Winston

Isaac Winston was born 1620 at Oned Hall in the town of Winstone Yorkshire, England. He moved to Essex Co. England in 1650 where his son Isaac was born. This Isaac was the father of William Isaac and James who came to Virginia and settled in Hanover Co. 1704.

James Winston, son of Isaac married 1706 Barbara Overton, daughter of Col. Wm. Overton. She survived her husband many years. Her will to which Patrick Henry was one of the witnesses was probated in Hanover Co. in 1764. This will mentions only two sons John and James who inherited the bulk of her property.

John Winston son of James married Alice Bickerton. Capt. James Winston son of John was born Mar. 12, 1753 at "Woodburg" in Hanover Co., but he lived and died upon his home farm on South Anna River near Louisa Va. He married Sarah Marks daughter of Hastings Marks.

John Hastings Winston, son of James was born Aug., 1783. He married Damanis Althea Campbell daughter of Capt. Francis Lee Campbell, May 21, 1816. He died at "Malvern Hill", Louisa Co.

John Hastings Winston Jr. married Charlotte Payne.
