This indenture, made and entered
into this sixth day of December 1836
between John Stormer of the one part
and Stephen Brown of the other, both
of Washington County, Tennessee, is
as follows, that the said John Stormer

for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars
the receipt of whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained
and sold by these presents doth convey and confirm unto the said
Stephen Brown, his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or
parcel of land with appertenances whereon Sevin Morris now
lives an Little Limestone Creek containing one hundred eighty
two and one quarter acres and bound as follows to wit:

Beginning at a Spanish Oak Millions corner thence south one
hundred and forty nine poles to two white oaks on a rocky side
of a hill thence west fifty two poles to a poplar and hickory
at William Clydes corner thence south twenty four poles west
forty two poles to two white oaks on William Cloyds line thence
north fifty one west seventy poles to a white oak, thence north
twentey eight degrees west one hundred forty eight poles to a
white oak on David Browns line thence north sixty nine degrees
east thirty eight poles to a hickory near the road thence north
twenty two degrees west three poles to a white oak on
David Browns line thence north forty eight degrees east sixty
