ENGLISH



The English Department at North Springs plays a vital part in the student's liberal arts education. Much stress is placed on the humanities and the development of personal values. 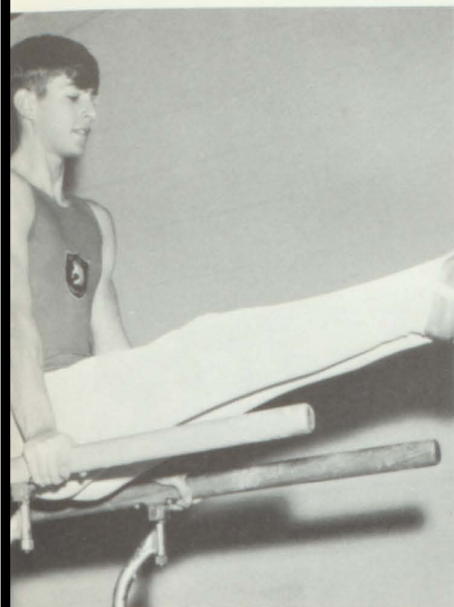

To enhance their success, the Spartans had the pleasure of beating their arch-rival Sandy Springs 44-11.

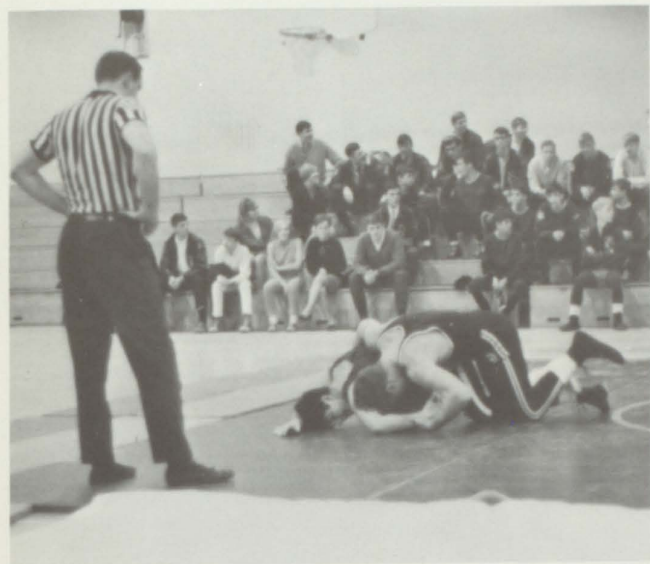

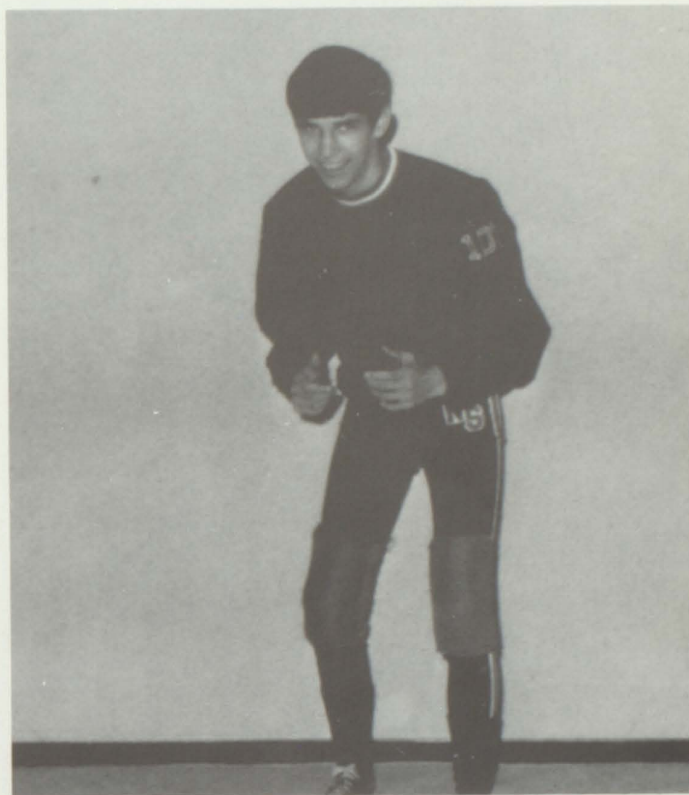

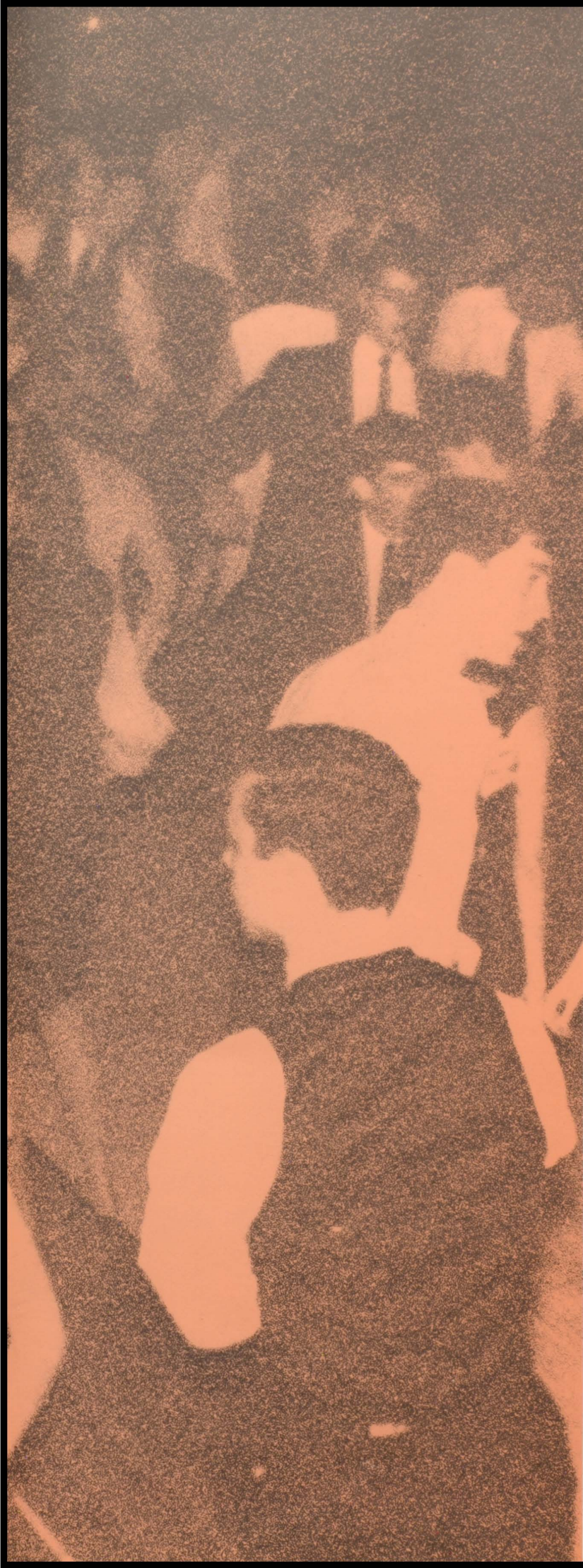
