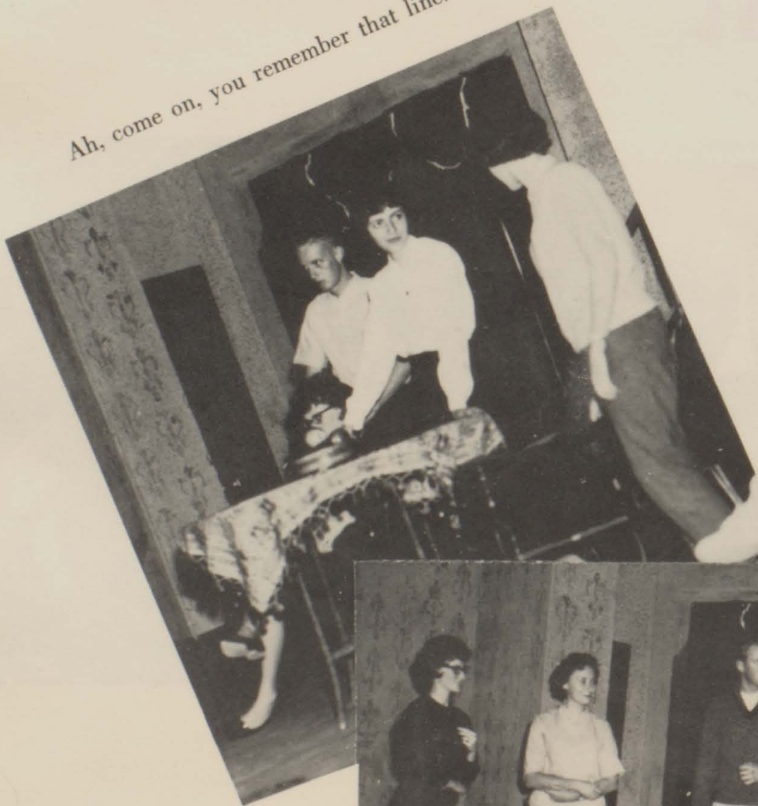
### Senior Class Play
