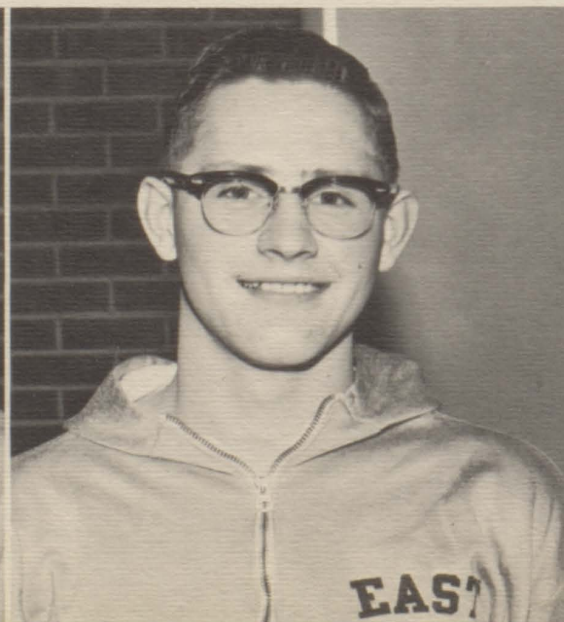
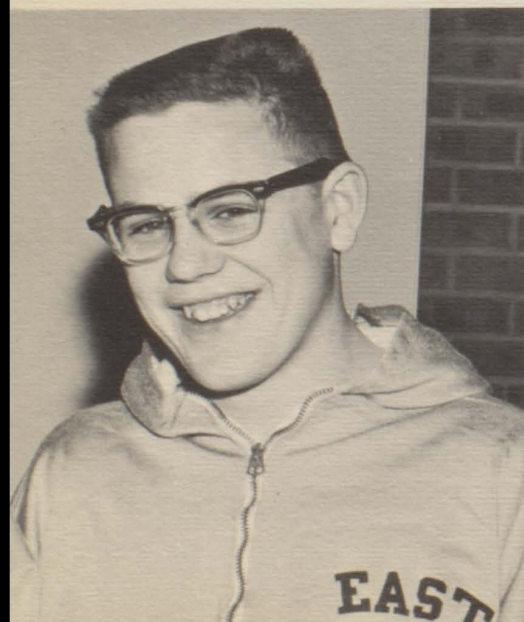
Under Coach Art Phillips, T-Bird grapplers ended the season with a break-even record, having won some important contests and dropping a few to some tough opposition.

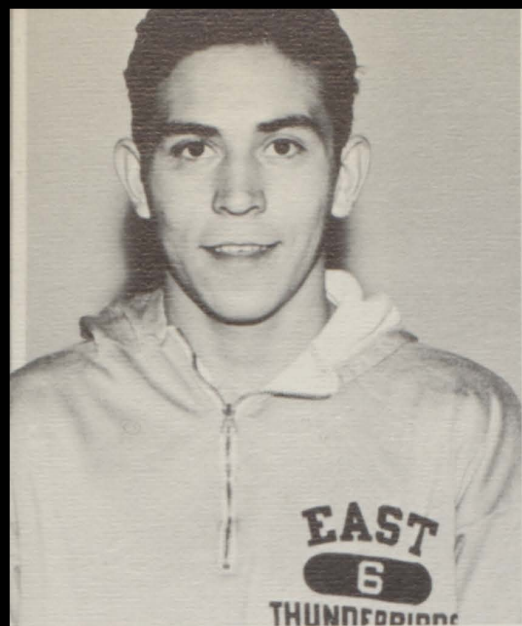
