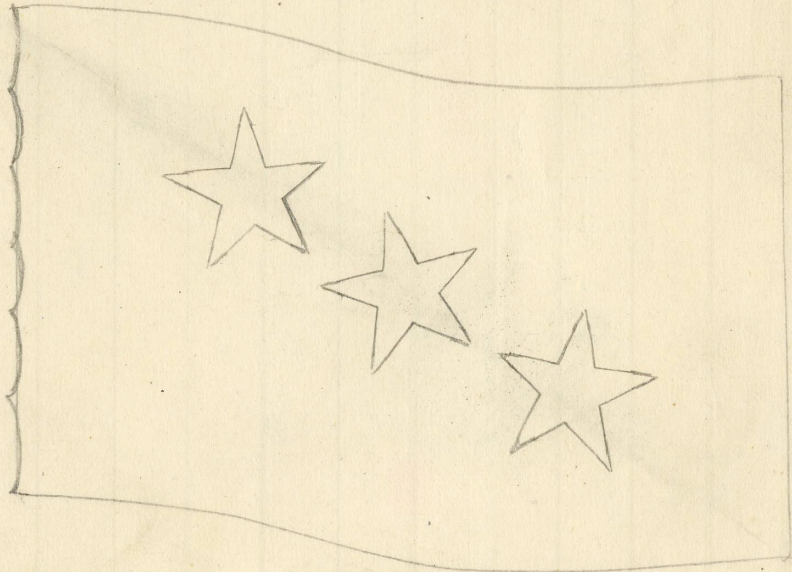
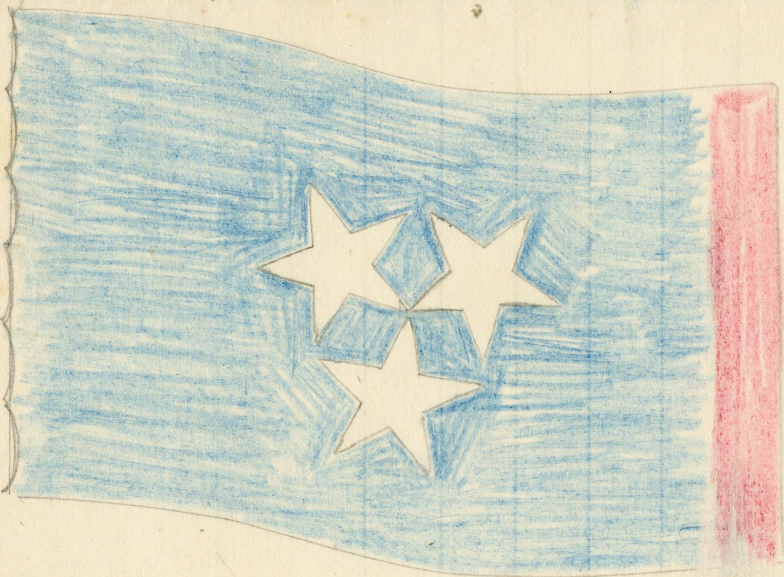
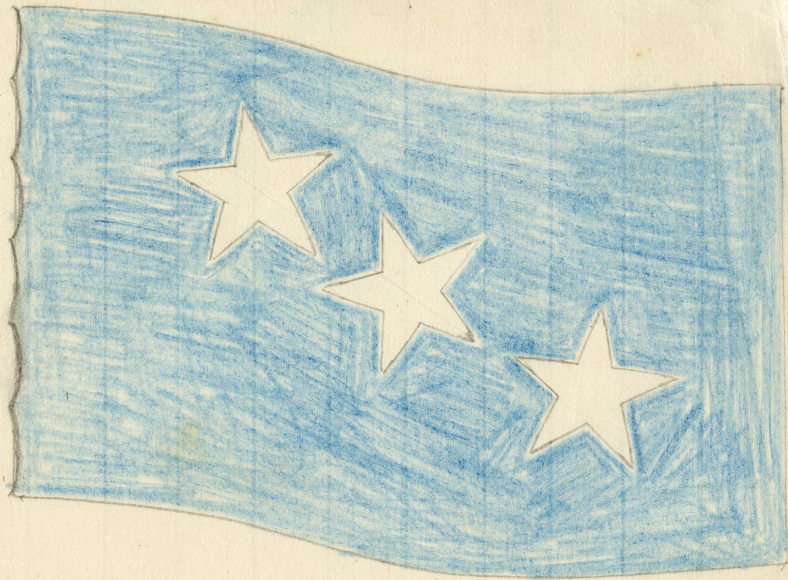
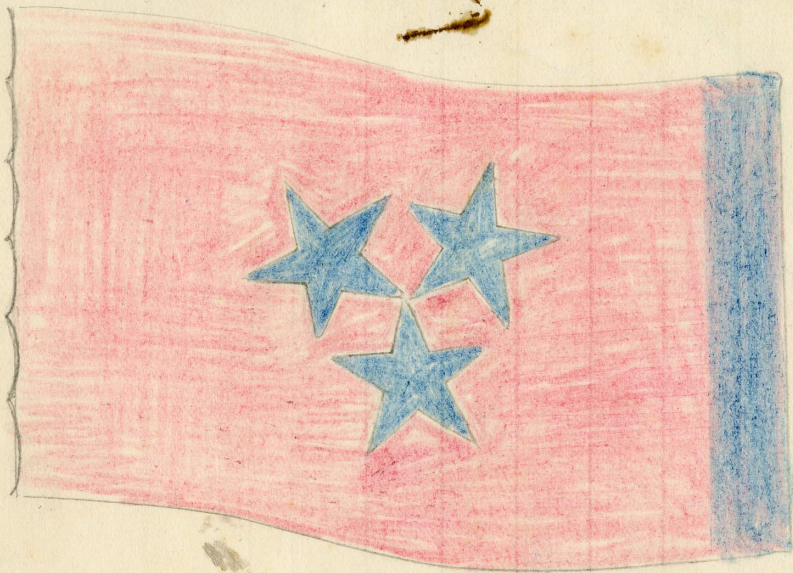
Original drawing of the Tennessee flag, by Leroy Reeves.

who introduced same in House of Representatives, January 28, 1903. Reeves  
came to final vote.  
Introduced again in House March 8, 1905, by Representative W. W. Faust  
of Williamson County (formerly of Washington County); and in Senate  
April 3, 1905, by Senators R. N. McCaig and Douglas White.  
Became a law April 17, 1905, being passed on last day of session.
