

PORTUGUESE FESTIVAL

Will be Featured by Mass and Street Parade

The festival of Bom Jesus, to be conducted by lodges of the Portuguese Fraternity on Sunday promises to be the largest of its kind in many years. The committee is in receipt of numerous acceptances from lodges all over Eastern Massachusetts, and nearly all are to be accompanied by bands. The parade is to be a colorful one and will be well worth turning out to see.

The various lodges are to assemble in Wood square at 10.30 a. m., to march to St. Michael's church, where there will be a mass by Rev. Joseph Grillo, of Lowell, a member of Hudson lodge, assisted by visiting priests. Fr. Grillo will also preach the sermon.

After the service the parade proper will take place. The route will be done Manning, up Main to Pope, to Apsley, and then over the following streets: Carter, Butman, Howe, Apsley, Cottage, Central to Wood square, where the line will be reviewed. It will then move on to Park street and be disbanded at Wood park. Here there will be exercises, with speaking by distinguished visitors, and the selectmen. The bands will give a concert.
