GENERAL ORDER

NO 9.

1. 2nd Lt. Lemiel L. Reese, 64th Infantry is hereby cited for the following Meritorious conduct in action :

"2nd Lieut. Lemiel L. Reese commanded an advance patrol of scouts in the attack of company "A" on Hill 323.0, near Rembercourt, on Nov. 1, 1918, later covering the right flank of the company, advancing thru the enemy's line, driving back several machine gun crews, all under heavy direct and indirect machine gun, rifle and grenade fire. He withdrew only when half his patrol had been killed or wounded and his advanced position became untenable. During the five hours' combat in dense brush, Lt. Reese conducted his patrol with ability and coolness, while in close contact with the enemy, he personally expending a belt of Ammunition in rifle fire against the enemy."
