Dear Ora:

Well the thing has started. We are doing fair business- but the small fee of 25 ts is cutting [[?]] compared with El Reno- but when I get all my men at work my force strong at I think I will do all right. My telegram business is starting all right and I think I will do pretty well on that. I have instructed Porter to come not later than Friday evening. Up here trains don't run on Sundays- from Sioux City- here- generally. So it would not do for you to start on Saturday evening unless Porter can learn positively than the train will run on Sunday from Sioux City here.
