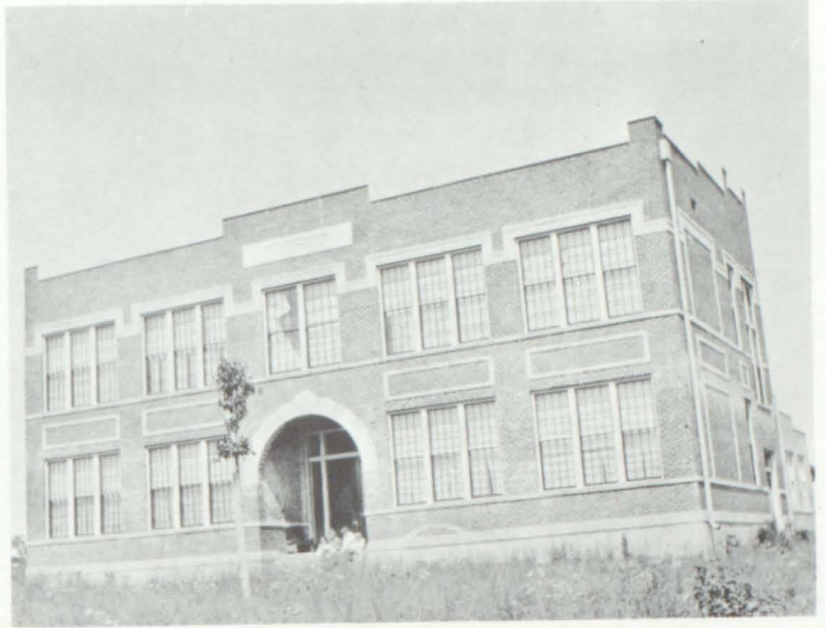

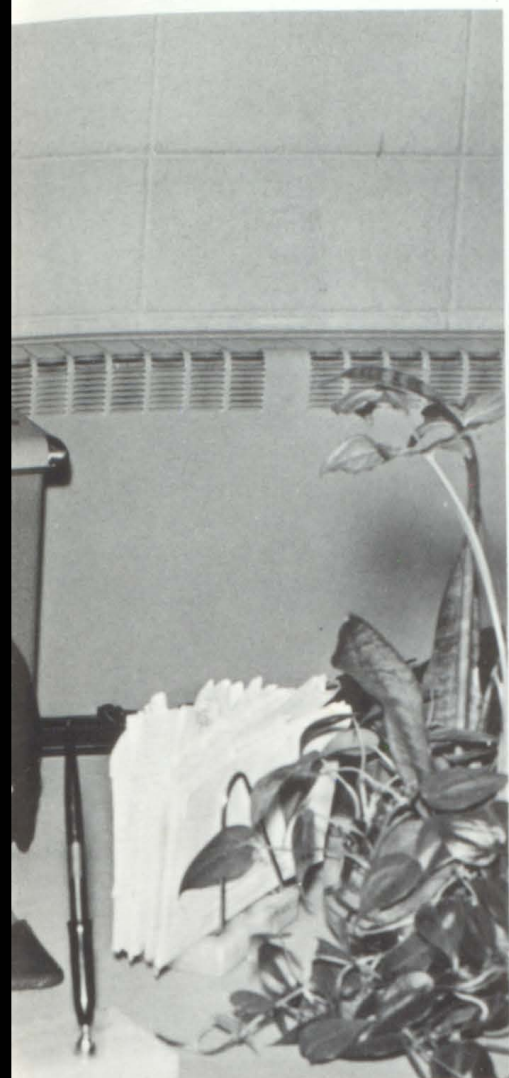


Thoughts from our Principal
