Fort Phantom Hill, established as an army post on the Clear Fork of the Brazos in 1850 and abandoned in 1854, became a noted station on the Butterfield stage line between Missouri and California. This first and longest of all transcontinental mail and passenger routes ran just west of Camp Barkeley. At Fort Phantom Hill the mule-drawn coaches, running always the Comanche gauntlet, used to stop to give passengers a meal of mustrad, salt pork, hard bread, black coffee, and to change teams. The Civil War ended use of the Butterfield Trail. The ghosts attached to Fort Phantom Hill by legend are of a later date and not so interesting as the ruins and the river.


I am sarry I haven't veritten more aften, but just kept putling it affand clidn't realize down for I was behind. I have been rather busy also.

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


Hello Milher.

Nov. 31 - 43


