HISTORICAL/ADMINISTRATIVE INFORMATION

Sally R. Korobkin (1921–2008) was an elementary school teacher for Montgomery County Public Schools. In the 1980s, she taught at the Garrett Park Elementary School (GPES). Korobkin was known for introducing her young students (third and fourth graders) to arts and culture, not only to promote appreciation, but also to teach history, writing, and other subjects. In 1985, she hosted Jazz bassist William Thomas "Keter" Betts in her classroom, where he performed and participated in musical experiences with the students.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Sally R. Korobkin Collection contains Korobkin's personal papers, photographs (mostly unlabeled), and memorabilia from special events and programs during her time as a teacher at GPES in the 1980s. The collection also includes correspondence with a class "pen pal" (a U.S. Army Officer) and former students. It also includes materials about GPES that Korobkin collected after her retirement.
