Dear Sir:

As you are one of the executives of your local post of the American Legion, and a representative of the ex-service men in your community, I desire to place before you for your consideration, the plan which I have proposed whereby our service men may acquire homes by securing a loan from the government for this purpose.

The plan as outlined in these speeches and the reprint of the bill contained therein, has met the approval of our service men wherever it has been brought to their attention. The State organizations of the American Legion of Iowa, Colorado, South Dakota and Indiana, have passed resolutions fully indorsing the measure, and urging Congress to take favorable action in its regard. Large numbers of local posts in different sections of the country have taken similar action.

I would suggest that, if after careful study, the plan meets with your approval, you communicate with your state organization in regard to your action; also a letter to your Senators and Representative, urging their support of the measure will aid materially.

I have no personal interest in this matter, but would like to see the National Government do something that is worth while for our soldiers, and that will in the end contribute to the strength of the nation.
