As Clerk I have endeavored to keep an correct record of all the proceedings of the Council which are recorded in the book of Minutes, approved by the Council.

All official communications, bills, receipts, proposals, etc have been kept on file.

The assessed value of the real and personal property of the Park as given by the assessor with the approval of the Council is ----- \$112,015.⁰⁰

The rate of Coporation Taxes for the year 1898-9 was fixed by Ordinance at 40 cents on the \$100, assessed value of

property, making a tax of \$448.06.
