John D. Goodin, Erwin, Receives Bronze Star

First Lt. John D. Goodin, former East Tennessee State College student, University of Tennessee law graduate and practicing attorney in Johnson City, has been awarded the Bronze Star medal for heroic achievement in action against the enemy, Army headquarters announced.

Lieutenant Goodin is holder of the Purple Heart medal for wounds received in Belgium and Germany. He has been in the 32nd Armored Regiment since June 25, 1942, and fought in the battles of Normandy, Northern France and Belgium, through the Siegfried Line, in the Ardennes, and into Germany to the Elbe River.

The lieutenant is a tank platoon commander in one of the Third Armored (Spearhead) Division's armored task forces. He is a son of Mr. and Mrs. Tom Goodin, Sr., of Erwin.
