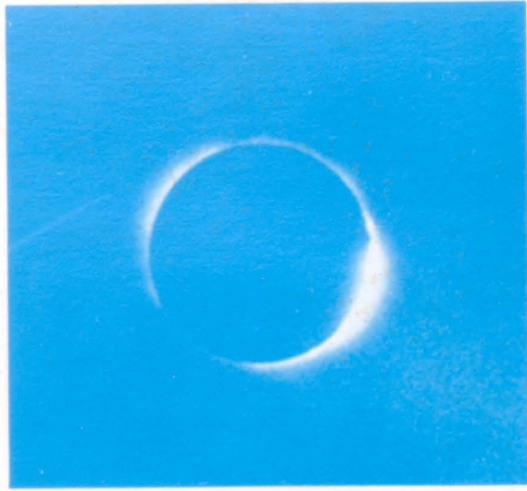
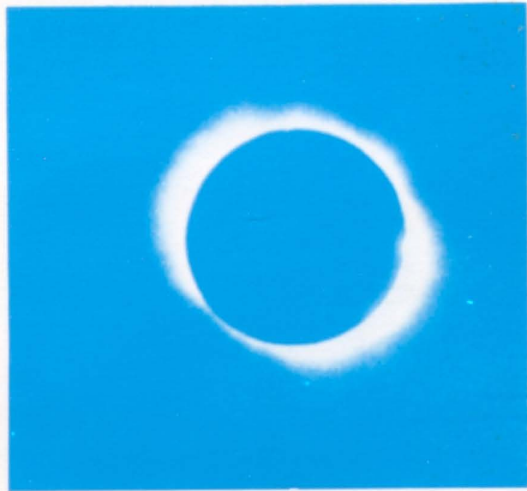
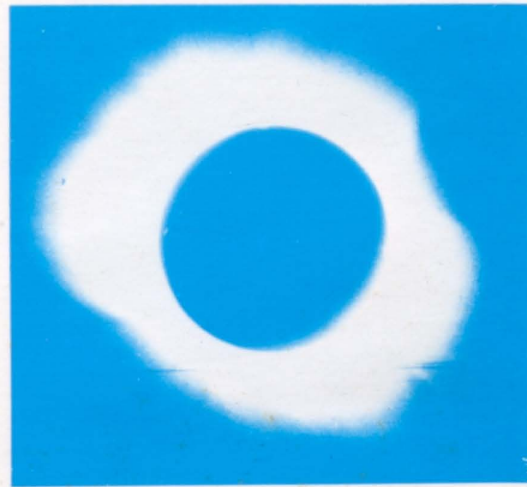

Color, Life Emotion.

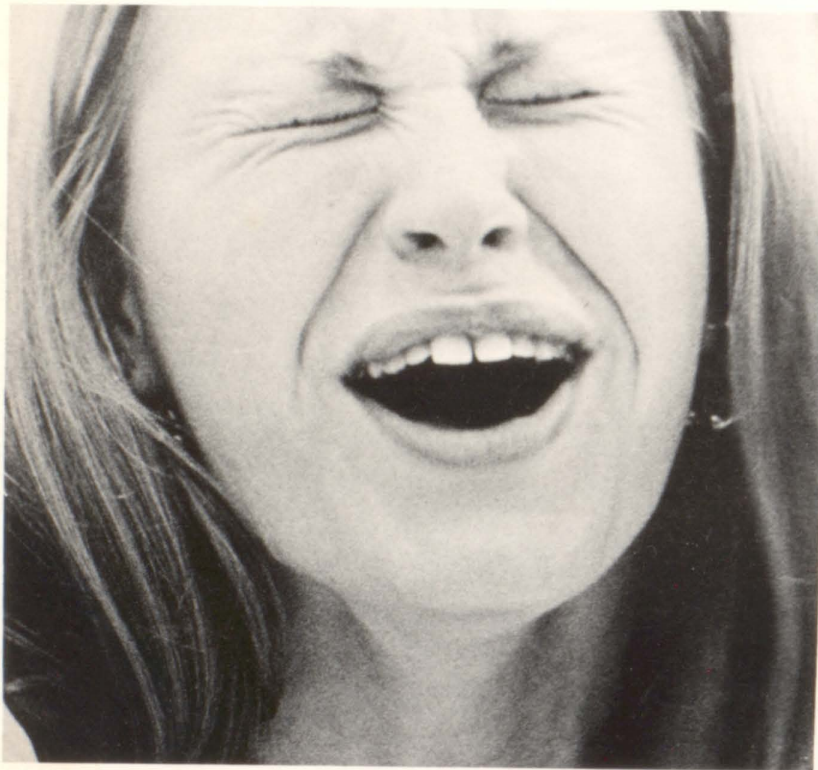




I have often dreamt of nature's wonders,

How can mankind form from dust?



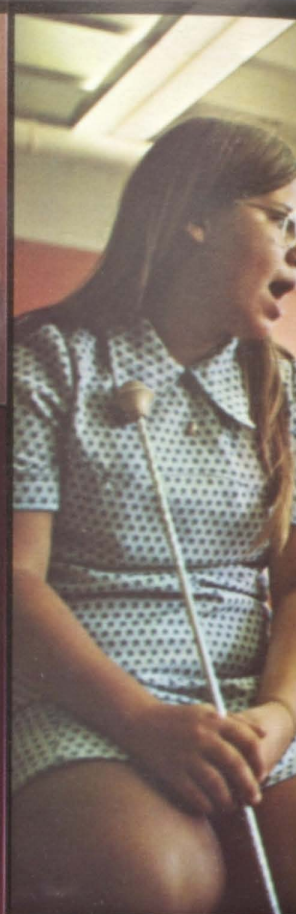
Humanity is one, in itself, and with God.

the key to existence . . .

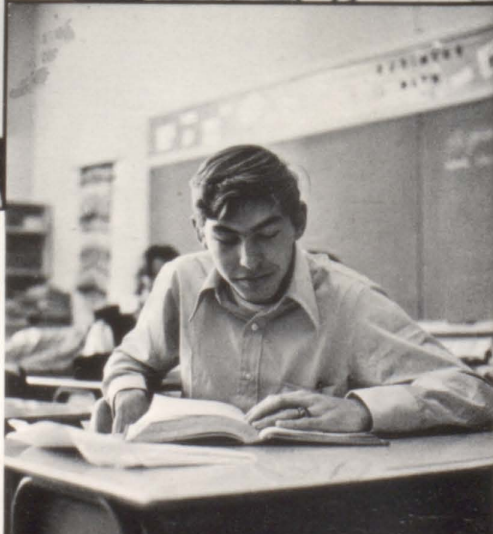


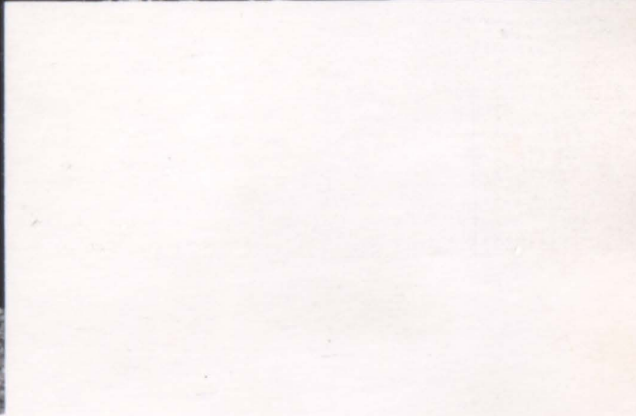
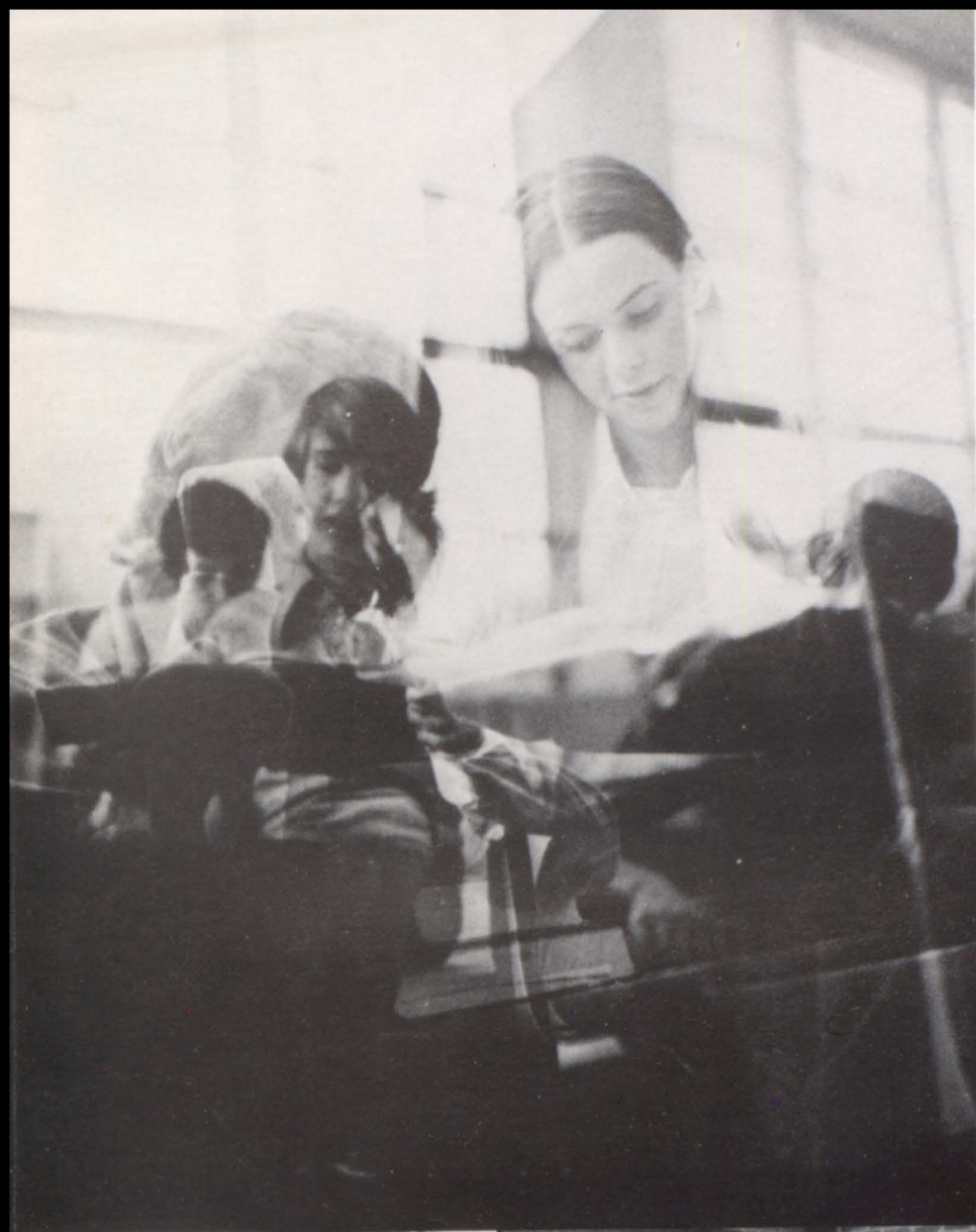




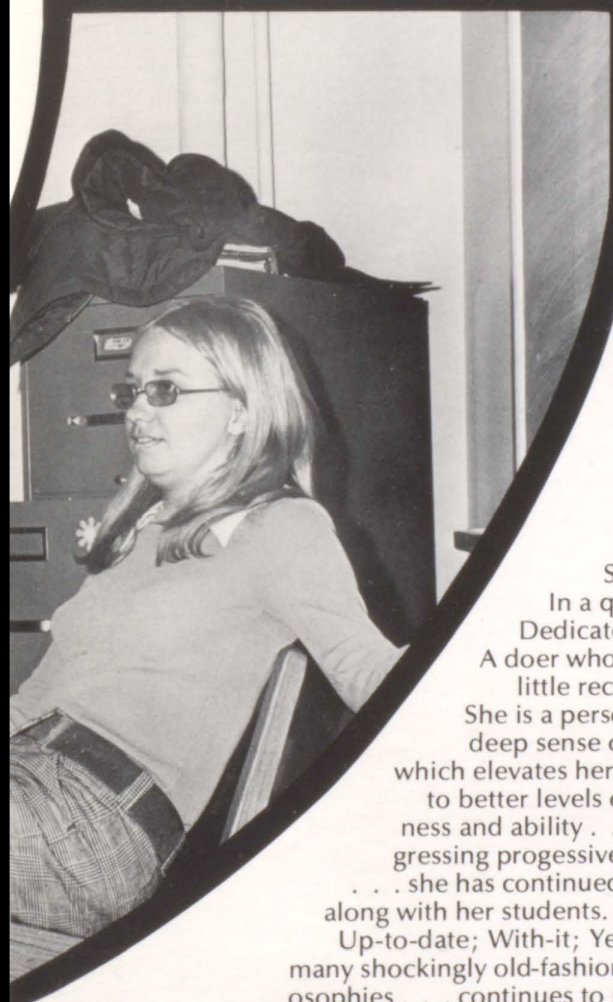
