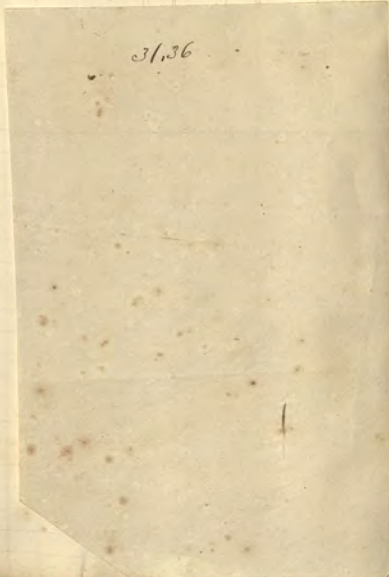

The court shall be composed of three judges of whom shall reside in each of the three great divisions of the State. The concurrence of two of said judges shall be necessary in a decision in every case. The court shall possess such jurisdiction as is now conferred on the present Supreme Court, and shall hold its sessions at Nashville, on the first Monday of March next, and every other day for Monday of December, of Knoxville, on the first Monday in June, of Jackson, on the first Monday in April in each year. Said court shall sit at the residence of the different justices in rotation on some day of the term. The judges shall each receive a salary of \$1200 per annum.
