April 11, 1902

Dear Cousin,

I have sad news to tell you- Mother is very ill and sinking rapidly. We do not expect her to live though the day. She has been unconscious since Wednesday. I got here last night but she does not know me or anyone else. She has a tumor which is pressing against her liver and she suffers agonize [[?]] when [[?]] the difference morphine.
