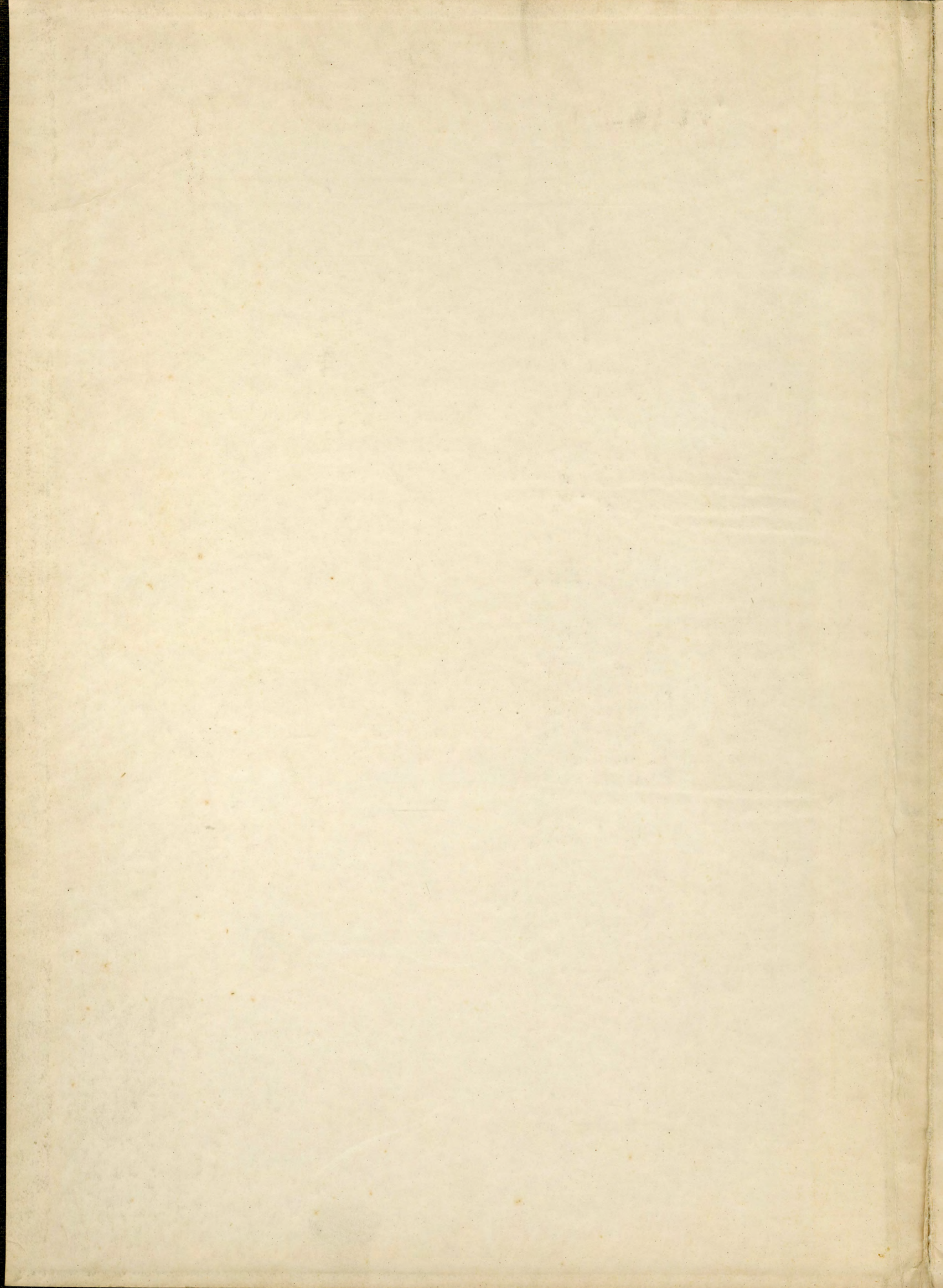

FUNCTIONS OF THE SOCIETY

The Rules, recommendations of the Council General and the traditions of the Society require that we faithfully observe the following functions of the Society:

CONFERENCE MEETINGS

1. Weekly meetings through the entire year.
2. Opening and closing prayers at weekly meetings.
3. Spiritual reading at the weekly meeting.
4. Secret collection of Members' offerings at weekly meetings.

Unless all of these requirements are observed the meetings cannot be considered meetings of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul.

QUARTERLY OR FESTIVAL MEETINGS

The Feast days of the Society are:

1. The first Sunday in Lent.
2. The Feast of the Translation of the Relics of St. Vincent de Paul (second Sunday after Easter).
3. The Feast of St. Vincent de Paul, (July 19th) or the Sunday within the Octave.
4. The Feast of the Immaculate Conception, (December 8th) or the Sunday within the Octave.

The Rules require that all members, Active and Honorary, shall on these occasions, and in a body, assist at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, receive Holy Communion, join in a recital of the five Our Fathers and Hail Mary's for the intention of the Holy Father at the close of the Mass and attend the general or festival meeting provided for such occasions.

These requirements are not limited to members of Conferences under the jurisdiction of Councils but apply as well to those of Isolated Conferences. (See Chapter VI. of the Rules).

MASSES

1. *The Mass of Four Intentions* —The Council General, May 15, 1911, requested all Conferences throughout the world to have a Mass celebrated annually on a fixed date, other than those of the four Festivals, for the four Intentions:—The Church; The Sovereign Pontiff; Our Country; and, The Society of St. Vincent de Paul. It is not obligatory that the members shall assist at this Mass but they should do so if at all possible.

The date fixed by this Conference for the celebration of this Mass is.....

2. *Memorial Mass* —It has become the custom, of most of the Councils and Isolated Conferences in this country, to have an annual Mass of Requiem celebrated, on a fixed date (usually a public holiday to enable all of the members to attend) for the repose of the souls of the deceased members, benefactors and the deceased poor of the Society in their respective jurisdictions.

If this Conference is under the jurisdiction of a Particular Council the Mass and date fixed by the Council should be adopted by the Conference and is.....

RETREAT OR TRIDUUM

The custom of having an annual Triduum or Retreat for the members of the Society is universally observed wherever our Society exists. All Conferences should unite with their Councils in promoting the successful holding of such retreats.

Isolated Conferences should have this religious function for their members in their parish church and invite thereto the attendance of the men of their parish.

DUTIES OF OFFICERS OF CONFERENCES

Officers should always bear in mind the injunction of the Rules that office in the Society of St. Vincent de Paul should not be considered an honor but a burden freely assumed for the spiritual welfare of themselves and their brother members.

THE PRESIDENT

The rules state that the president should never consider himself otherwise than as an elder brother, the first amongst equals, and that "what the president is, so is the Conference."

It is the duty of the president to see that the Rules of the Society are strictly observed so that the members may obtain the spiritual rewards provided for their service under the conditions imposed by our Sovereign Pontiffs.

If the Conference is subordinate to a Particular Council, he should attend regularly all of the meetings of the Council. If occasionally he is unable to do so he should make sure that his vice-president fulfills this obligation.

THE SECRETARY

It is necessary that the secretary should be present at every meeting so that the minutes of the Conference proceedings may be properly recorded and that the correspondence made necessary by such proceedings may receive prompt and adequate attention.

If the secretary should be unable to attend a meeting he should notify the president in advance so that the latter may appoint a substitute to ensure the regularity of the record keeping.

He should, after the close of the Society year, September 30th, and at the end of each of its quarterly divisions, promptly compile and record, in the minute book blanks, provided therefor, complete details concerning the activities of the Conference.

He should promptly forward copies of the quarterly and annual reports to the Particular Council. If the Conference is not under the jurisdiction of a Particular Council he should forward the annual reports to the Council under whose jurisdiction his conference may be.

THE TREASURER

The treasurer should report at every meeting the details of the funds of the Conference.

He should welcome, for his own protection and that of the Conference, an annual audit of his accounts by a Committee of the Conference appointed by the president, as recommended by Art. 12 of the Rules.
