TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:



KNOW YE, that in consideration of an entry made in the office of the Surveyor of the Sixth District, of Number *Twenty six* dated the *Seventh* day of *August* eighteen hundred and *Eight*, founded on a Warrant of number *Eighty two* issued by *James* to *Nathaniel Taylor* for *Twenty and Fifty* acres of land, dated the *Eighth* day of *February* *Two thousand and Eighty six* and *Eighty six* acres of which are assigned by said *Nathaniel Taylor* to *Isaac Hammer* the Entitled

There is granted by the said State of Tennessee unto the said *Isaac Hammer* and his heirs, a certain tract or parcel of land, containing *Six* acres, lying in the county of *Washington* in the District of *Washington* on *Knobbs Creek*

Beginning at a maple and small oak on the south side of the creek and running East five poles to a white oak at the foot of the fine Knobbs then along the same South Eighteen East twenty four poles to a small Hickory then South Seventy eight west thirty poles to a white oak Saplin then South twenty west eight poles to a white oak then South Eighteen East forty four poles to a white oak then South forty five west fourteen poles to Elm then North Sixty five west twenty eight poles to a Stake in the Creek then down the meanders of the Creek to the Beginning

Surveyed August the Sixth Eighteen Hundred and Eight with the hereditaments and appurtenances: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the said tract or parcel of land, with its appurtenances, to the said *Isaac Hammer* and his heirs forever.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WILLIE BLOUNT, Governor of the State of Tennessee, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the great seal of the State to be affixed at Knoxville, on the *Tenth* day of *May* in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and *Ten* and of American Independence the thirty fourth.
