

CALLS FOR A TRACT OF LAND SURVEYED FOR FRED WALKER.

"BEGINNING AT A STAKE IN THE ROAD, Willis' corner; thence with his line S. $63\frac{1}{2}$ W. $123-1/5$ poles to a post in Keefauver's line; thence N. 15 W. $32\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a post; N. 25 W. 31 poles to a stake, Willis' corner; with his line N. 66 E. $98-1/5$ poles to a point in the road; with the same S. 10 E. 3 poles; thence N. 65 E. $31\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a set stone; thence S. 63 E. 45 poles to a set stone; thence N. 15 E. $41\frac{1}{4}$ poles to a post; thence S. $70\frac{1}{2}$ E. $66\frac{1}{4}$ poles to the center of the road; with the same S. 19 W. $42-1/8$ poles; N. 84 W. $63-2/3$ poles to a walnut; thence S. 14 W. 11 poles to a set stone; thence S. 69 E. $10-3/4$ poles to a post; thence S. 43 W. 27 poles; thence N. 42 W. $20\frac{1}{4}$ poles to the Beginning, Containing 78 Acres, more or less."
