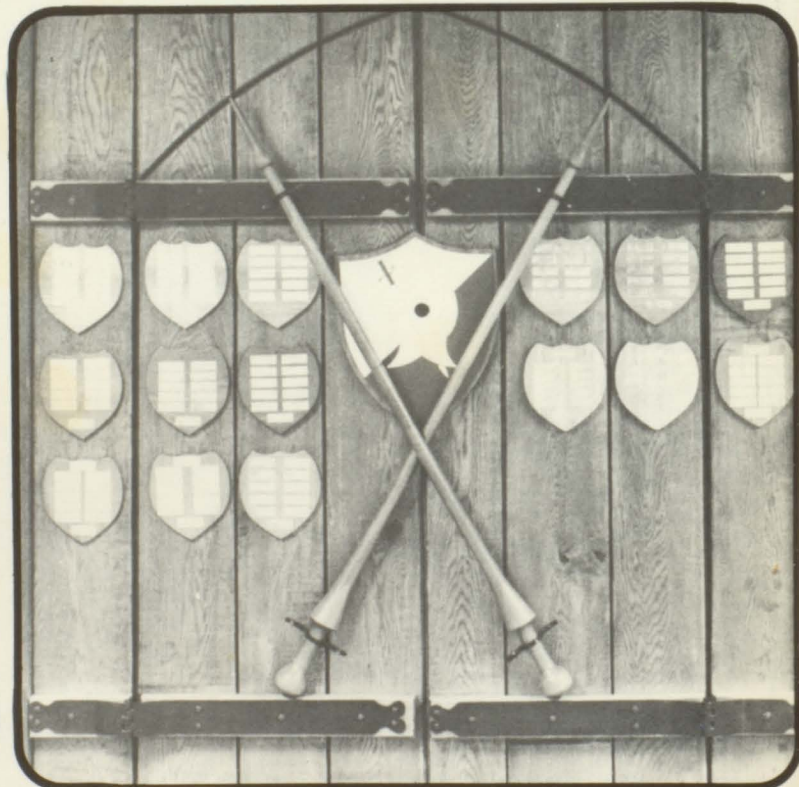




And last but far from least, we stopped at Frontierland, risking our lives under the frequent attacks of wild indians, and becoming the first brave pioneers to settle Lakeshore.

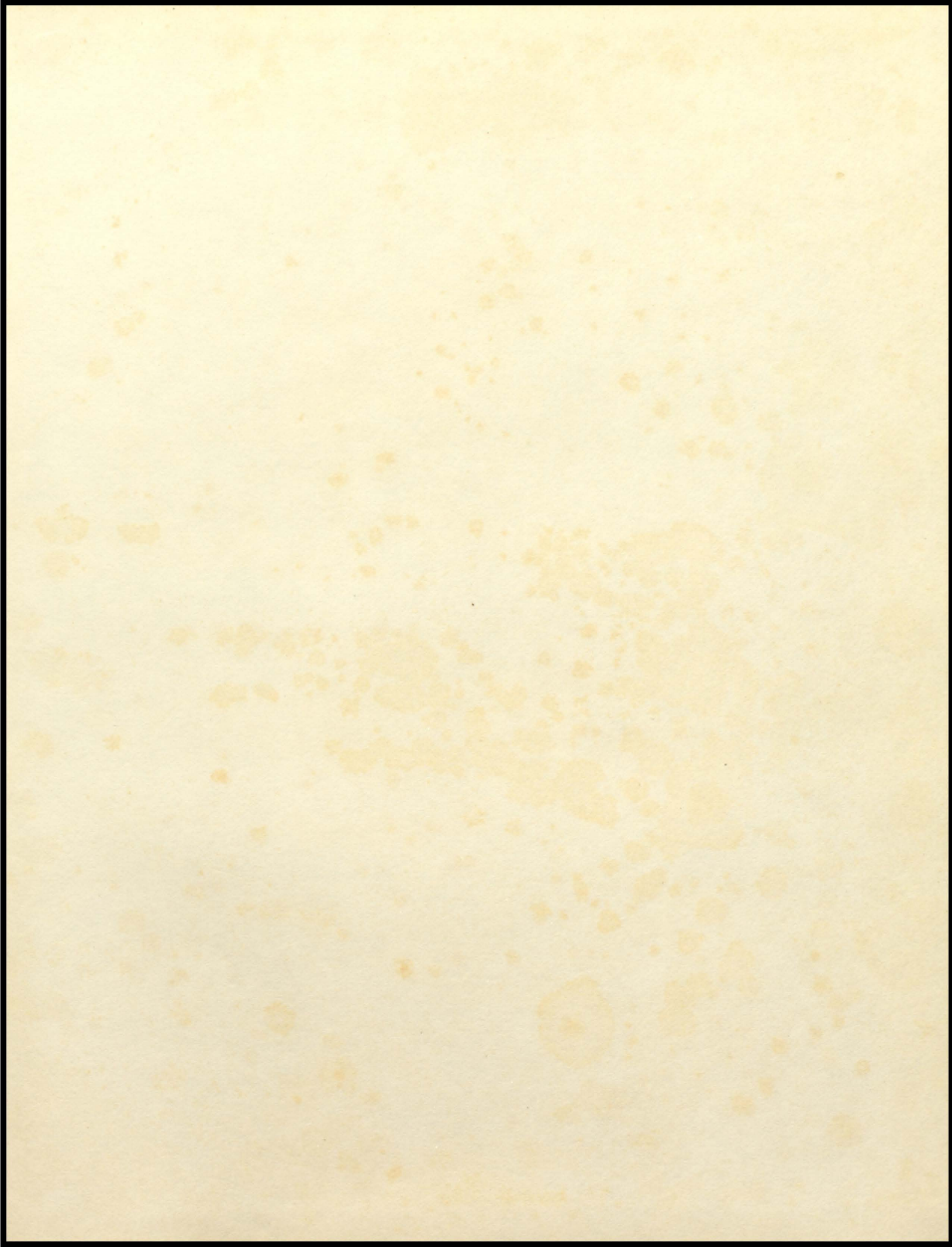

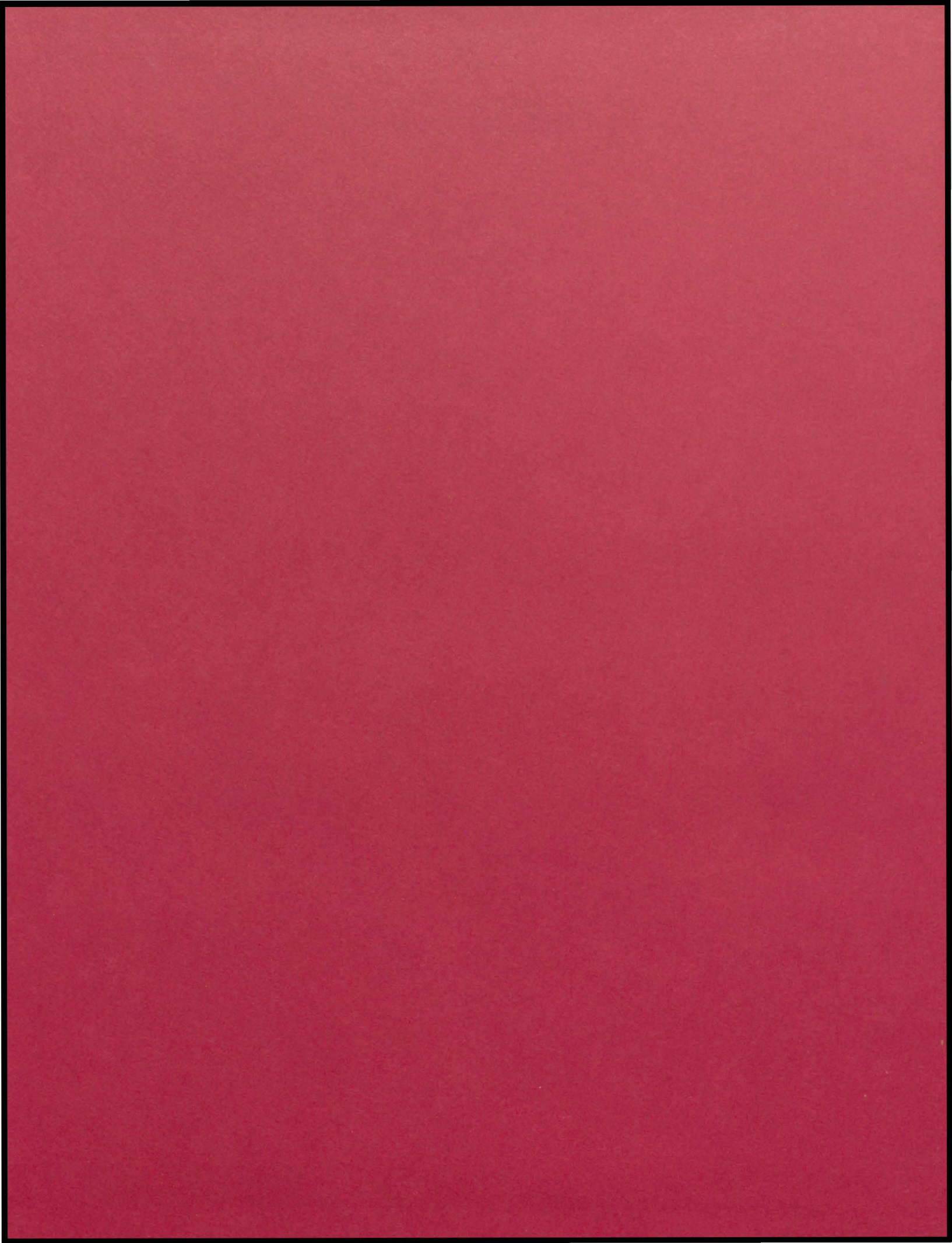

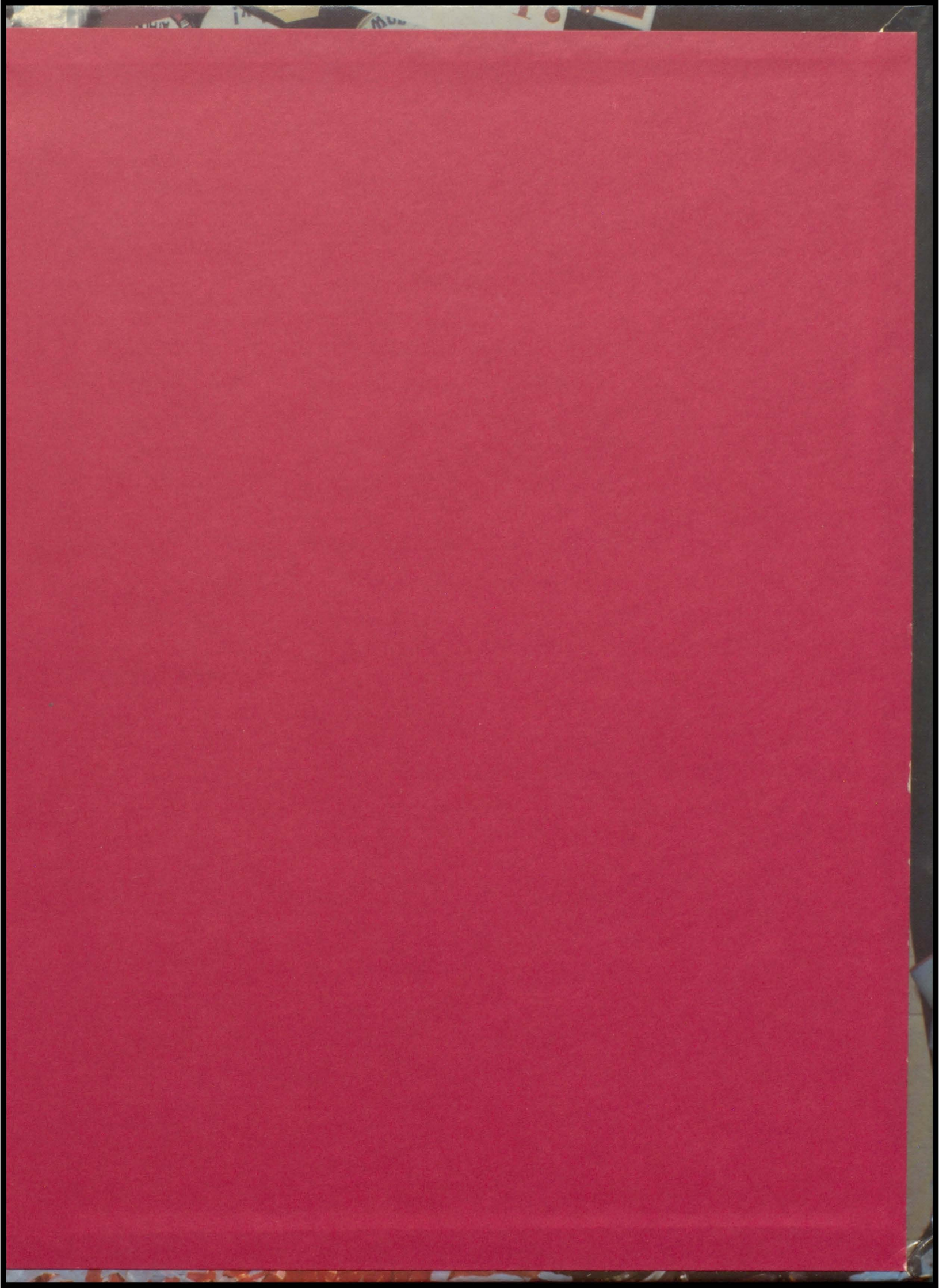
