ELI SHIPLEY Research:

It seems that the pioneering spirit is still active with the descendents of Eli Shipley for they are scattered throughout the country.

The State of North Carolina has the original 1780 land grant for Eli Shipley. Note there are two warrants issued by N. C. to the surveyor, # 677 for 200 acres and #109 for 100 acres. The survey was proved Nov. 1795 by the Dist. Surveyor John Anderson. Note that the two Chain Carriers (CC) for the survey were Richard and John Shipley. According to N. C., Eli purchased his land in Sullivan County but the amount per acre was not indicated. Richard Shipley bought his land in 1788 and paid one shilling per acre. The Tennessee Archives does not list Eli's original land grant date, but does list Richard's. However, the N. C. records prove the grant.

A petition was sent to the N.C. legislators in 1787 to establish an independent governance area (later to be known as the State of Franklin. Note that Conrad, Eli, Thomas and Richard signed the petition. This establishes their presence in Sullivan County on that date.

In attempting to trace Eli, several days of research at the TN Archives only confirm that there were several Shipley families in adjoining Sullivan and Washington Counties. All of the Shipley families seem to come from Maryland but the relationships between them and between the other Shipley families of Maryland is not proven. Maryland research indicates that there may have been several Shipley men who came to Maryland as early as the 1600s. Another group of Shipleys came to the Wilmington, Delaware area and later moved to Maryland. This last family is easily identified for they were Quakers and kept detailed family records. At the outbreak of the Revolutionary War many of the Quaker Shipleys emigrated to Canada.

There is an organization called the "Shipleys of Maryland" that has published two books on the Shipleys and another is due out soon. Most of the members of this group relate to "Adam Shipley" who came to Maryland in 1675. The "Shipleys of Maryland" are active and have some social occasions each year and publish a newsletter. The Eli line is listed with them and should be in the new volume.

Eli seems to remain in Tennessee the rest of his life for the rest of his
known children are born in TN according to later tax & census records.

Several Shipley researchers are working on the Eli / Maryland connection.
Somewhere there must be a record that will tie the line together and
establish the ancestors of Eli. Possibly Harford Co. has some information
that has yet to be uncovered.



SHIPLEY-KINGSTON RESEARCH

Ancestor Eli SHIPLEY married Elizabeth KINGSTON... 16 Feb. 1782,
Harford Co., Maryland.

Research in MD...Three days of research at the MD Archives in Annapolis and three days in the Library of Congress. Correspondence with the historian for the "Shipleys of MD".

"Shipleys of Maryland"...Two books published with a third edition to be released in 1992. All lines of this family have been traced where possible. This family keys back to Adam Shipley 1 who was in Ann Arundel Co., MD by 1675. This family was Anglican/Episcopalian. This is the largest Shipley line in MD and many of the same names occur in both lines but it does not appear to be linked to Eli Shipley. The one possibility may be the son of Adam 1, Peter 2, who was alive and witnessed a land deed in 1747 as Peter, Sr. The sons of Peter 2 are not recorded.

Shipleys of Delaware...There was a second Shipley family in MD that moved into the Baltimore area. This family was Quaker by religion. Many of the members of this family moved to Canada at the outbreak of the Revolutionary War.

Shipleys of northern MD...This family seems to be the Eli Shipley line. Thomas Shipley appears in the 1783 Tax List in the Mine Run Hundred district. Plantations in this district include "Part of Carrol's Manor" and "Piney Grove". In 1798 a listing of slave holders in Baltimore Co. listed one slave with plantation owner Talbot Henry and superintendent Benjamin Shipley. The Mine Run Hundred district is on the border with Harford Co. MD and southern Pennsylvania.

In Baltimore Inhabitants 1763-1774, by Henry C. Peden, Jr., Bel Air, MD, he lists in the Mine Run Hundred district in the 1773 tax list by George Lytle, constable two (2) Benjamin Shipleys and an Eli Shipley. Mr. Peden has misplaced his copy of the list and the MD Archives do not show a copy.

KINGSTON Research: (Only one family found in Harford Co.)

Harford Co. Wills, 1774-1800 by R. Morgan, Jr. Nathaniel Kingston was a witness for the will of Ann Brierly (10 Jan 1788). She bequeathed 105 acres to her son of the plantation called "Herbitation" (or "Habitation") in His Lordship's Reserve. This probably was a part of "Hanley's Habitation" in the Bush River-Eden Hundred district. The Harford Co. Court Clerk indicates the community is now called "Madonna".

1782, 16 Feb.- Eli marries Elizabeth Kingston in Harford County, MD. (Source: Harford Co., Bel Air, MD Court Clerk.)

1783- Richard listed on Harford Co. tax rolls with seven (7) white inhabitants. (Source: MD Archives.)

1786-First son of Eli & Elizabeth, Benjamin, is born in MD. (Source: TN Census records.)

TENNESSEE...

1780- Eli buys 400 acre land grant in Sullivan County, NC (later TN). (Source: NC Archives.)

1787-(December) Petition to establish a Western State of NC signed by Eli, Thomas and Richard Shipley and Conrad Shepley. (Petition was refused by NC which later caused the organization of the "State of Franklin".)(Source: NC Records Vol. 22, pps 705-714.)

1788- Richard Shipley buys 400 acres (land grant#484) from NC in Sullivan Co. Richard serves as a guarantor for Thomas Shipley land purchase. (Source: Sullivan County records.)

1789-Washington Co. (adjoining Sullivan Co.) had several Shipleys listed in the 1789 tax rolls-(Samuel,700 acres & 2 white polls; Thomas, 160 acres & 1 poll; Peter, 1 poll.)

1789- Conrad Shipley witness with Eli Shipley on land sale. (Source: Sullivan County records.)

1789- Thomas Shipley buys 161 acres from Adam Stokes.

Page 2:

ELI SHIPLEY-ELIZABETH KINGSTON search:

1790, Feb.- Conrad Shipley buys 71 acres from Bryce Russell.

Before 1790 Benjamin Shipley purchased 400 acres, will made in 1802 notes he is an old man, leaves bequests to wife Elizabeth, sons Nathan & James, noting that he had earlier provided for his other children. (Source: Washington Co. TN records.)

1793-Second son of Eli & Elizabeth, Josuha, is born in TN.
(Source: TN Census records.)

Note: Land sale & probate records in Sullivan County & Washington County, TN indicate that there were probably two older Shipley men, Benjamin, living in Washington Co. who died in 1802 (will), & Richard, Sr., living in Sullivan Co who died in 1804 (land sale by widow). John Shipley dies by 1808 (land being sold by widow Sarah) but age of John is not known, although there appear to be grown children (son-in-law George Elmore is selling land with widow Sarah).

NOTE: The relationship of Eli, John, Richard, Thomas, and Conrad Shipley to each other and to the Shipleys of Washington Co. TN has not been proven although all were reported to be from MD. (Source: Goodspeed History of Tennessee, 1880.)
