1. 2nd Lt. Lemiel L. Reese, 64th Infantry is hereby cited for the following Meritorious conduct in action :

"2nd Lieut. Lemiel L. Reese, commanded an advance patrol of scouts in the attack of company "A" on Hill 323.0, near Rembercourt, Nov. 1, 1918. later covering the right flank of the company, advanceing thru the enemy's line, drivingg back several machine gun crews, all under heavy direct and indirect machine gun, rifle and grenade fire. He withdrew only when half of his patrol had been killed or wounded and his advance position became untenable. During the five hours' combat in dense brush, Lt. Reese conducted his patrol with ability and coolness, while in close contact with the enemy he personally expending a belt of ammunition in rifle fire against the enemy".
