
















#### **FOREWORD**

He loved math and wildlife, and his artistic hands drew deer coming out of the forest, or puma, running through the meadow. He loved cars. He loved the cars he died beneath, and he drew them also. He loved swimming and basketball, but most of all he loved God and wanted to serve and worship him through his church.

Still with all this in his body and soul he died that night beneath the wheel of a car as no one should ever die, in pain and suffering. I know he is peaceful. Yet if he were here today what greatness could he have accomplished.

While he died upon this night, while this bit of greatness and love died, scum lived. Filth and dirt and grime lived and crawled upon the earth. Hoods, who when the age of freedom reaches them will become welfare cases either in free hand outs or in the prisons of the world, lived.

Mr. Phillips obtained his B.A. at Dakota Wesleyan University in Mitchell, South Dakota. He received his M.A. at the University of Wyoming.






