Only when we are faced with a serious challenge do we know when we have reached maturity.








In the world of imagination we can be whatever we wish.

Some of life's obstacles are real, and some are imagined. It is only when we face them directly that we live in truth. We can overcome seemingly impossible odds if we only try.










I have. I am a Rotary exchange student in Salisbury, Rhodesia, from September 1971 to August 1972. The above are a very few of my experiences as an exchange student. It would take me a year to relate everything that has happened to me since I left Cheyenne because there has not been a day during which I have not experienced something new, done something I have never done, seen a new sight, or made a new friend.

The changes that have occurred in me in the few short months that I have been in Rhodesia are as incredible as the distance between Salisbury and Cheyenne. I have acquired many Moms, Dads, brothers, sisters, uncles, aunts, friends and pets. I have cultivated an ability to meet people and to be at ease in a group of people I've never seen before. I have developed and practiced expressing myself forcefully and effectively (part of the credit goes to Mr. J. Albro). The ability to compare, contrast, decide, and think has been developed through much practice (thanks to Mr. R. L. Ferguson). My outlooks on racism, international politics, career, government, Communism, recreation, life, love, religion, people, and myself have changed drastically. The biggest change of all is in my feeling for America. I had always thought that she was great but I realize that I took my citizenship very much for granted. All the patriotic songs and days, Pledges of Allegiance, student councils, studies of Communism, studies of history, Girls' State, didn't and couldn't have made the impression on me that the last few months have. I've looked at America from without, have gained an understanding of her policies, and am a staunch supporter of those policies. I am proud of my country and appreciate the privilege of bearing an American passport.

I have gained an understanding of Africa, her people, and her problems. I have been given the true picture of this part of the world and have in return given a true picture of America to my hosts. This two-sided exchange of facts leads to understanding and understanding on a large scale leads to peace. I have spent this year in giving and getting understanding.

I have only given you a minute part of the problems and rewards of being an exchange student. If you want to get an education in the true sense of the word, I suggest you talk to any Rotarian and ask about becoming a Rotary exchange student. He can lead you to a remote corner of the world and to a new way of life.
