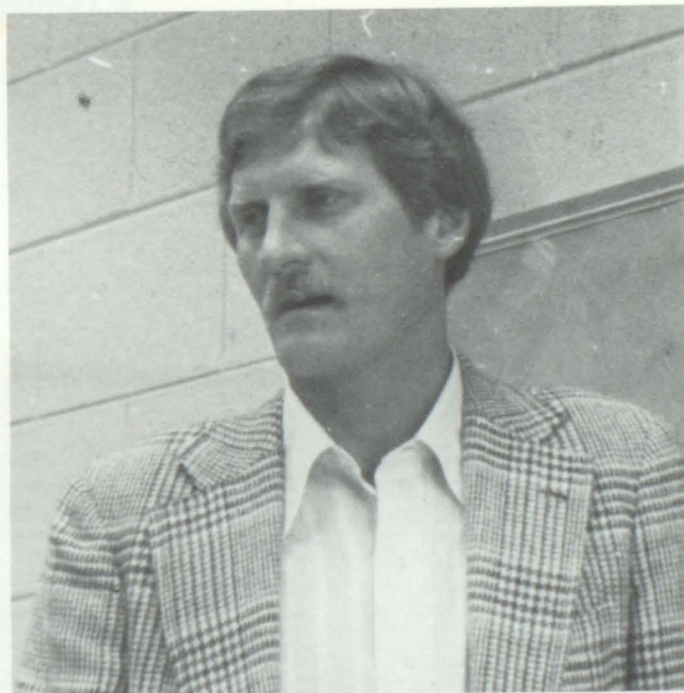


Miss Eleanor Paradise, Principal

In this Computer Age students have a chance to learn the modern technology of today's world with Ridgeview's Zenith 89 Dual Disc Drive Computer and Texas Instruments Printer. Ridgeview also has a modem, which is a telephone hook up that enables students to talk with the other Fulton County high school computers.

The Torch & Hatchet uses the computer to print their newspapers and magazines. All students have access to this computer which offers insight into possible job opportunities.



Brain waves

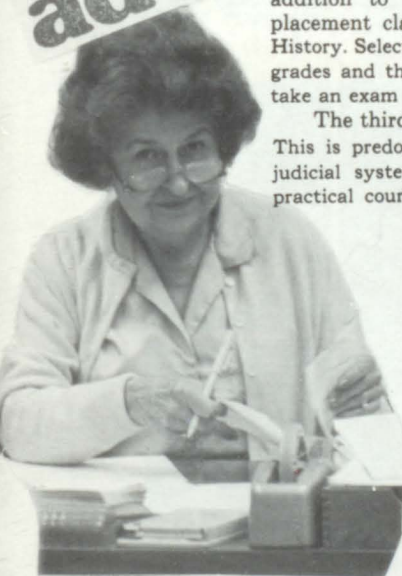
Ridgeview's Science Department offers a course which is unique in Fulton County. Mr. Bird, a former Navy pilot of 15 years and a licensed commercial pilot, teaches Aviation Science. The students learn the aerodynamics of flying, the effects of wind and atmospheric conditions on the plane, and navigation. As an extracurricular activity Mr. Bird takes the students flying and gives them a chance to work the controls of a Cessna 172. This course provides valuable experience in a possible career.

The Social Studies Department offers three special courses in addition to the regular classes. Two of these are advanced placement classes, one in U.S. History and the other in World History. Selection in A.P. is based on students previous social studies grades and their academic ability. In the spring, the A.P. students take an exam and if their scores are high, they receive college credit.

The third special course is Law which is taught by Mrs. Cox. This is predominantly a senior class in which students study the judicial system and its development. This is an interesting and practical course that can be used in everyday life.

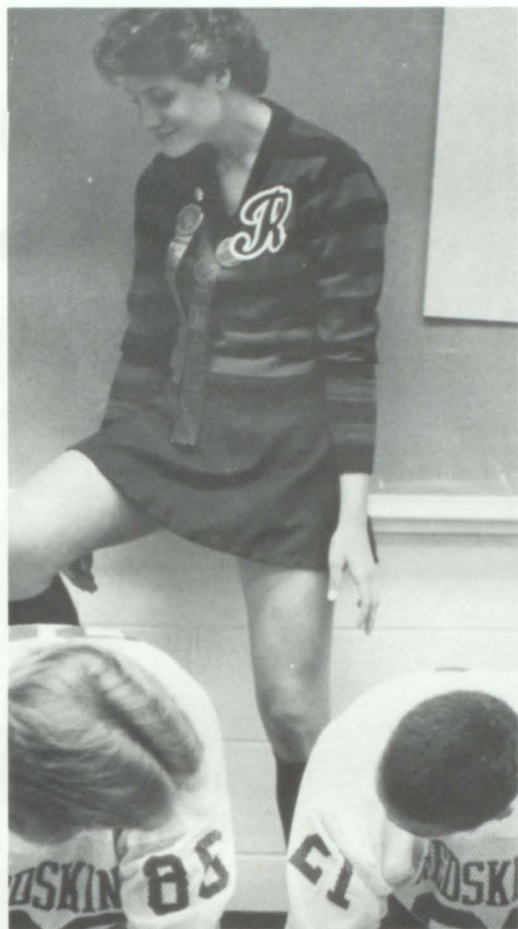
CONCLUSION

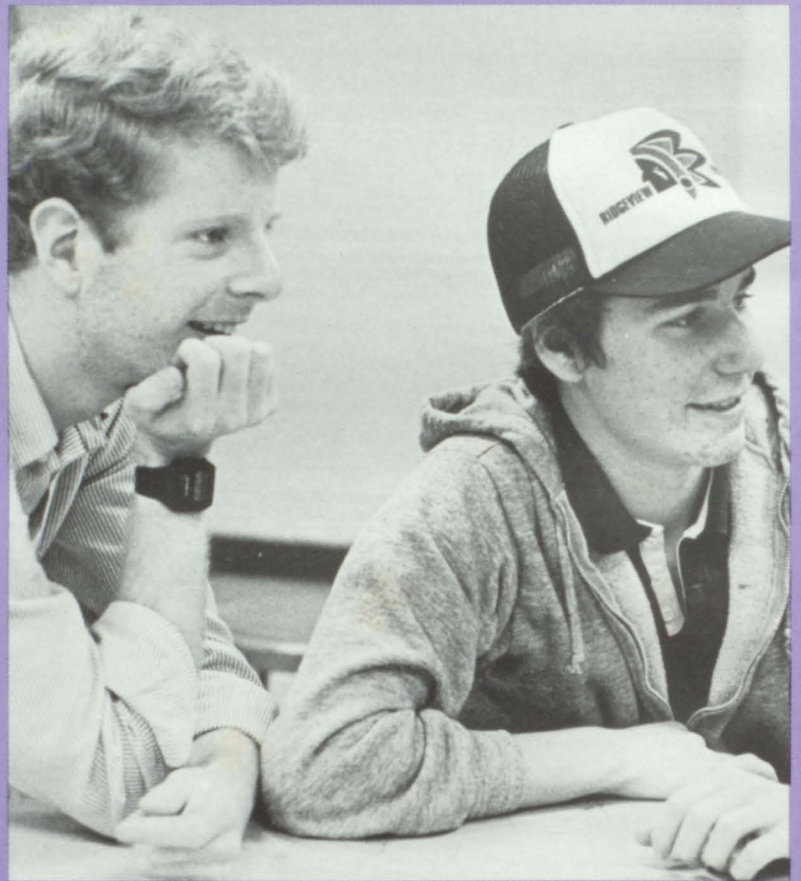
1982-1983

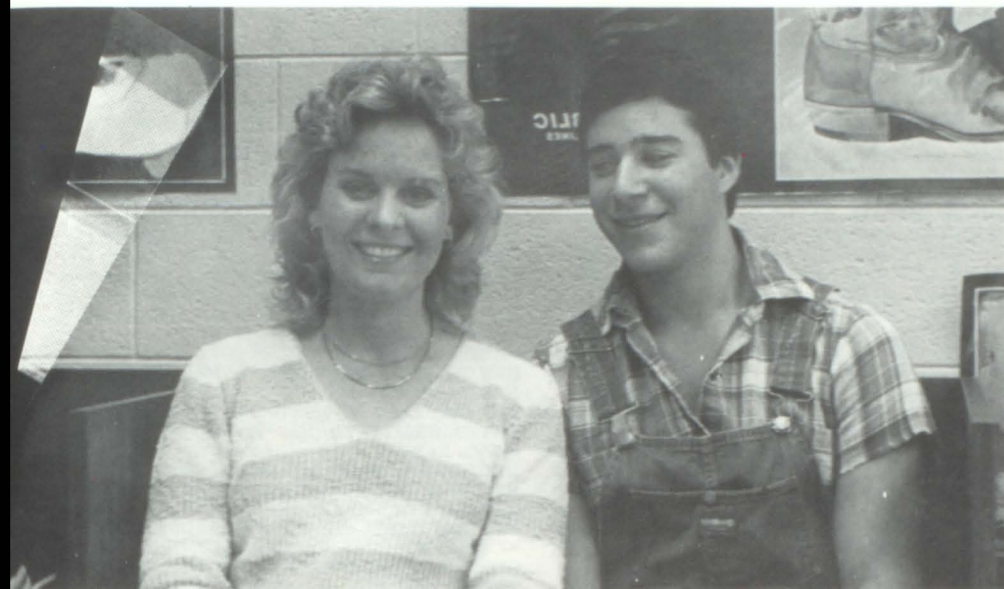
