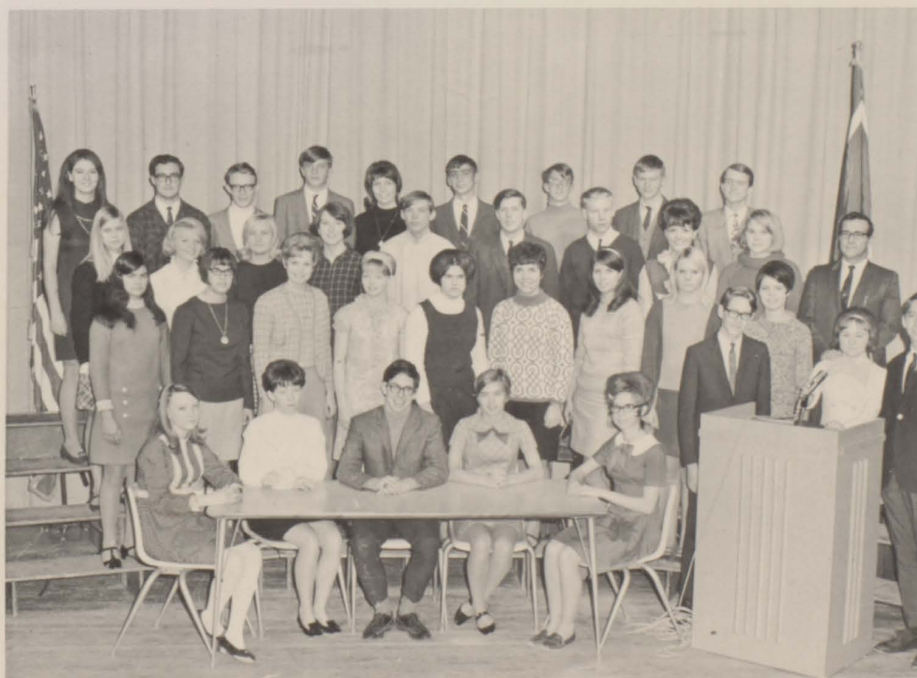
National Forensic League
