I was at Joseph Bowman's when  
Bro White made the agreement  
about the Union Church & how it

& that Joseph Bowman & Jacob Debault  
furnished all the timber, except lumber  
that Samuel Shessey gave, The Baptist  
was to have the privilege of holding meet-  
ing more than one Sunday if no other  
appointment -
