I John Bowman a resident
of Dist. No. 10 Washington County
State of Tennessee.

And being of sound mind and
memory, I do make and publish
this my last will and Testament,
in regard to the disposition of
all real estate and personal
property that I shall die
seized and possessed of, in the
following manner, to wit:

I give and bequeath to my
nephew Joseph Albert Bowman
son of my Brother H. K. Bowman
all my personal property,
consisting of all live stock
of any kind, all farm
implements, and all my
household and kitchen furniture
including all due bills, notes
and cash on hand at my decease.

My nephew Joseph Albert Bowman
shall assume the payment of
all my just debts.

and defray all my burial
expenses. I also give and
bequeath to Joseph Albert Bowman
all that part of my farm
that I shall die seized and
possessed of that lies south
East of the Jonesboro and Abing-
don road, upon which is my
dwelling House, Barn and
other buildings and appurten-
ances pertaining thereto,
to have and to hold unto himself
forever. my will is that there
shall be a division line estab-
lished as near as practicable in
the middle of the Jonesboro and
Abingdon road the full width of
my farm through which said
road runs, so that the parties
receiving these bequests on one
or both sides of the road, will
have as much as possible
equal rights and privileges
to the same. I also give and
bequeath to Joseph Albert Bowman

two acres of land lying on the
north west side of the Jonesboro
and Abingdon road and opposite
of my dwelling house.

The survey of which shall
begin on the above mentioned
division line and opposite a
walnut stump standing on
north west side of road, and
running on said line along
the road south west 25 poles.

Then a parallel line 25 poles
long shall be surveyed at a
sufficient distance of even
width with right angle line con-
nections so as to form and
oblong square plat of land about
twice as long as wide, containing
two acres to have and to hold
unto the said Joseph Bowman
forever. Furthermore give
device and bequeath to my niece
Ida Elizabeth Bowman the daughter
of my Brother H. K. Bowman

And my sister Julia C. Sanders
all the remaining portion of
my land that lies on the
north-west side of the Jonesboro
and Abingdon road the equal
division of which they shall decide
upon themselves, to have and to
hold unto themselves equally,
and jointly forever. In testimony
whereof I John Bowman have
to this my last will and
testament subscribed my name
and affixed my seal. This the
first day of June 1910.
