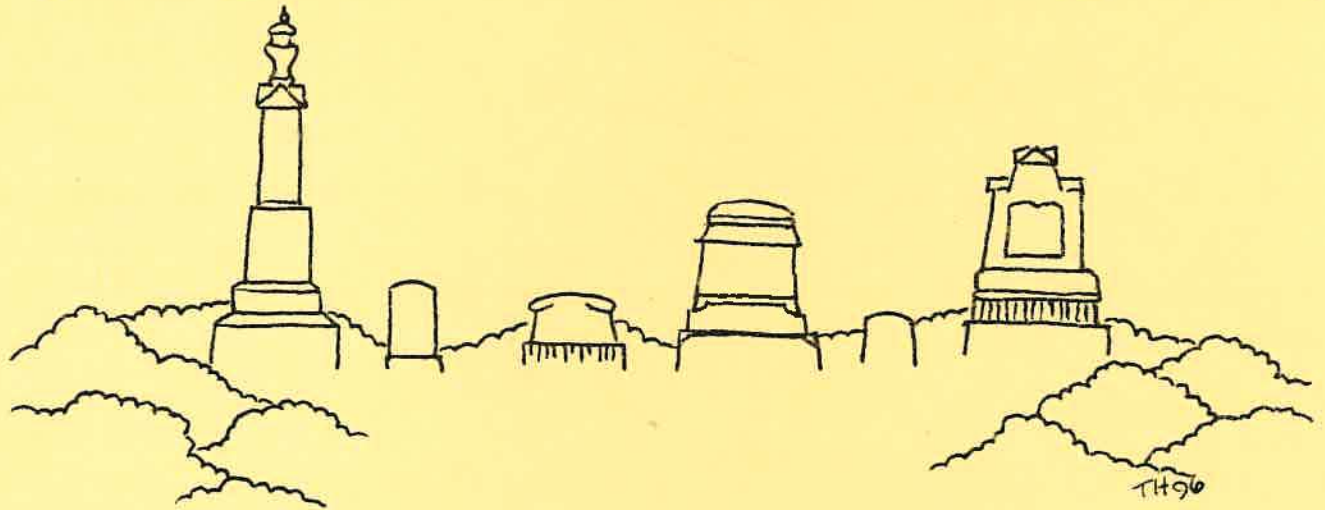

## Introduction

The Jonesborough Cemetery was catalogued by participants in the Historic Preservation project groups in the 1995 and 1996 Governor's School for Tennessee Heritage. At the request of Dr. Gary Burkett, a detailed catalogue was created to remedy the absence of a complete inventory of the Old Jonesborough Cemetery. This project was conducted by a group of high school students under the direction of Mr. Joe Spence, a high school teacher from Lenoir City, Tennessee. The 1995 project group catalogued the main portion of the Old Jonesborough Cemetery. This section of the cemetery, catalogued on July 10, 11, and 12 of 1995, contains the graves of primarily white persons. In June 1996, a second portion, containing the graves of African-Americans, was uncovered. On June 28 and July 1, the 1996 project group catalogued this section of the cemetery. The Governor's School students who worked diligently, enduring the hot sun, poison ivy, and yellow jackets, are as follows:

## METHOD

### Location Indicator

A technique was devised to describe the location of each grave marker.

1. The cemetery was divided into 20 "sections" (labeled A through T) as indicated on the attached map. The measurements provided on the map would enable future reconstruction of these sections. Sections were marked using stakes, string, and signs.
2. Within each section students were instructed to assign "rows," beginning with the grave markers closest to the front (west side) of the cemetery. Since the markers are not actually

always in neat rows, a row sometimes consists of a single stone.

3. Within each row students were instructed to assign individual "numbers" for markers beginning with the marker closest to the south side of the cemetery. Each grave marker, therefore, has a unique location indicator consisting of a combination of section, row, and number.

#### Information Collected

Each student was provided with a packet of forms to be used to record the information from each grave marker. The form, a copy of which is attached, had been designed based on suggestions from the book, *A Gravestone Preservation Primer*, by Lynette Strangstad.

Students were assigned to work by pairs in sections. In order to facilitate deciphering grave markers which were difficult or impossible to read, flour and/or chalk were used to highlight the inscriptions. Students often spent long periods of time attempting to read a single stone.

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Dr. Gary Burkett has entered the information from the forms into a computer data base, which facilitates sorting and examining this information. He plans to update and check the accuracy of this information as time permits.

If anyone reviewing this information should discover mistakes that need correction or knows of additional information that should be added to these records, we would appreciate hearing about it.

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Working on this project is an ongoing process. There are scattered grave stones yet to be read and, perhaps, others to be discovered in the woods. Dr. Gary Burkett and Mr. Joe Spence are owed special gratitude for lending their expertise, as well as their hard work, to this effort. We would also like to express our appreciation to David Guy, son of Tennessee History teacher Bob Guy, for drawing the section maps of the cemetery.

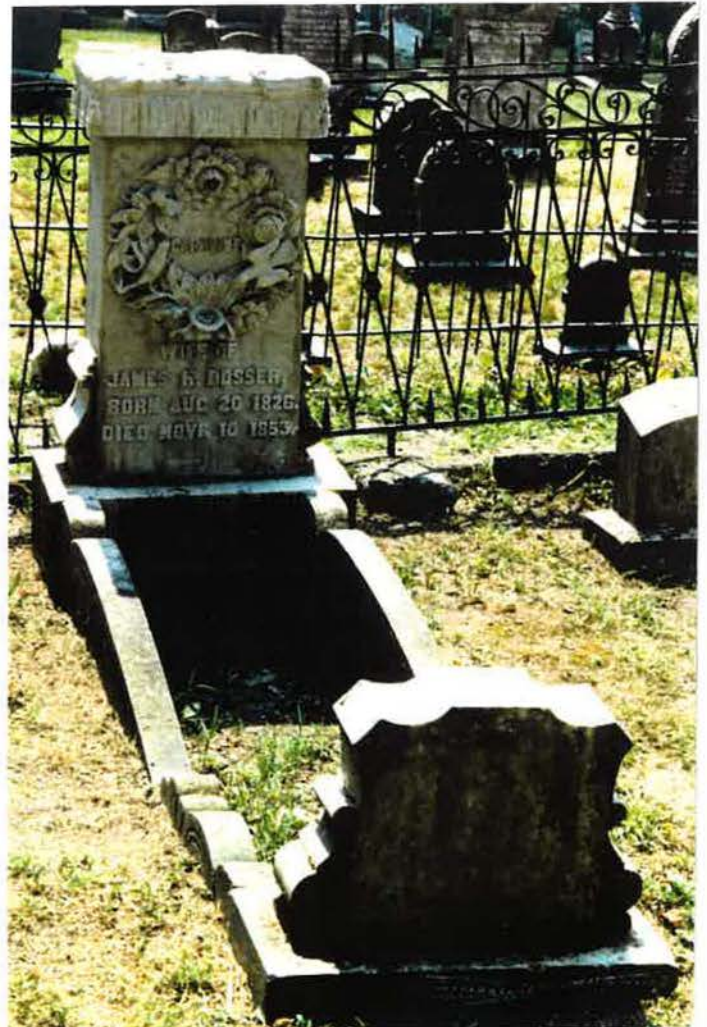

RIGHT: This headstone is interesting not only for the lovely carvings on the top of the marker but also for the inscription that reads, "Her twin babes sleep in her arms."

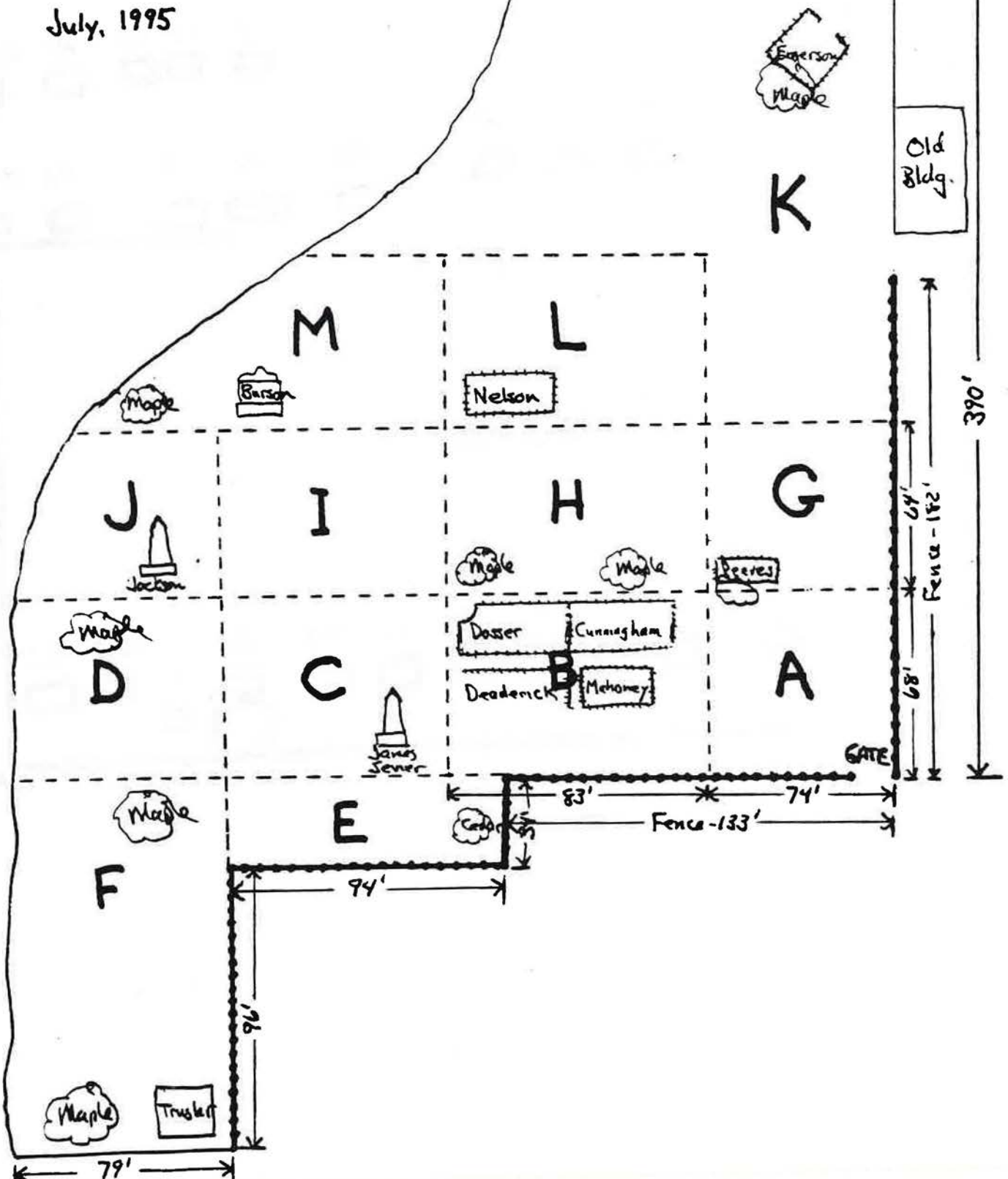


LEFT: The epitaph reads:

SURVEY PLAN MAP

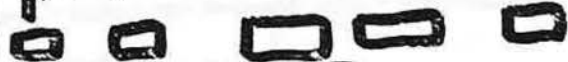
