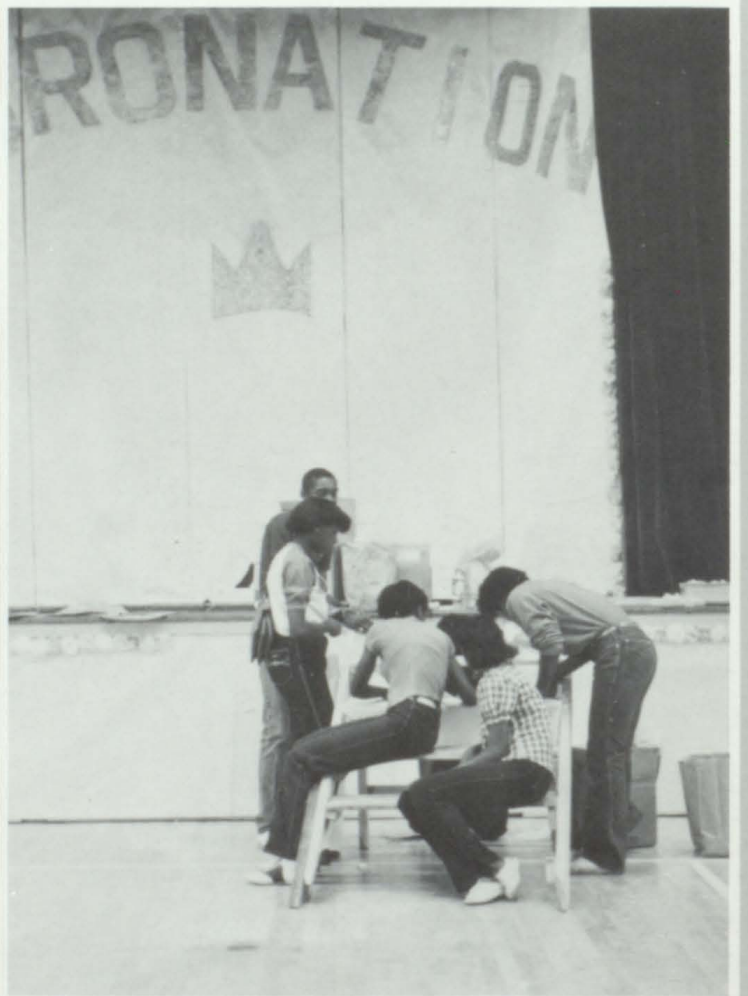
## PREPARATION

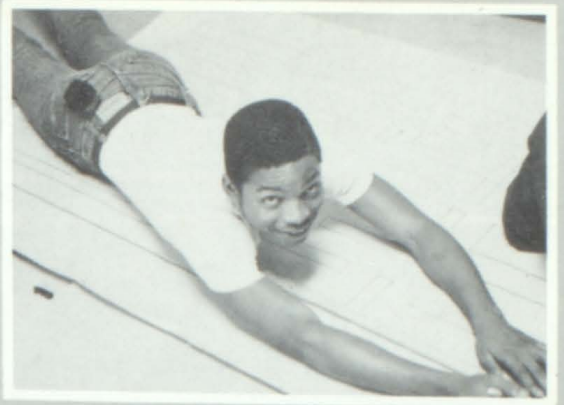
## SPIRIT HALLS

# BRONZE REMINISCENCE



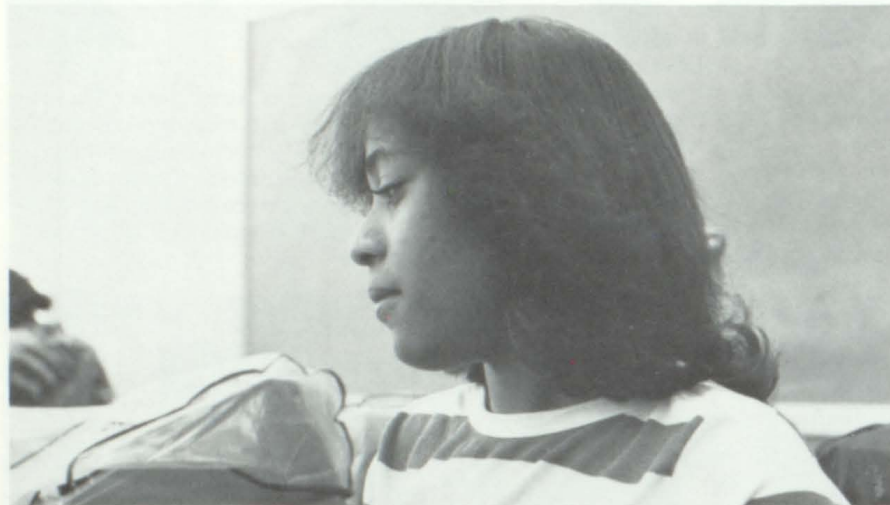
