I desire to send them copies of my bill, H. R. 5545, "To provide homes for soldiers, seamen and marines" and my speeches thereon.

The National Convention of the American Legion approved the principles of the above bill which provides for loans to former service men for the purchase of both farm and city homes. Quite a number of the state branches of the American Legion have indorsed this bill.

I have no selfish ^{interest} to serve in this matter, but I feel it my duty to furnish our service men with information upon the plan which I have proposed.
