Language Arts





Courses offered in this department are World History, American History, American Problems, and Psychology.




Taendas

Thanks to Mr. Lloyd Peterson, this problem was virtually solved during the 1967-1968 School year.




Mr. Peterson did an excellent job of taking royalty pictures as well as sports pictures and many of the candid.




