Carriages south of the Capital may cross Pennsylvania Avenue, Route of Parade, in order to reach the north side, at Third Street up to 1:00 o'clock P. M.; at Sixth Street up to 1:00 o'clock P. M.; at Seventh Street up to 1:00 o'clock P. M.; at Ninth Street up to 1:10 o'clock P. M.; at Eleventh Street up to 1:15 o'clock P. M.; at Fourteenth Street up to 1:25 o'clock P.M.; at Seventeenth Street crossings may be made up to 2:15 o'clock P. M., and at 2:15 o'clock the "Court of Honor" will be closed. Beyond Seventeenth Street, crossings can be used up to 2:15 o'clock P. M.
