

Extensive Damage at FSC . . .

Three receive minor

At 6:40 a.m. Monday, State Police investigated a personal injury accident on US-10 east of Reed City. Troopers stated that a pickup truck driven by Omar Hainbecker, 46, Reed City pulled into the path of a vehicle driven by John Roggow, 22, Reed City.

Virginia Spence, 21, Reed City, a passenger in the Roggow auto suffered a fractured left knee and facial lacerations. Roggow and Hainbecker both suffered minor injuries, were treated and released from the Reed City Hospital.

State Police arrested Racheal Aubert, 46, Hersey, on a charge of driving while under the influence of liquor last evening. She was lodged in the Osceola County jail awaiting arraignment today.

Still under investigation is a breaking and entering Sunday evening at Beeson's Marathon Station in Morley. Cigarettes and loose change were taken. Entry was gained by breaking a window.
