HISTORICAL/ADMINISTRATIVE INFORMATION

Originally planned and developed by Henry N. Copp in the early 1890s, the Town of Garrett Park incorporated in May 1898. Since that time, Garrett Park residents have commemorated and celebrated their town's incorporation at various junctures. For milestone anniversaries, such as the town's 75th and 100th anniversaries, multiple events—such as plays and musicals, picnics and galas, and contests—were planned across the entire year and involved numerous committees and working groups. Other anniversary celebrations were smaller in scale.

EXTENT

2 cubic foot, including a textile box. This collection is open for accruals.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Town Anniversaries Collection includes planning documents, correspondence, flyers and announcements, programs, photographs, and memorabilia and objects from town celebrations dating back to 1958. In addition, although not a town anniversary, the collection includes materials from the town's celebration of the United States Bicentennial in 1976.

The collection is organized by anniversary in the following series and subseries:

Materials within each series are arranged chronologically by date, from earliest to latest.

SERIES DESCRIPTIONS

Series I: 60th Jubilee Anniversary, 1958 (0.1 cubic feet)

This series includes planning and event materials from the town's 60th Anniversary, described as its Jubilee. Highlights of this celebration included several skits depicting key events in the town's history, such as the first meeting of the Town Council in 1898 and the founding of the Civic Study Club, later known as the Women's Club, in 1913. This anniversary also featured a Jubilee Ball that included a souvenir dance card.

Series II: 70th Anniversary, 1968 (0.05 cubic feet)

This series includes just a handful of documents and photographs related to the town's 70th Anniversary. Most significantly, this series includes plans and records related to the writing of town history. Town residents initially planned to write the book for the town's 60th Jubilee; however, the project was postponed until this 70th Anniversary. Due to various delays, the final product, *Garrett Park: A History of the Town from its Beginnings to 1970*, was published in 1974.

Series III: 75th Demi-Sesquicentennial, 1973–1974 (0.2 cubic feet)

This series includes materials related to the town's 75th Anniversary, also known as the Demi-Sesquicentennial, a term coined by the then mayor, George L. Payne. This series includes planning materials, event programs, and photographs and memorabilia and objects. As with previous anniversaries, the 75th featured skits and musical productions about the town's history.

Series IV: 80th Anniversary, 1978 (0.05 cubic feet)

This series includes one flier advertising the town's "Four Score Shindig" and a few objects commemorating the anniversary.

Series V: 100th Centennial, 1990–1998 (non-inclusive) (1.4 cubic feet)

This series includes numerous documents, photographs, news clippings, memorabilia, and objects related to the town's yearlong 100th Anniversary, or Centennial, Celebration. The highlight of this collection is the town's Centennial Quilt, which took more than 6 years for town women to sew. Other highlights include postcards of the quilt; a centennial poster; a license plate; a U.S. flag donated to the town by Congresswoman Constance Morella; and, numerous fliers, programs, and photographs.

Series VI: United States Bicentennial, 1975–1977 (0.2 cubic feet)

This series includes planning documents, correspondence, event information, photographs, and memorabilia and objects related to the town's celebration of the United States Bicentennial in 1976. As with celebrations of town anniversaries, bicentennial events in the town occurred over several months and included concerts, plays, and contests. A highlight of this collection includes a commemorative letter signed by President Gerald R. Ford.

The bulk of the materials were found in collection. It appears most of the materials came from town residents who worked on committees to plan the anniversary events. Some materials may have come from Town Office staff.

PROCESSING PROCEDURES

General processing procedures included discarding unnecessary binders, metal clips and paperclips, duplicate copies of documents, and general reference materials (such as brochures) as well as arranging and organizing documents. We placed oversized and fragile objects in a separate storage locations. We inserted separation sheets in the original location within the folder to indicate new locations of these items. Materials in folders were arranged, unless otherwise indicated, in forward chronological order, with undated records appearing at the end of the folder.
