ENGLISH


The English Department at North Springs plays a vital part in the student's liberal arts education. Much stress is placed on the humanities and the development of personal values. The teachers, headed by Miss Virginia Griscom, strive to present thegreat Anglo-American cultural heritage and try to correlate historical trends with literary ones.

In addition to intensive studies of literature in each class, the students also work to learn both new and traditional grammar and sentence structure. They are drilled for development of strong and rich vocabularies. They are taught the etymology of their language through concentration on linguistics and basic language patterns and principles. Each student is encouraged to read a large and varied collection of books to prepare himself better for later life.
