# Freshmen

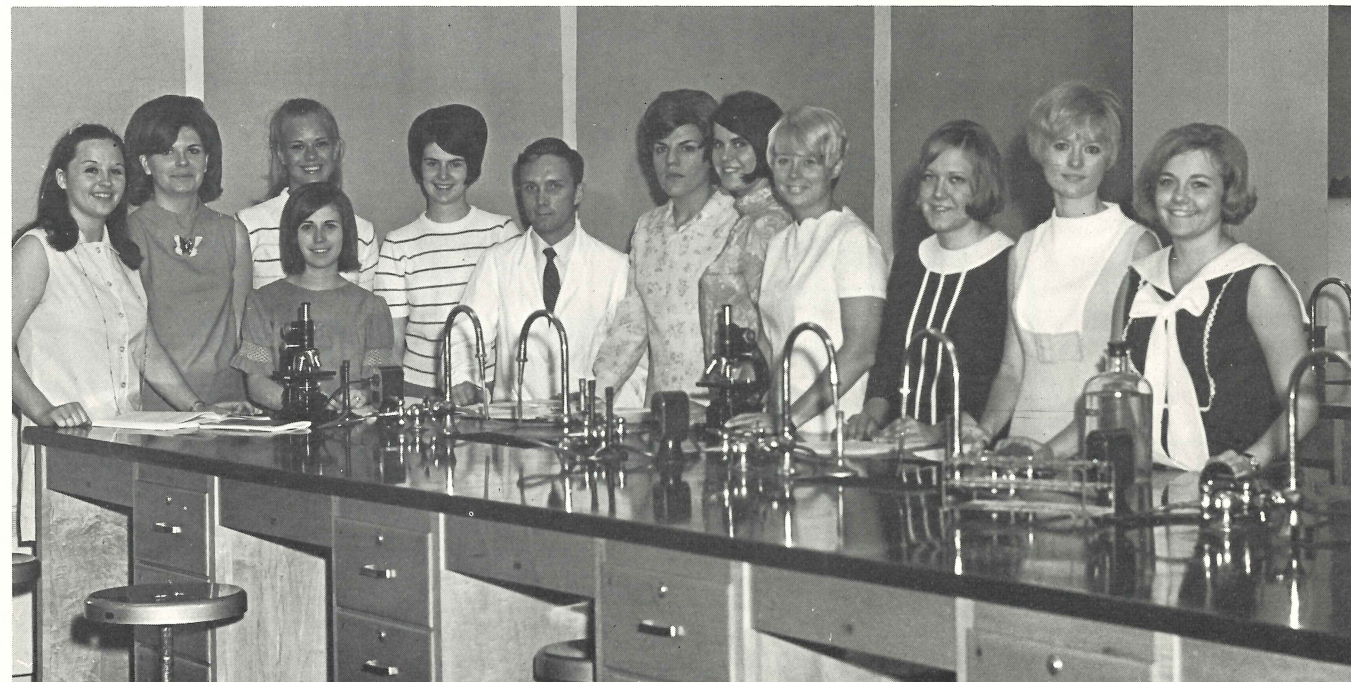

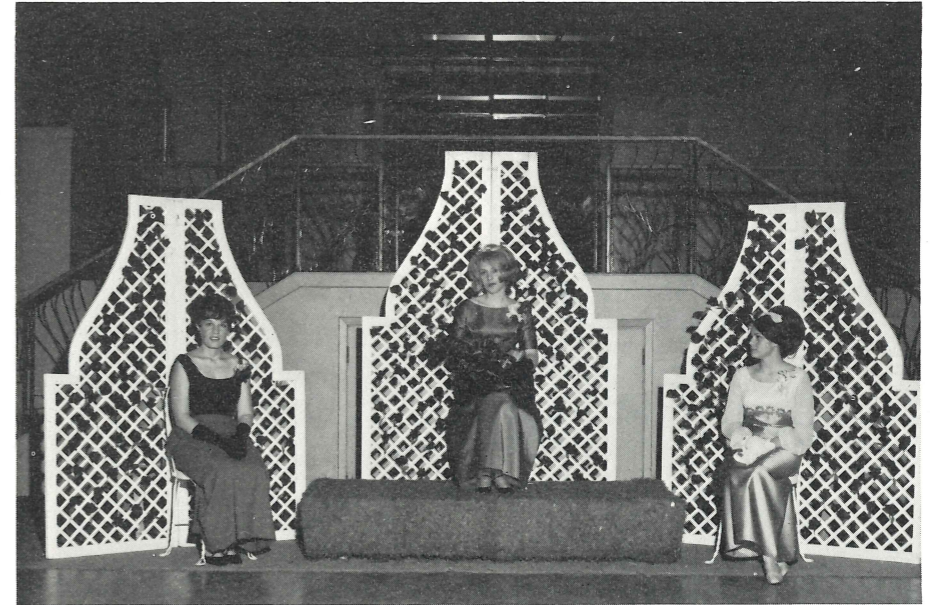

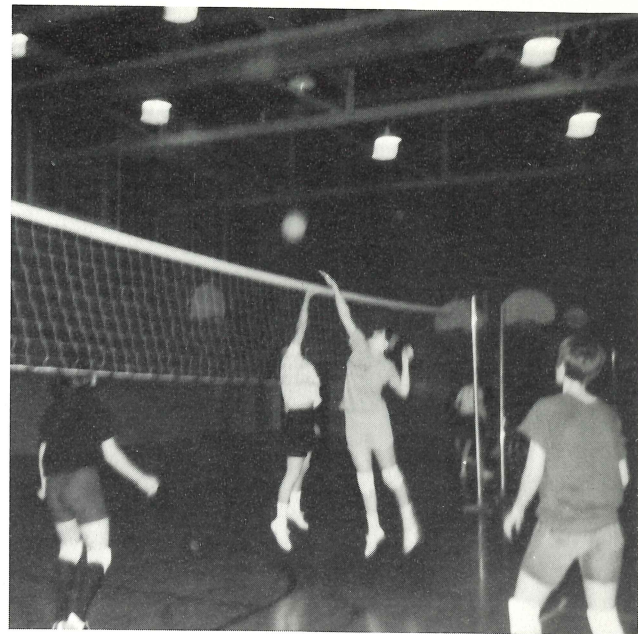
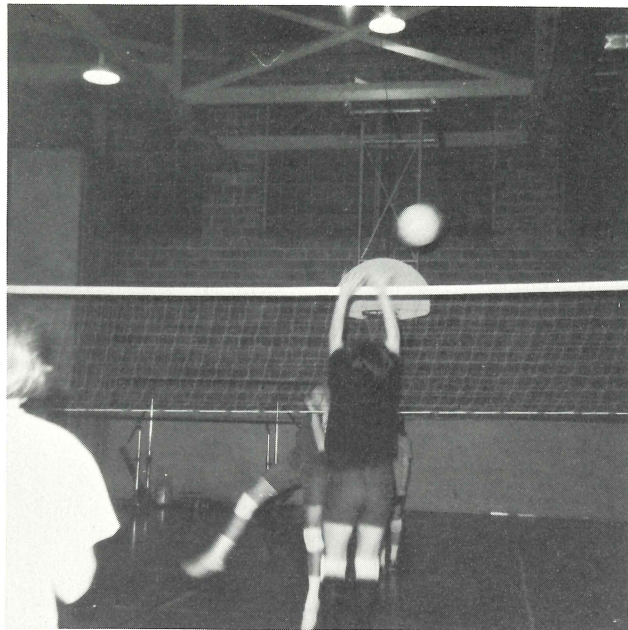
Striping is anticipated by both Juniors and Seniors. The stripe added signifies one more year of experience and learning.



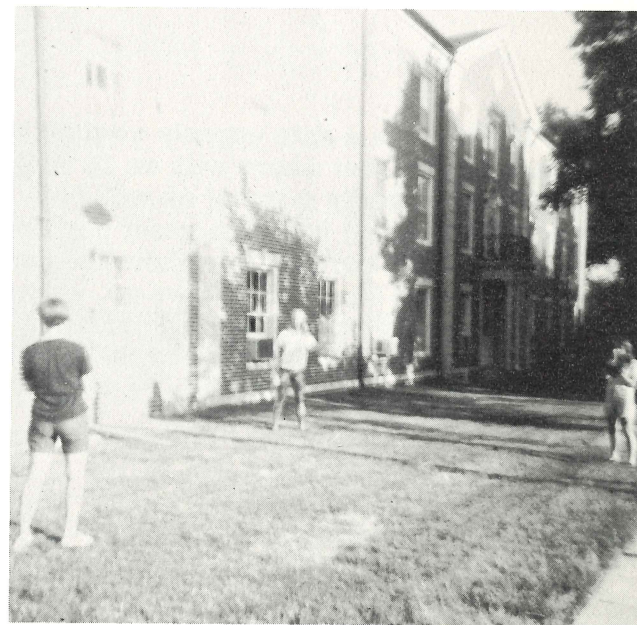
## Graduation is Only the Beginning
