This bill is rendered, by direction of the Council, under the provisions of Ordinance No. 21, which provides:

That it shall be unlawful for any dog to run at large within the corporate limits of the Town of Garrett Park unless the owner has obtained from the Clerk a permit to allow the dog to run at large within the town; and

That the Clerk shall issue such a permit upon the payment to him by the owner of the dog of a tax of \$1.00 for each male dog and \$2.00 for each female dog, such permit to be valid for one year; and

That the Clerk shall issue a tag with each permit, which may be worn by the dog as evidence of the payment of the tax; and

That it shall be the duty of the Town Marshal to enforce this ordinance by impounding all dogs running at large without permits. Dogs so impounded may be recovered by the owners within 24 hours by paying the tax and obtaining a permit. If not so recovered, the dogs are to be killed by the Marshal.
