slowly he approaches maturity





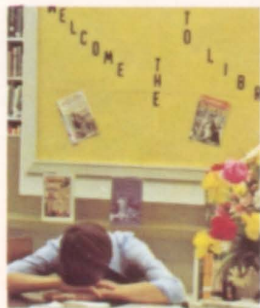
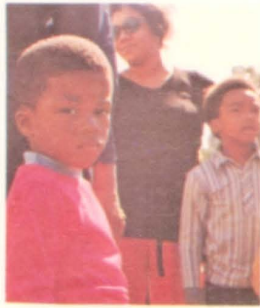
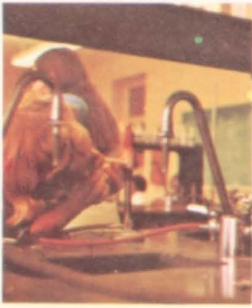
maturity, experience, judgment, wisdom, responsibility

someone who his children can look up to

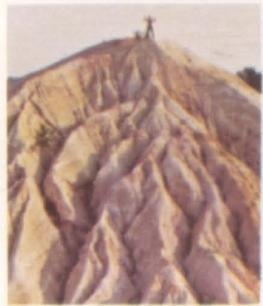




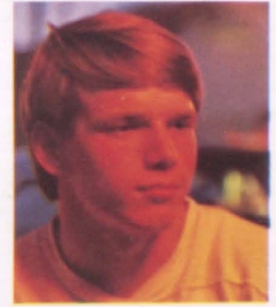
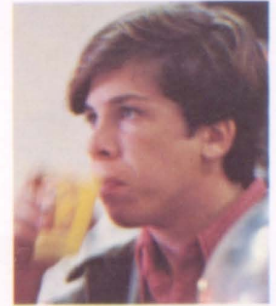
we are now at a medium of life

our last turn



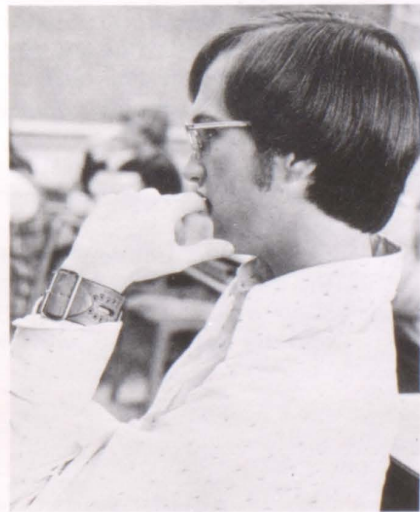




the end is destruction

 we present 'the 1972 aries'







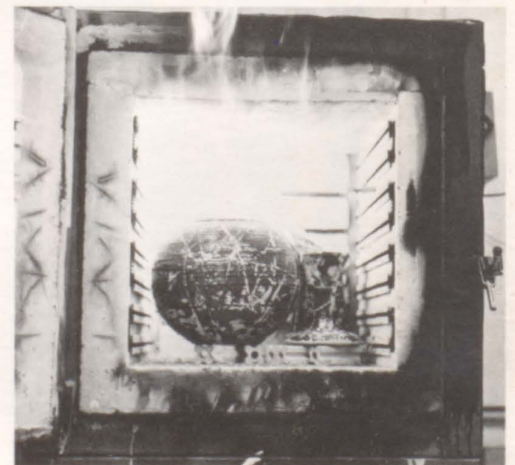


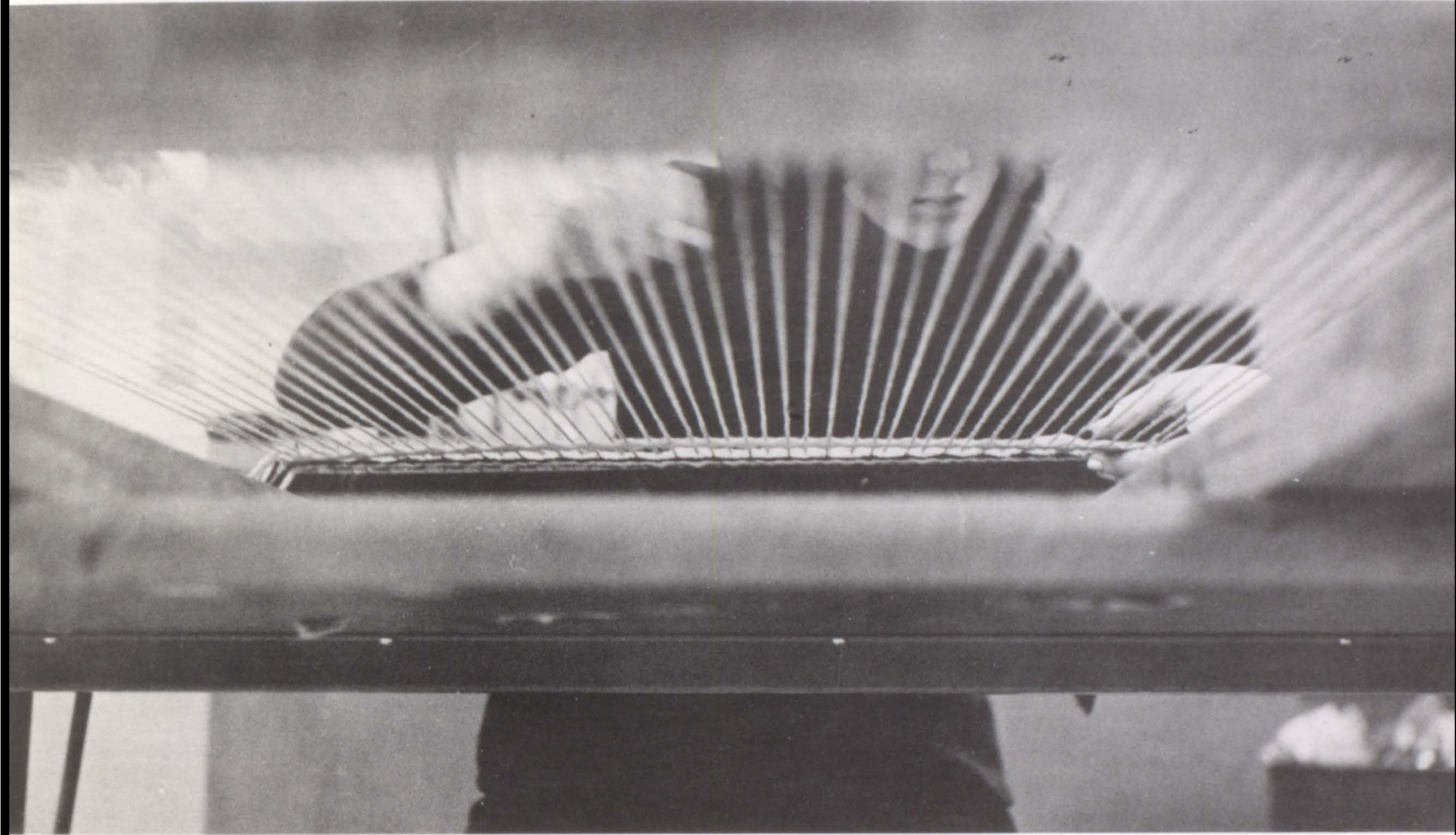
there was a child went forth every day,

and the water-plants with their graceful flat heads, all become part of him.





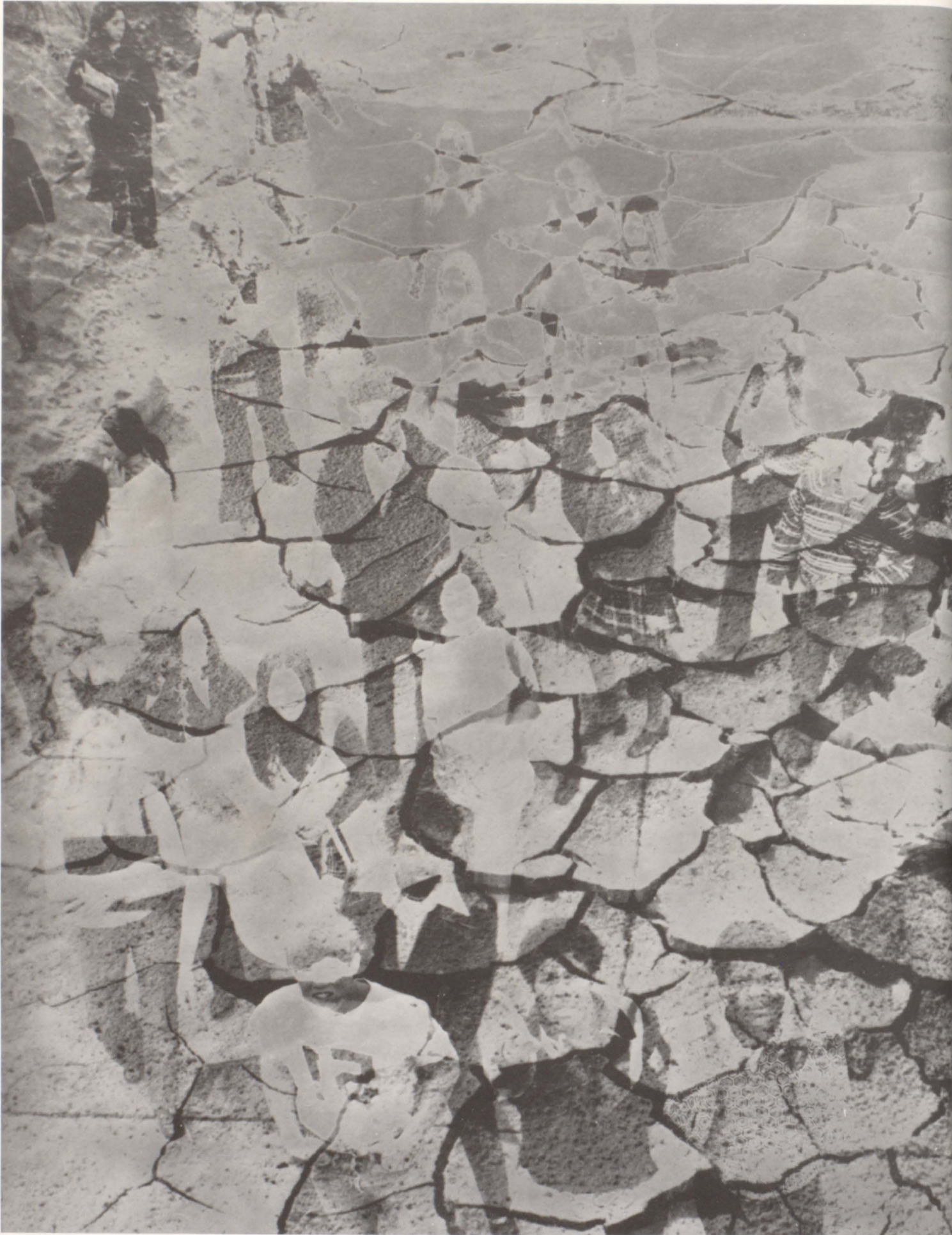
the field-sprouts of Fourth-month and Fifth-month became part of him,
