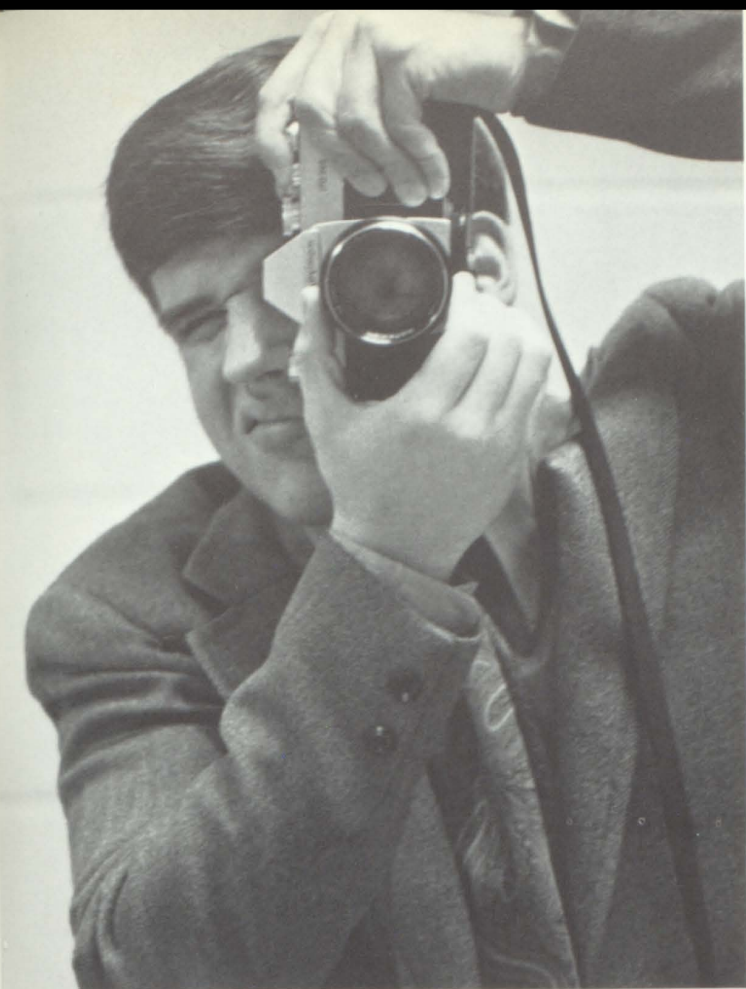


Torch And Hatchet

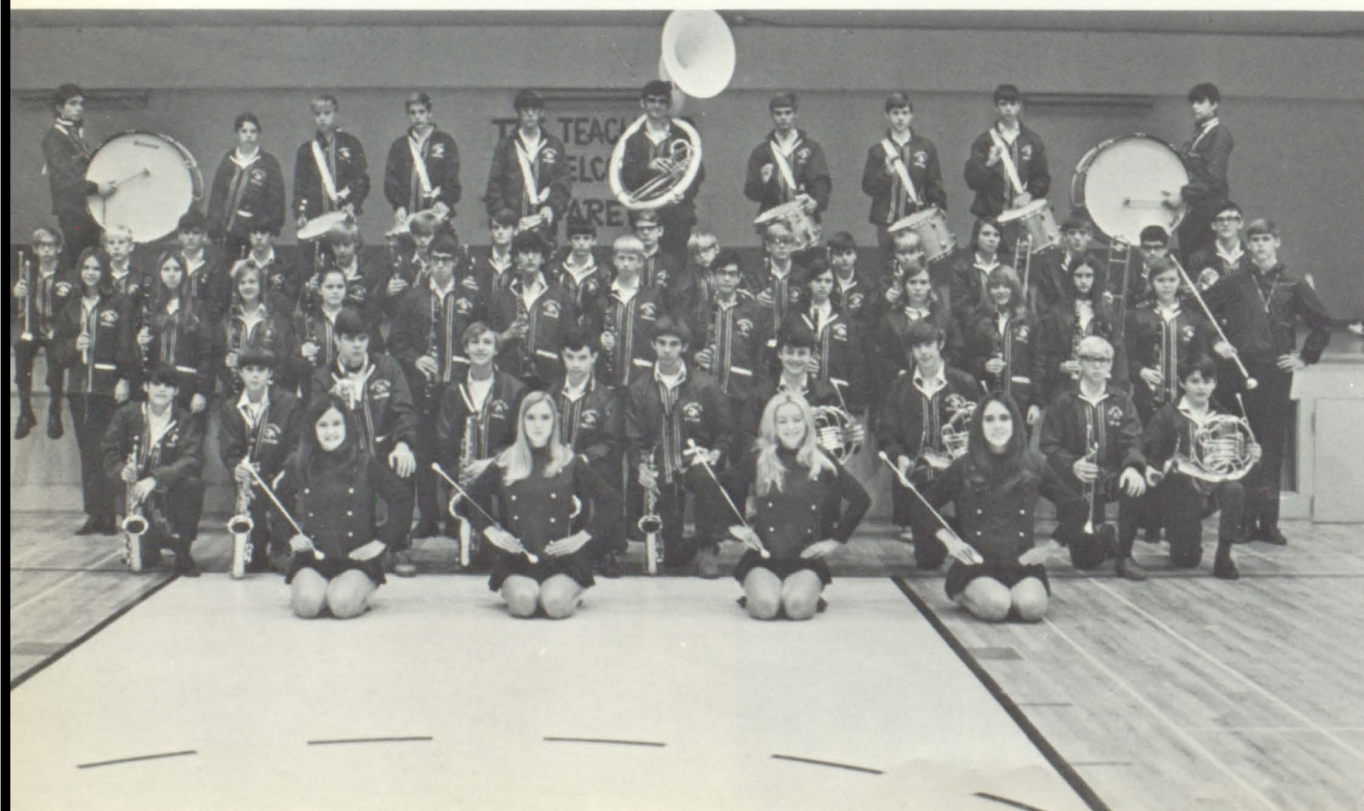
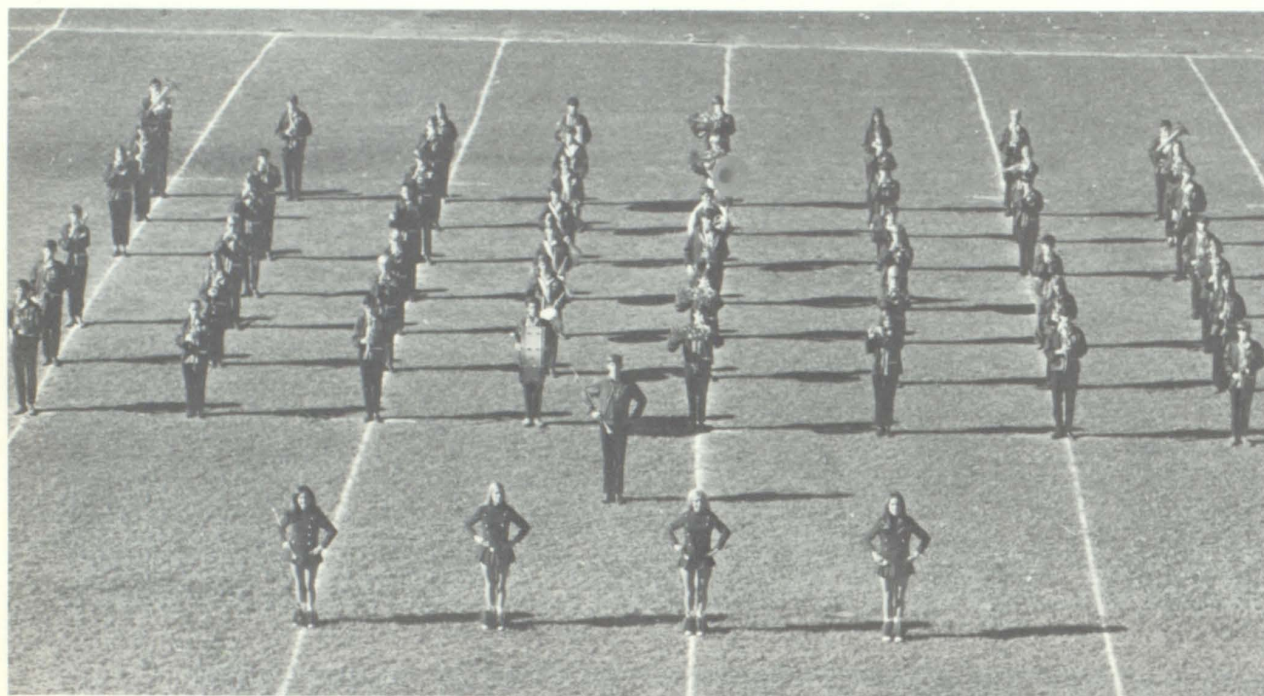
B-Team Cheerleaders

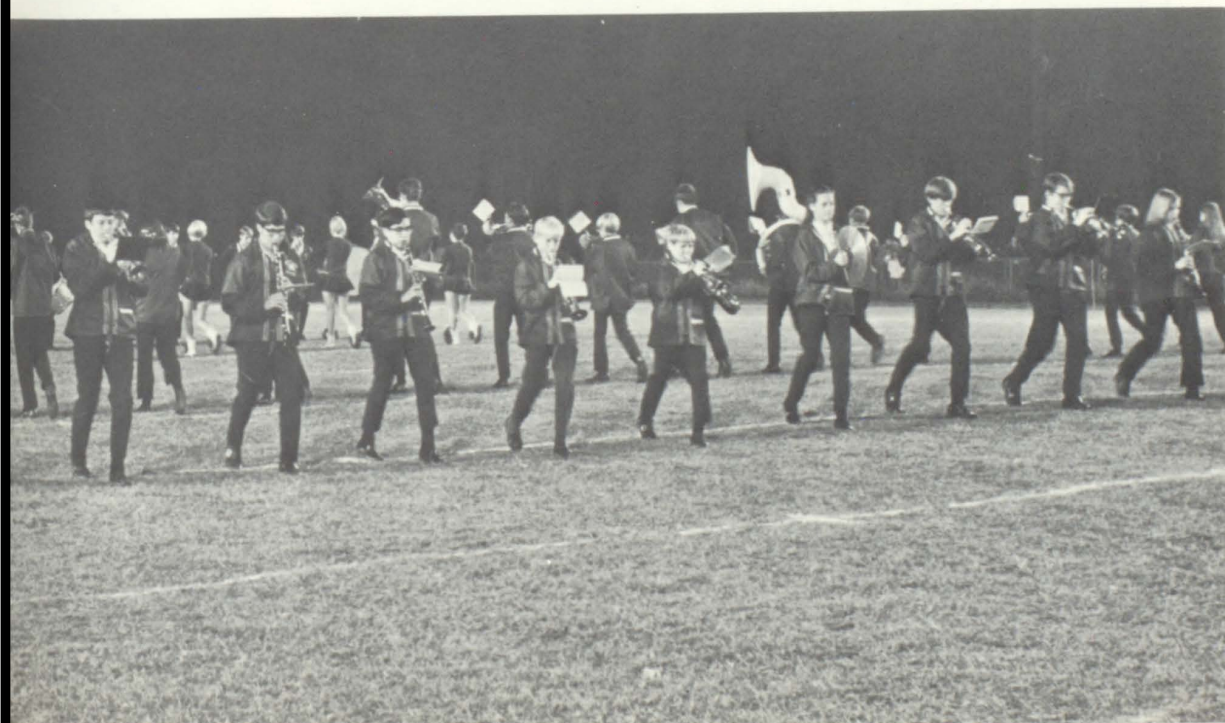






Marching Band

Orchestra And Orchestra Concert Band

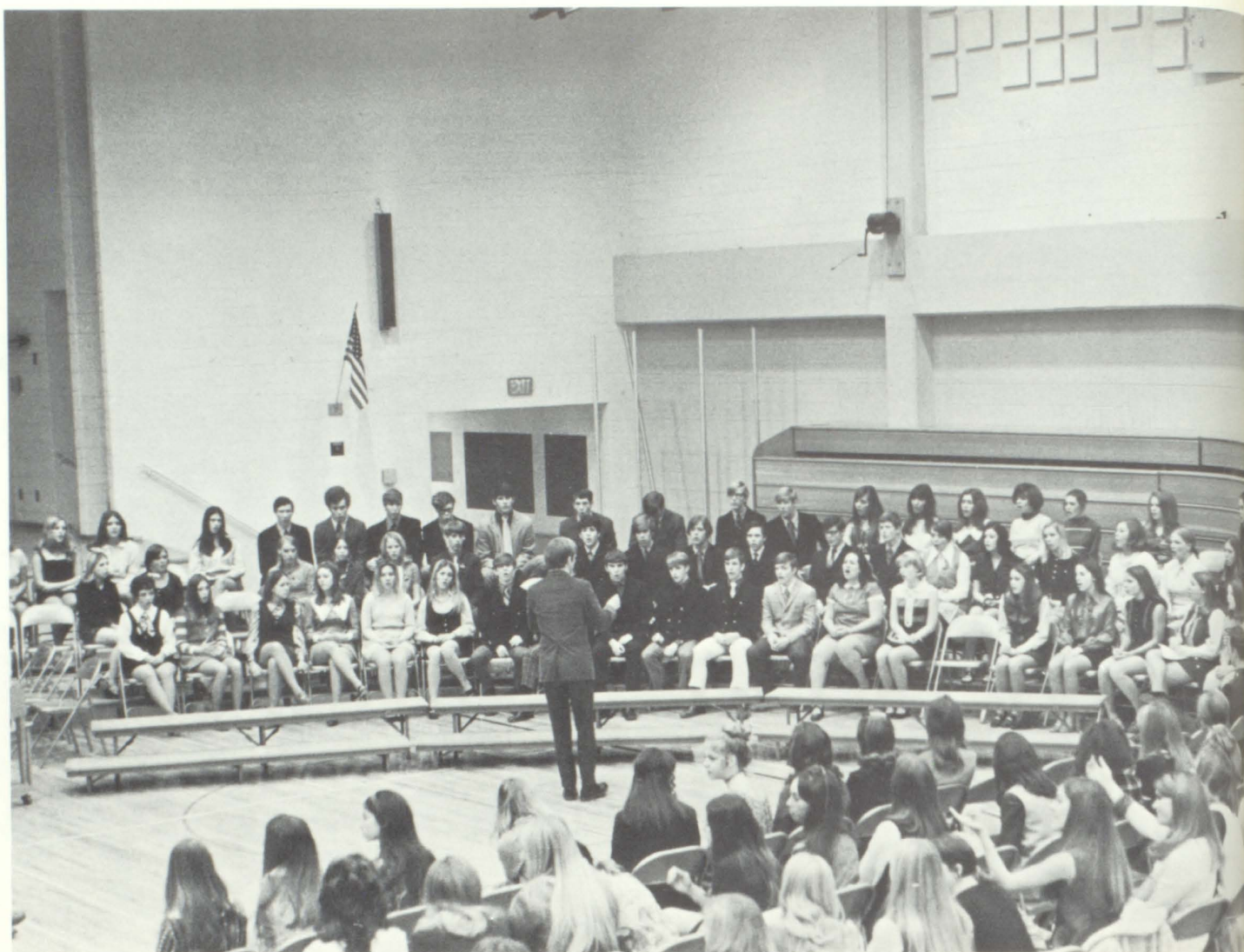

In the spring, Ridgeview's music department hosted the 5th District Music Festival. 4500 Students from 73 high schools throughout Georgia came to compete for honors.

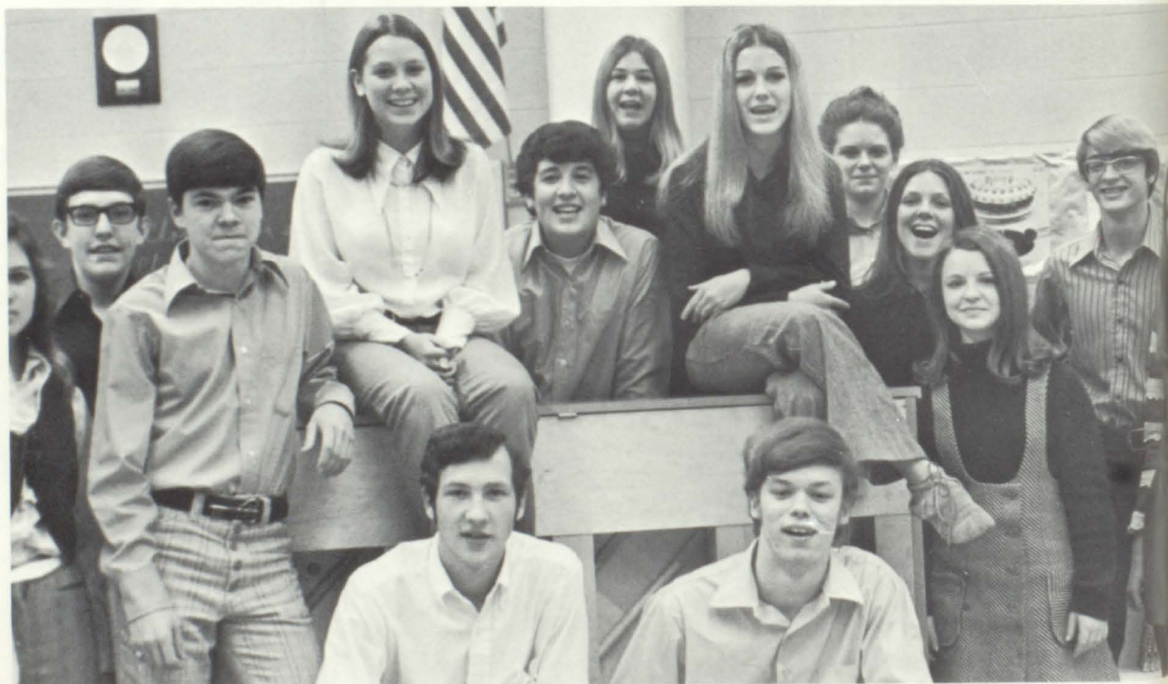

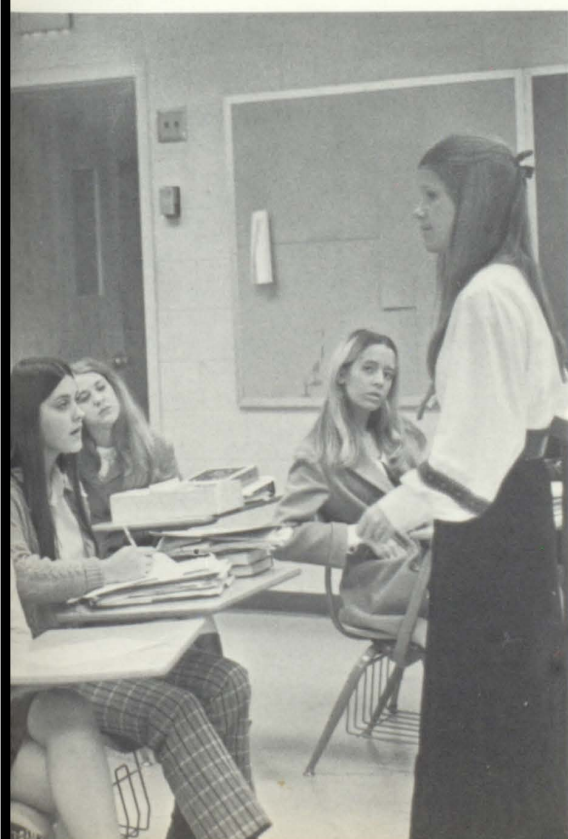


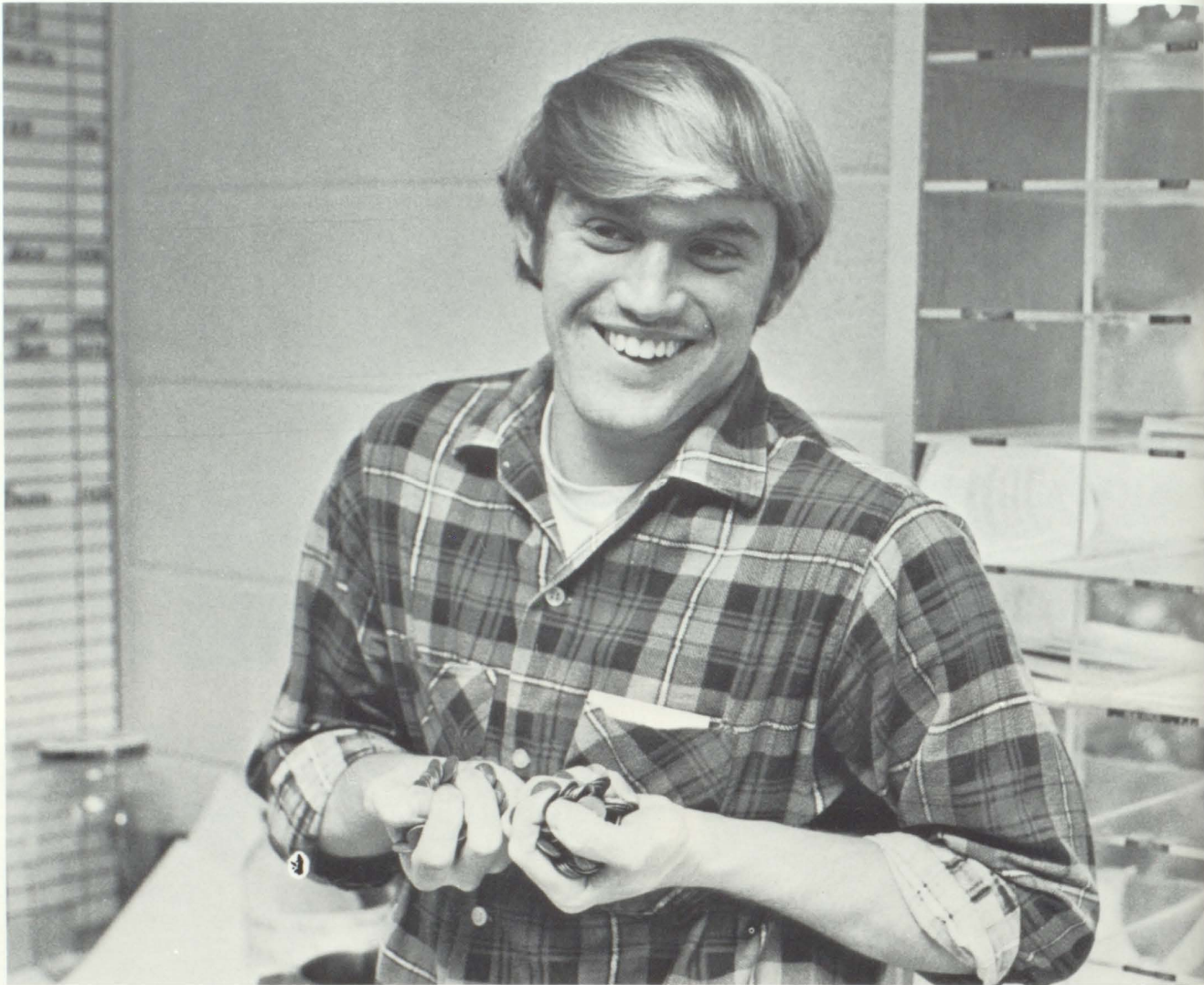
Anchor Club

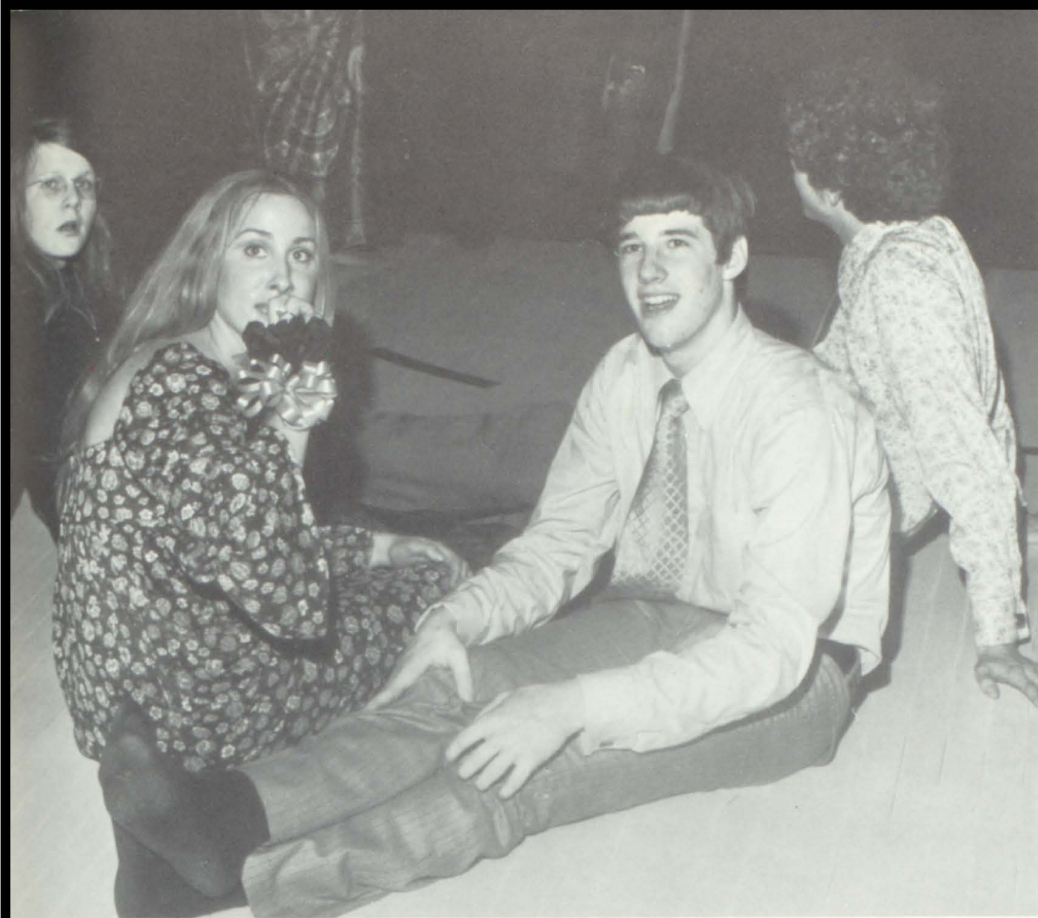
Each spring and fall the club installs new members selected from the eleventh and twelfth grades on the basis of scholarship, character, and leadership.

Key Club

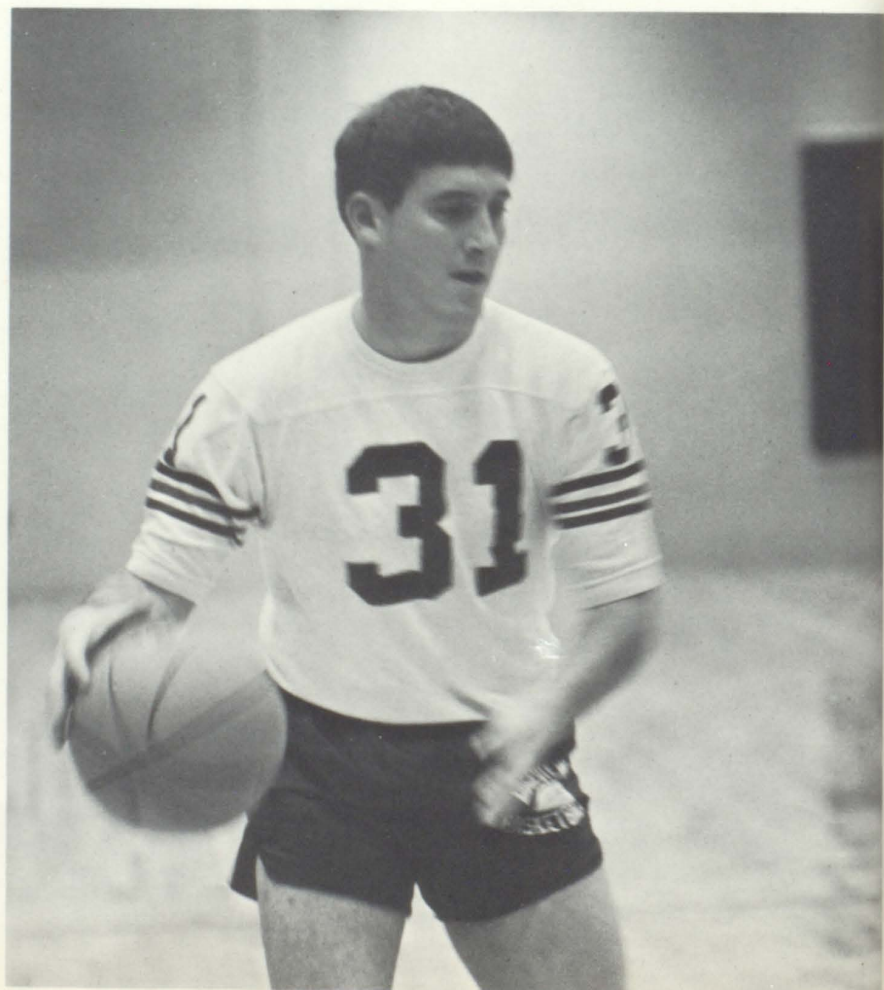

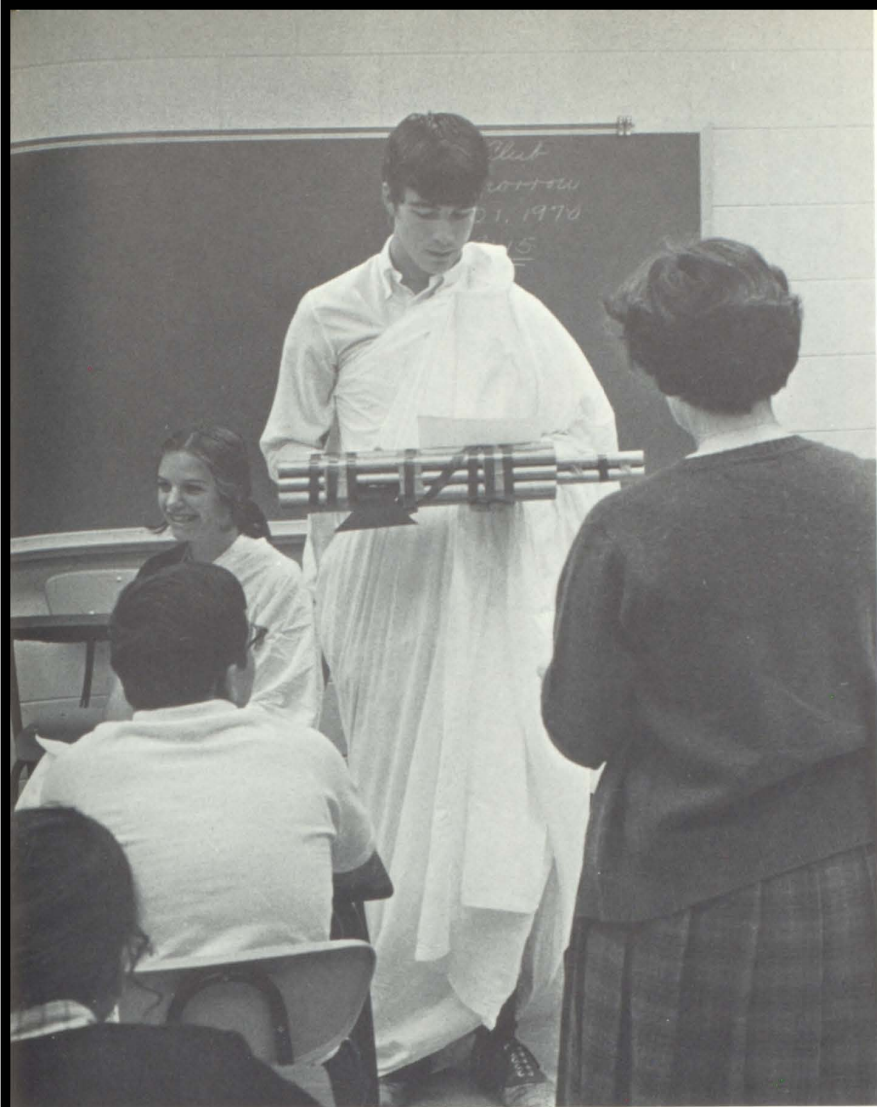




Fellowship Of Christian Athletes

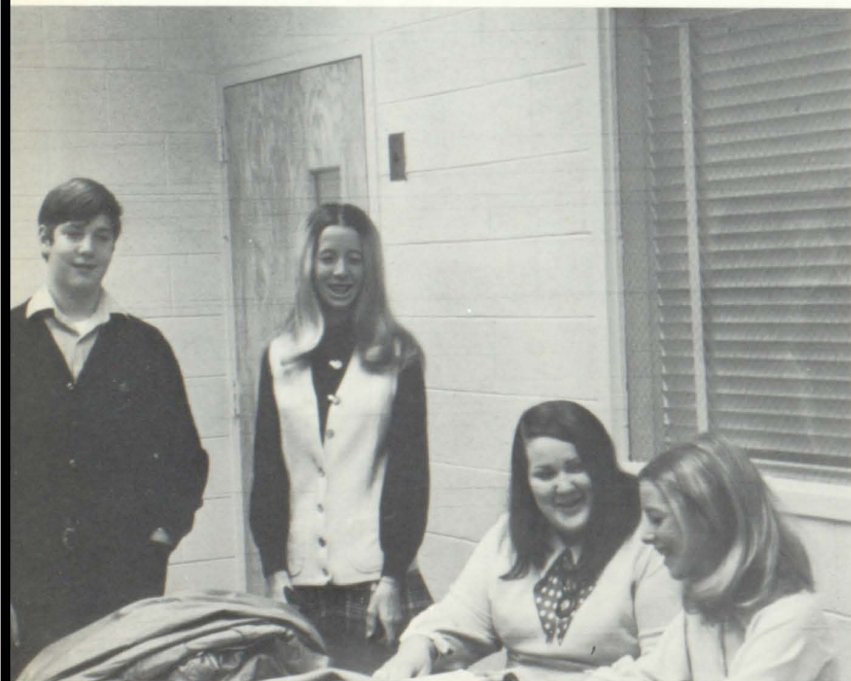
Latin Club

French Club

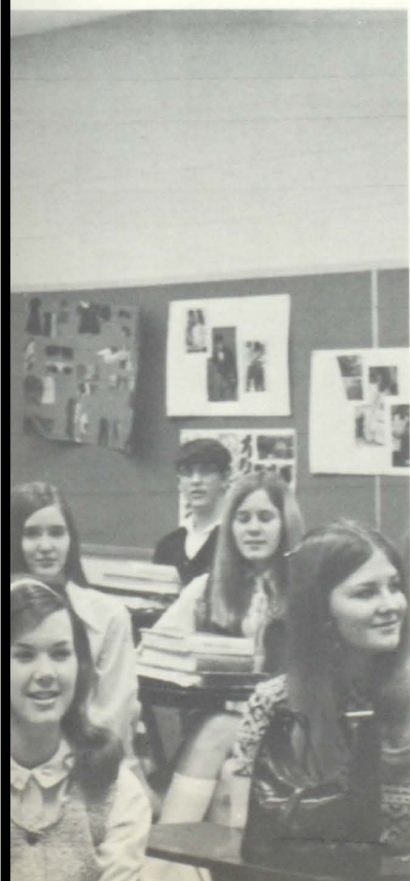

Assistance in the library and help with audio-visual facilities are the duties of the library and audio-visual aids.



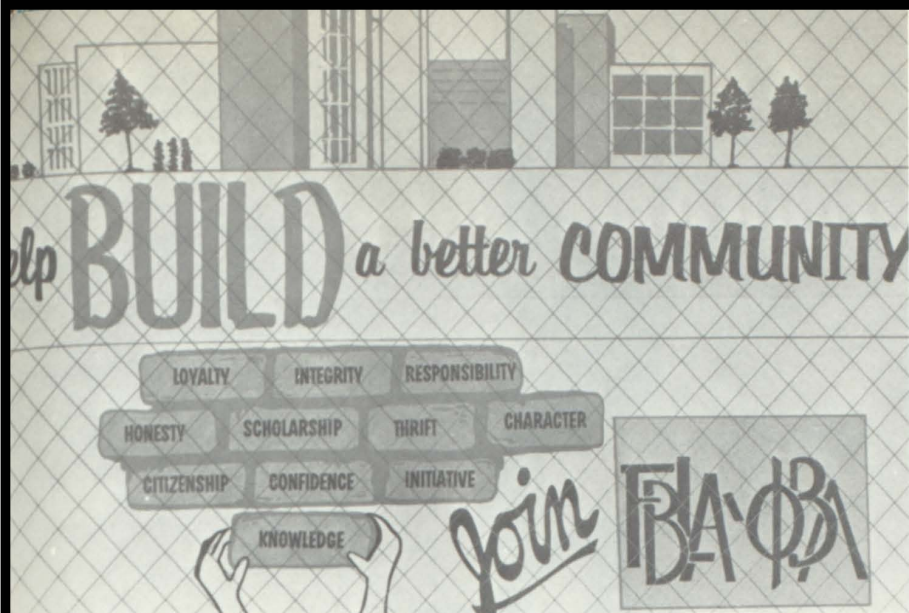


Future Homemakers Of America

In more serious functions, the club provides needy children with Thanksgiving baskets. Just as important, our Future Homemakers strive to help individuals improve personal, family, and community living.

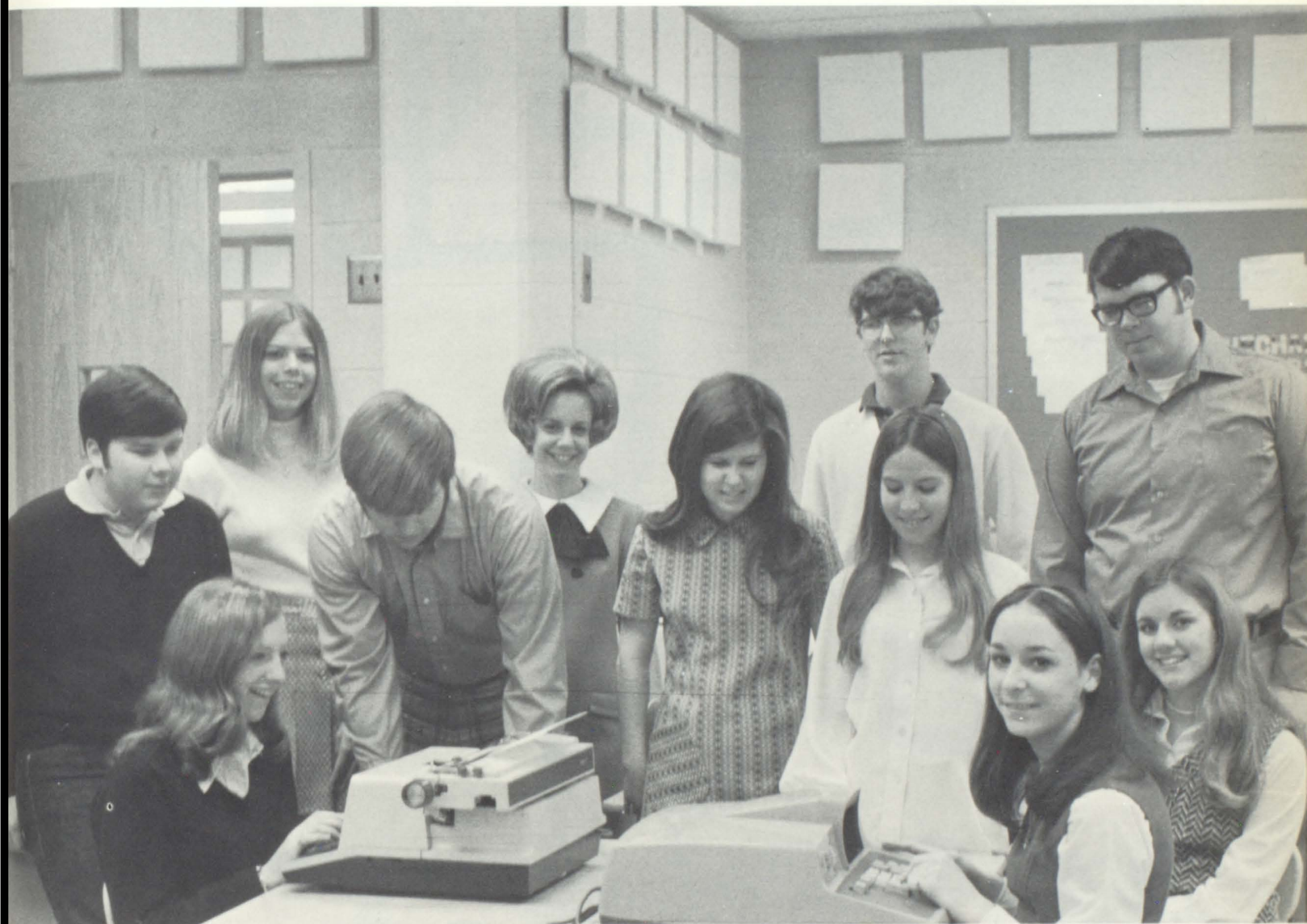


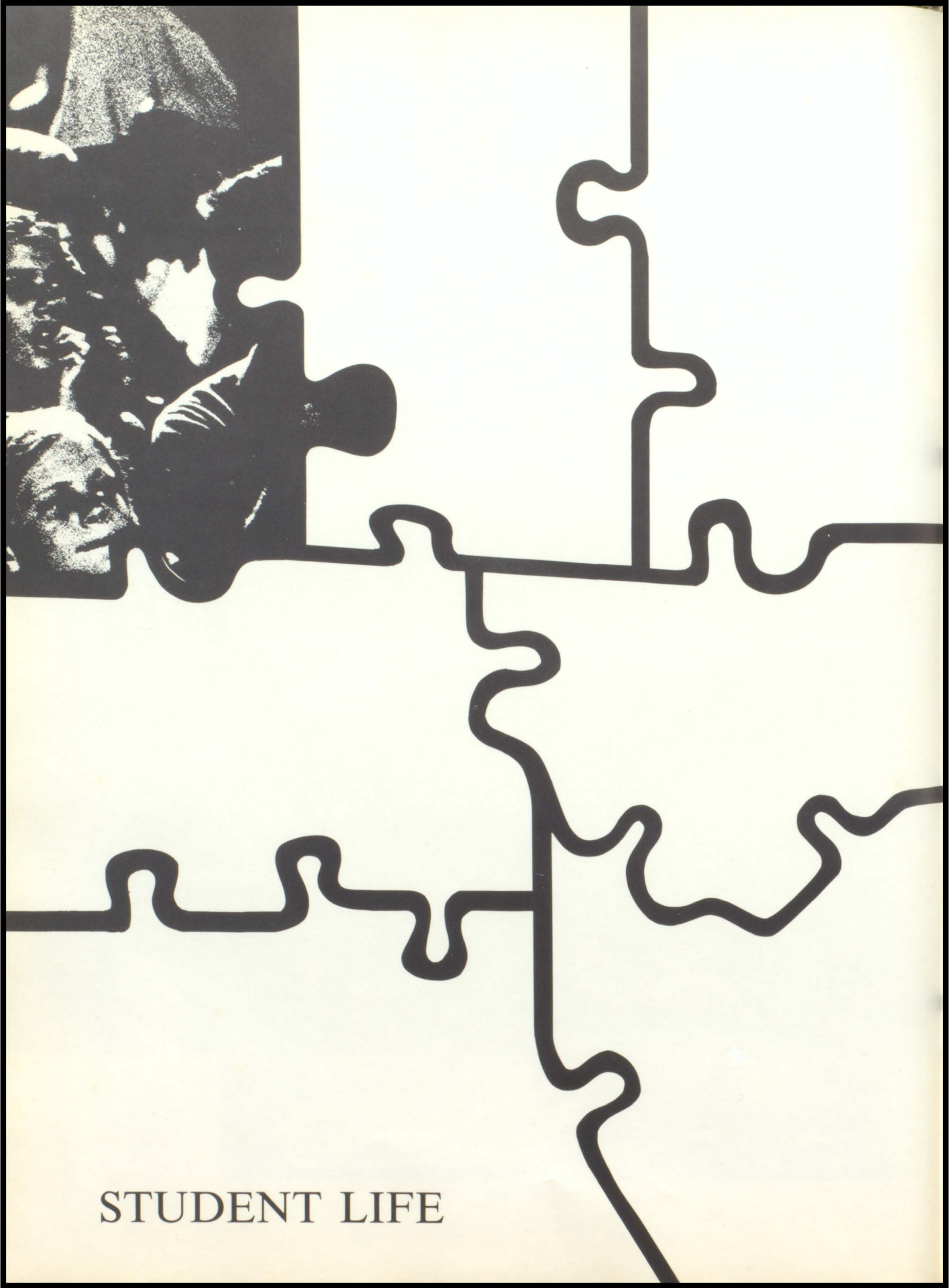


Future Business Leaders Of America



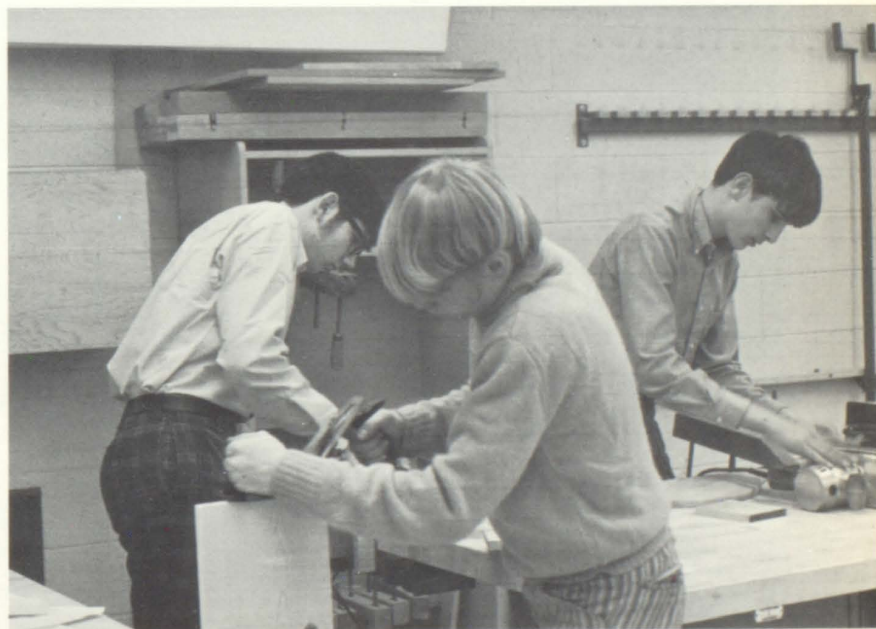
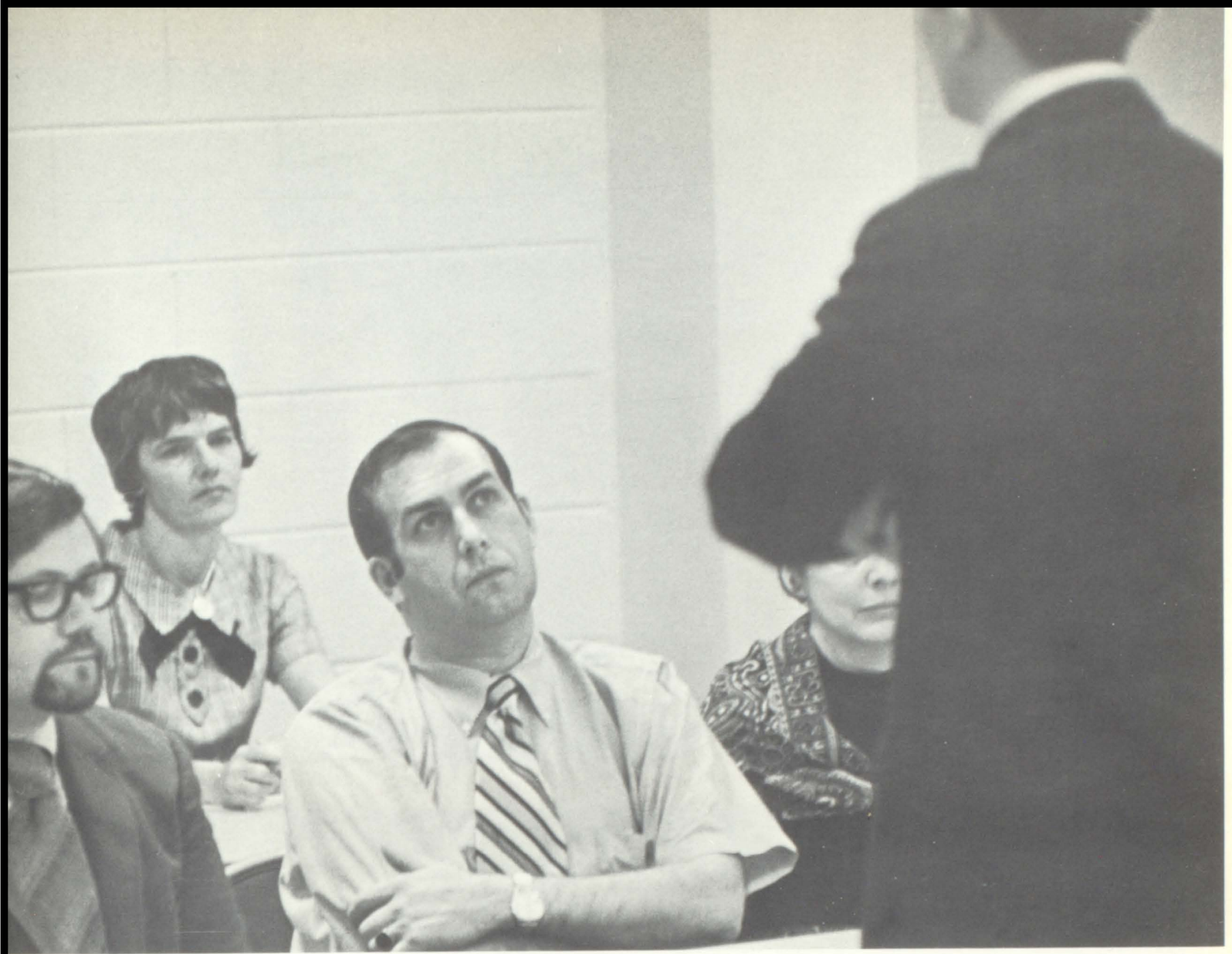


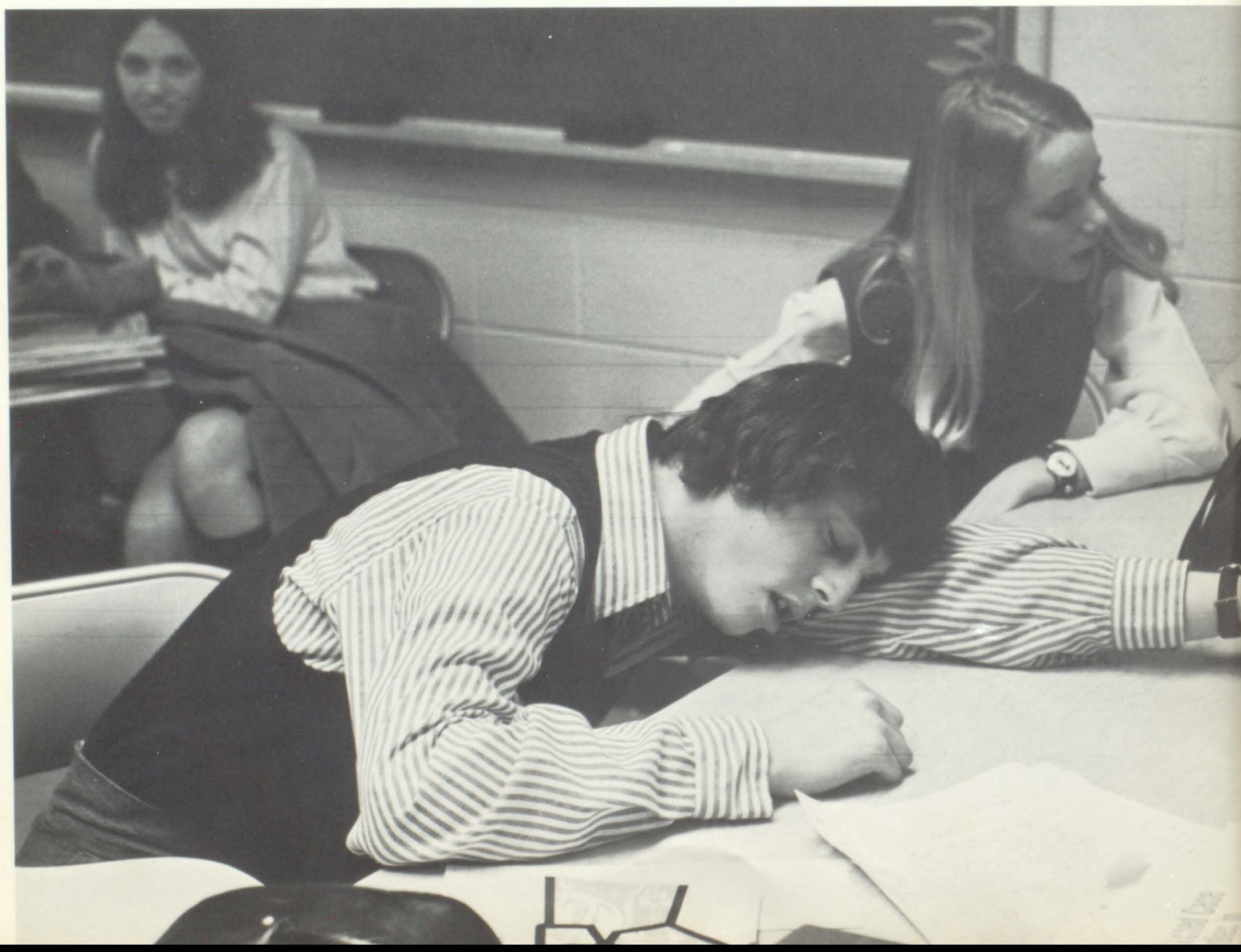
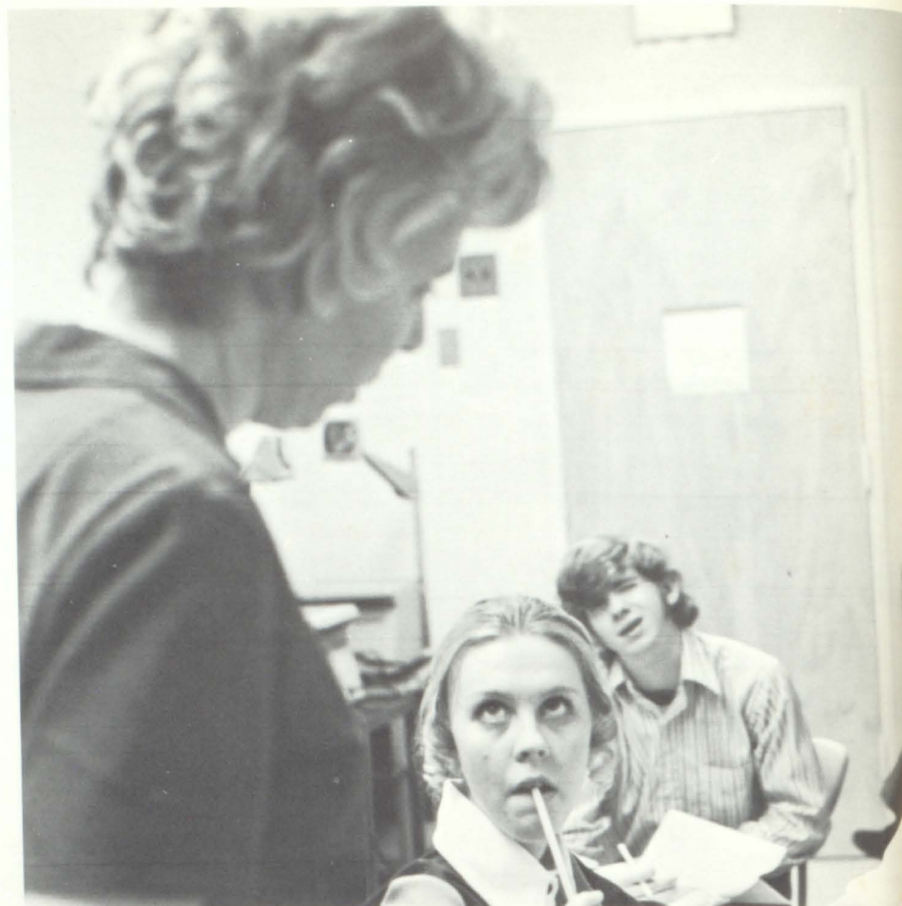


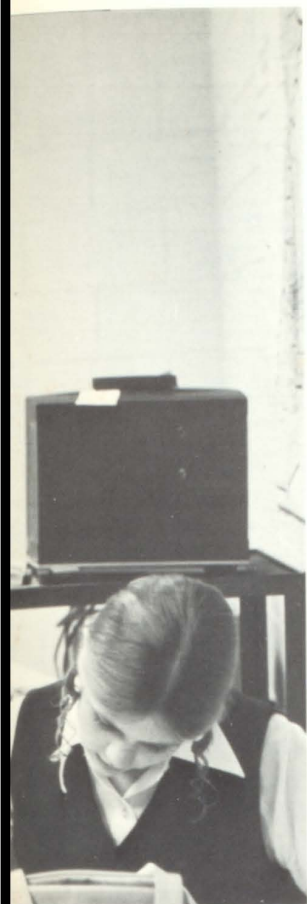


Epilogue

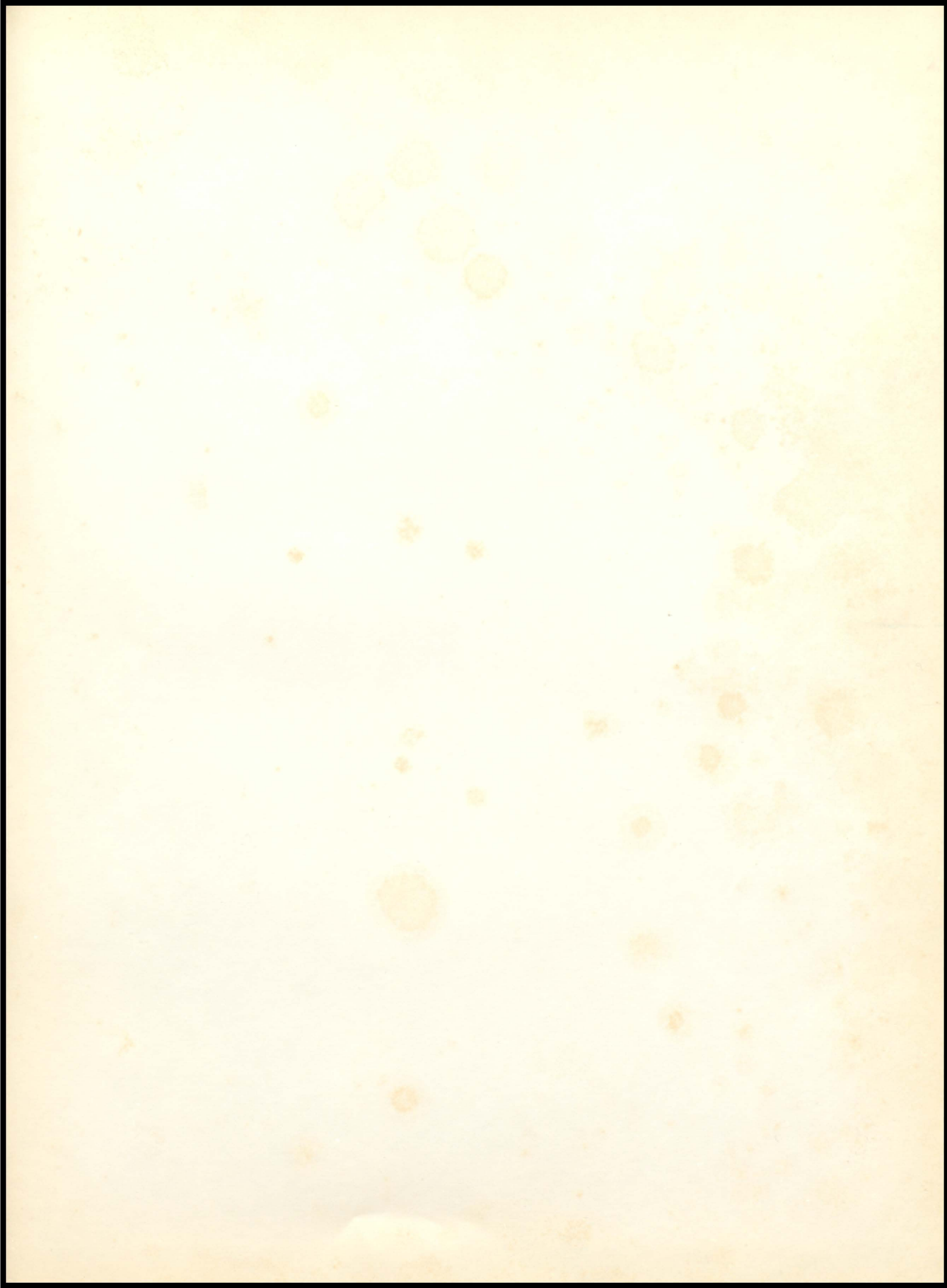
