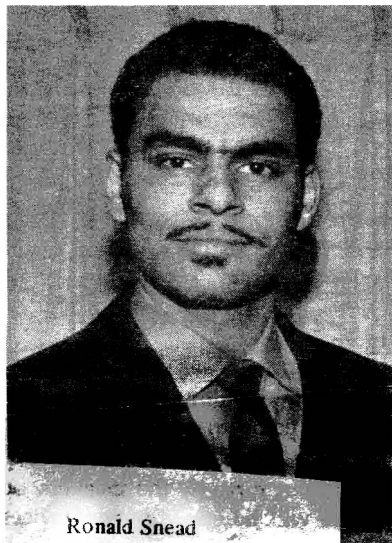

STROSS-SNEAD PLATFORM

- 1.eEffect additional student involvement in the college's administrative government.
—Creation of student-faculty policy committee to approve proposals.
- 2.ePlace into operation a direct student complaint system with the college's administration.
—Professional person (lawyer) on campus to investigate student's complaints.
- 3.eEstablishment of a Student-Administrative-Faculty Committee composed primarily of students to deal solely with the racial and student unrest problems that exist.
—Correlate this committee with the NAACP and all interested campus organizations.
- 4.eTotal lighting system for the safety and well being of the student.e
—Correlate plans with the college and state appropriations committees to begin construction.
- 5.eAutomobile parking shortage . . . exhibit student problems in parking, including campus and off campus students and to indicate to the college's administration the needs of the student.
- 6.eEstablish permanent student representation in Big Rapids Chamber of Commerce.
—This will express the students' concern in matters dealing with the merchants of Big Rapids.
- 7.eActivate an open dormitory visitation for women's and men's dormitories.
- 8.eRegulate all dormitories' social and recreational activities by the dorm councils and dorm advisors in order to establish a more complete dormitory self-government.
—Encouragement of more social activities throughout the week days
- 9.eHousing - Plan committees with direct student participation.
—Students living in dorms will have a voice in existing and future issues concerning their dorms.
