My Dear Ode:

Well, I arrived here on time- at 6 p. m. this evening. Arrived at Alva about 12:30. Went to hotel- had dinner, and [?], Train left for Woodward about 3:20. Went to court house- court was in session. Saw a number of my acquaintances and Paucoosh. Had only few words with him as court was in session. Then went down to Land office and saw musseller. He asked me to go to house- but of course. I did not go. From [G?] to Watonga I rode with Rev. Collins of Watonga who you will remember gave the address at El Reno at Prebyterian Church on S. S. teaching recently. From Watonga on to Alva- most of the way I rode with a young man from Ballet and the rest of the way with a Mr. Murray. at 3:20 started for Woodward.

Had my supper and Mr. Wiggins, the Reciever, called after supper and we talked our the conditions of the Land office, and he has gone- and I then commenced your letter. all things considered I think it will be better for me to post-pone coming home for a week and I guess we will so arrange it. You can therefore make your arrangements accordingly. Well, I have nothing to write about- so I will close this letter. Hope you will continue well.
