TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:



KNOW YE, that in consideration of an order made in the office of the Surveyor of the Sixth District, of Number 318 dated the Seventh day of August eighteen hundred and nine, founded on a Warrant of number 775 issued to Isaac Hammer to the representatives of John English for 9 acres of land, dated the twenty sixth day of January Eighteen Hundred and nine which said Warrant is assigned by John English Executor of John English deceased to Nathan Shipley and again by said Shipley to Isaac Hammer the Enterer

There is granted by the said state of Tennessee, unto the said Isaac Hammer and his heirs, a certain tract or parcel of land, containing nine and an Half acres, lying in the county of Washington in the District of Washington on Knobb Creek Beginning at two small Ashes on the Bank of the Creek said Hammer's Corner Thence East fifty four poles to a white oak then South six poles to two Hickories and a white oak then East forty three poles to a Buck Eye and Gum tree at the foot of a Knob on the Bank of Knobb Creek then up the meander of the Creek to the Beginning surveyed September the Eleventh Eighteen Hundred & nine

with the hereditaments and appurtenances: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the said tract or parcel of land, with its appurtenances, to the said Isaac Hammer and his heirs forever.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WILLIE BLOUNT, Governor of the State of Tennessee, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the great seal of the state to be affixed at Knoxville, on the Tenth day of May in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and Ten and of American Independence the thirty fourth.
